Dear Senator Pangelinan:

Thank you for the opportunity to provide written testimony on Bill No. 330-31 (COR).

The Bureau understands the intent of the Bill to reduce the government of Guam's General fund deficit and therefore supports Bill 330-31(COR) relative to the automatic de-appropriations of funds of any budgetary saving that may be realized from any reorganization efforts. Section 2 of the Bill can be strengthened with a provision that any deappropriation savings shall be used to reduce the General Fund deficit. The proposed measure is consistent with the Administration's goals to reorganize services and programs, to streamline the government of Guam, to reduce the cumulative deficit by taking steps to fix the structural imbalance of the General Fund, and to continue to take steps in order to right-size this government.
