1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** the late Sgt. Paul N. Moore has dedicated more than seventeen
4 (17) years of his life in service to the government of Guam while working with the
5 Guam Police Department. He is survived by his wife, Juliet Cruz Caguioa Moore, and

1 his two (2) sons, Phillip and Gavin; his mother Susan Freeman and her husband
2 Charles; his father James Moore and his husband Larry Nicolas; as well as his brother
3 Mark and his sister Karin; and

4 **WHEREAS**, from the time he was a very young boy, Paul had wanted to
5 become a police officer; and being as tenacious as he was, he never wavered from that
6 goal; and

7 **WHEREAS**, after graduating from Oceanview High School, Paul enrolled in
8 the Police Academy at the Guam Community College (GCC) using the money he had
9 saved to pay for his tuition; and

10 **WHEREAS**, after completing his training at GCC, Paul joined the Guam
11 Police Department cycle; and because of the dire need for police officers after
12 Supertyphoon *Pongsona* devastated the island, he became one of the youngest officers
13 ever on the police force. In November of 1997, he began his government of Guam
14 career serving as a Police Recruit at the Guam Police Department; and through hard
15 work and dedication he continued to work his way up the ranks, and he was promoted
16 to Police Officer I in August of 1998, and promoted to Police Officer II in 2004; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the late Sgt. Paul N. Moore had served at the *Dededo, Agat* and
18 *Hagåtña* Police Precincts before being assigned to Internal Affairs. In his early years
19 of service with the Guam Police Department, Sgt. Moore had been applauded for his
20 outstanding performance of duties, successful recovery and apprehension; and in June
21 of 1998, he received a Letter of Commendation; and

22 **WHEREAS**, in June 2000 and February 2002, Sgt. Moore again received
23 Letters of Appreciation and Commendation for his loyalty, dedication, civility and
24 outstanding performance of duty; and

25 **WHEREAS**, in May of 2003, he received the Distinguished Service Award for
26 his allegiance, good judgment, zeal and ingenuity; in June 2004, he received another


1 Letter of Commendation for his exceptional performance of duty; and January 2011,
2 he received a superior performance recognition; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in 2007, Sgt. Moore joined the Guam Army National Guard and
4 after basic training in Fort Benning, Georgia, where he graduated at the top of his
5 class, he was later deployed to serve in Afghanistan in 2008; now therefore, be it


6 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*
7 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
8 of Guam, recognize and memorialize the late Sgt. Paul N. Moore, known to many as
9 “Peanut,” for his more than seventeen (17) years of government of Guam service with
10 the Guam Police Department; and does further extend sincere condolences to his
11 family on his passing; and be it further

12 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
