## II. COMMITTEE PROCEEDINGS

### (a) Bill Sponsor Summary

### (b) Testimony

**Chairman Pangelinan:** Bill 372 is an act to add a new §22437 to Title 5 Guam Code Annotated and to add a new §16316 to Title 17 Guam Code Annotated; relative to the expansion and renovation of the facilities of the University of Guam and a companion Bill 373 would proposed the same program but for the Guam Community College. I would like to ask Dr. Okada and President Underwood to please join us.

#### 1. Dr. Robert A. Underwood, President UOG

**Dr. Robert Underwood:** *(read written testimony; see attach)*. I do understand the bill may go through some changes as we go along this process. Thank you.

#### Panel Comments and Questions

**Chairman Pangelinan:** Thank you Dr. Underwood. The limitation on the expenditure of the funds requires the University of Guam to match any dollar spent on a dollar for dollar basis. Is that something the University of Guam supports?

**Dr. Robert Underwood:** Yes

**Senator Yamashita:** Mr. President I appreciate your support of it. I do believe education will help our future. As we go allow I would like to see we fit somewhere in the master plan the development and the return of an early childhood center. We proffer a lot of bills that are intervention. The university had one years ago but the president decided it cost too much. It's a good investment. Thank you very much.

**Chairman Pangelinan:** Thank you. President Okada.

#### 2. Ms. Mary A. Y. Okada

**Ms. Mary A. Y. Okada:** *(read written testimony; see attach)*.

**Chairman Pangelinan:** Thank you Ms. Okada.

#### Panel Comments and Questions

**Chairman Pangelinan:** I'm going to ask you the same question I asked President Underwood. Do you support the limitation?

**Ms. Mary A. Y. Okada:** Yes.

**Chairman Pangelinan:** Thank you. Senator Taijeron.

**Senator Taijeron:** I just have a comment. I just want to say I'm proud of where the University and GCC have gone. I'm a triton and looking back 20 years when the building were modular and seeing the plans and what's in store I am proud. I appreciate both your efforts and thank you.

**Chairman Pangelinan:** Thank you. I want to say I am a triton and about 20 years ago I say those modular building and I said we got to do something about this. One of the first things I did was structure the first bond issue that ever was to fund schools. We worked with the University of Guam we were able to fund the bond financing which was for the first time paid for our own local institutions. Before that time we had to wait for the federal government. That makes me a proud Triton.

**Senator Cruz:** I did notice on both class listings at least a dozen early class listings. I didn't see a Russian class yet.

**Ms. Mary A. Y. Okada:** Not yet.

**Dr. Robert Underwood:** There are 25 Russian speakers on island and we are trying to find one with a degree. We just might certify one through the continuing education program.

**Senator Cruz:** Do either institution do a follow up on your graduates? I notice both have Japanese courses but it never ceases to amaze me the Department of Labor is announcing a need for Japanese speakers. I'm just worried when we might have a Russian speaking student.

**Chairman Pangelinan:** Thank you. I'll be happy to host a round table on all these issues.

**Ms. Mary A. Y. Okada:** There is a requirement for our Perquins funding that we do a post graduate follow up survey. We are starting to gather that information now. It's more apparent that Federal funding is closely tied to placement. We do have an alumni data base. As for Senator Aline we just received our first draft of our campus master plan. We do have a briefing for our faculty and board on January 20<sup>th</sup> at 4:00pm. All the senator are more than welcome to come.

**Senator Yamashita:** Are you looking to build an early childhood center?

**Ms. Mary A. Y. Okada:** Not necessarily but in a partnership with another organization. If we entered into a longer term partnership with an organization to build the capacity using separate facilities that were not ours, this bill does not allow us to do that. It says renovation of GCC facilities if somehow we could expand the language to include that we would have greater opportunities.

**Chairman Pangelinan:** This concludes the testimony on Bill No. 373. There being no additional individuals to present any additional testimony, this Committee will continue to remain open for the acceptance of any additional information or public testimony on the bill discussed. **AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §22438 TO TITLE 5 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED AND TO REENACT §31115 OF TITLE 17 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE EXPANSION AND RENOVATION OF THE FACILITIES OF THE GUAM COMMUNITY COLLEGE.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**  
2 **Section 1.** A new §22438 of Title 5 Guam Code Annotated is hereby  
3 *added* to read as follows:  
4 “§22438. **Excess General Fund Tax Revenues for the Guam**  
5 **Community College.** Beginning in Fiscal Year 2013, if the General Fund  
6 Tax Revenues projection exceeds Six Hundred Million Dollars  
7 (\$600,000,000), *I Liheslatura* shall appropriate an amount of Six Million  
8 Dollars (\$6,000,000) to be deposited into the Guam Community College  
9 Facilities Fund (‘Fund’) for the expansion and renovation of the facilities of  
10 the Guam Community College (‘College’). Any monies expended by the  
11 College from this Fund must be matched on a dollar per dollar basis by the

1 College. The aggregate amount of the deposits to the Fund shall not exceed  
2 Thirty Million Dollars (\$30,000,000).”

3 **Section 2.** §31115 of Title 17 Guam Code Annotated is hereby *reenacted*  
4 to read as follows:

5 **“Guam Community College Facilities Fund.** There is hereby  
6 established the Guam Community College Facilities Fund (“Fund”) in which  
7 the monies shall be used for the expansion or renovation of the facilities of  
8 the Guam Community College. The Fund shall be held in an account  
9 separate and apart from all other accounts and funds of the government of  
10 Guam and shall not be subject to the transfer authority of *I Magalahan*  
11 *Guåhan*. The Board of Trustees (“Trustees”) of the College shall administer  
12 the fund. Within sixty (60) days after the closing of each fiscal year, the  
13 Trustee shall transmit to the Governor and Legislature an annual report of  
14 the expenditures of the fund.”

Testimony of Dr. Mary A.Y. Okada  
President  
Guam Community College  
Bill Number 373-31

Senators, thank you for allowing me to appear before you to offer support for Bill Number 373-31, An Act to add a new section 22438 to Title 5 Guam Code Annotated; Relative to the expansion and renovation of the facilities of the Guam Community College.

For the past several years, the Guam Community College has been expanding its facilities. Although many of you may have participated in several groundbreaking and ribbon cuttings at the college, the expansion and renovation of our facilities is far from over.

In 2005, the college adopted the Physical Master Plan that projected the college's growth over the next fifteen years. Keeping on task with the new buildings recommended in the Master Plan, the college added the Anthony A. Leon Guerrero Allied Health Center in 2009, the Learning Resource Center in 2010, and the Student Center in 2011. In 2012, the college will open the completely renovated Foundation Building in July. With each of these added facilities, the college incorporated new features into its designs. For example, the Learning Resource Center was designed to obtain LEED certification, and we successfully achieved a Gold rating in LEED certification. This building utilized digital controls for air conditioning and LED lighting. The renovated Foundation building will incorporate a rain harvesting system that will capture water that can be used to flush the toilets. By the end of this year (2012), the college will have four buildings with photovoltaic systems. The parking lots have been retrofitted with photovoltaic lights with funding provided by the Guam Energy Office.

But we have more plans being developed as we speak. The A&E for both the Expansion of the Forensic Crime Lab and the complete renovation and expansion of Building 200 is underway.

Funding has been provided for both of these designs: the Guam Community College Foundation and the Department of the Interior. This body in Public Law 30-201 provided funding for construction. These buildings are being designed to obtain LEED certification as well. New features are being explored to incorporate into these facilities such as a building automation system. This system is computerized with a network of electronic devices that is designed to monitor and control the mechanical and lighting systems in a building.


So, with all that we have been able to accomplish, why is all of this necessary? For the past several years, enrollment has increased by 38%. Many new programs have been revamped, re-instituted or are currently under development. There are emerging technologies that the community will begin to require, such as photovoltaic training, among others.

According to the bill, in its current form, funding will be used for the expansion or renovation of the facilities of the Guam Community College. I would like for you to consider language that allows the college to increase its capacity by expanding its informational technologies. The college recently completed a technology audit. This audit updated our Enterprise Architecture and Information Technology Strategic Plan. This audit identifies some areas that need to be upgraded to allow the college to further venture into online or distance education and increase our capacity to offer online courses. This will definitely increase our enrollment and provide opportunities to more students, particularly our non-traditional students, not just on Guam, but throughout the region.

Senators, you know that GCC is one of the most fiscally responsible agencies of the government. For the last ten consecutive years, the college has been able to maintain clean financial audits. We have been very fortunate for dedicated staff that ensures we are fiscally accountable. Every investment in the Guam Community College has proven to be a wise one. We account for all funds that are given to us, and our planning process has provided us with excellent opportunities in the past several years.

Si Yu'os ma'ase for the opportunity to provide this testimony and for your continued support of the Guam Community College. We are excited about the opportunities to renovate and expand our facilities. Your commitment and investment in our institution is greatly appreciated by our faculty, Board, staff, and most importantly, our students and their families.

Dear Mr. Chair and Senators:

*Buenas yan Hafa Adai.* I am Robert Underwood, President of the University of Guam and I am here today in support of Bill 372-31. Thank you for the opportunity to comment.

The University is grateful for the support that I Mina' Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan has shown through your sponsorship of Bill 372-31. We acknowledge the sponsorship of Speaker Judi Won Pat, Senator Judi Guthertz, Senator Tina Muna Barnes, Senator Aline Yamashita, and Senator Sam Mabini.

With the University of Guam "Celebrating the Triton Spirit" for our 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary this year, Bill 372-31 provides a timely opportunity to double our capability when joined with our five-year capital fundraising campaign to support the financing of facility priorities as identified in our updated physical master plan. As you know we are on an aggressive schedule to raise \$30 million by 2017.

Bill 372-31 provides legislation that allows support for higher education to increase as our economy improves. It also requires a commitment by the University of Guam to match every extra dollar provided through this legislation with a dollar the University generates through its fundraising efforts. I support the passage of this bill as it is one of two pillars to enable the University to build a 21<sup>st</sup> century campus that will meet our growth needs until 2025. The University of Guam's Physical Master Plan, to be completed in April of 2012, will include over \$100 million worth of capital projects that include new buildings, infrastructure upgrades and revisions, and will be adaptable to both an on-campus and off-campus student and faculty degree programs, research projects, and service network. This will allow the University to plan and build an infrastructure in response to the island's growth needs and not to the availability of funding sources. The Plan will guide construction of our physical plant keeping our students and academic programs in the forefront of our efforts and the broader scope of economic and human resource development and professional capacity building as our overarching commitment to the community.

Bill 372-31 offers a unique opportunity to develop the financial capacity to meet the growth needs of our University's student population. The University of Guam's academic programs

have received recognition from specialized accreditation bodies and community confidence as the University continues to grow, as reflected in the Fall 2011 enrollment numbers, which increased to 3,721 students, the highest level in over ten years. Our current facilities must expand to meet the increased demand and to create learning environments that are conducive to student success, research, and service/outreach activities. The campus of the future will include LEED certification for all new facilities.

The University plans to break ground on the Student Services Center and Engineering School facility in the near future. This achievement is due in significant part to your leadership and the passing of Bill 446-30, now Public Law 30-20, that allows for debt service for these projects tied to a USDA loan which is pending approval. The Student Services Center will provide a single one-stop center for all UOG student services and will be the center point of student life on campus. The Engineering School will allow Guam and the region to retain local talent and internally grow this professional field.

Unfunded priority projects include, but are not limited to, the expansion of the Fine Arts Center which will enhance our capability to showcase the many talents of our students, faculty, and programs; and the Triton Engagement Center which will consolidate the many services and outreach activities in disabilities, cancer research, and distance education. Other projects include renovations and expansions for the Nursing, Health Science, and Science programs; Micronesian Area Research activities; Marine Lab and Water Environmental Research programs; and better technology support to students and faculty throughout the campus.

I Mina' Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan's support to help foster a nurturing environment so that the University can continue to provide the leadership and talent that sustains our Western Pacific region is priceless and an investment that continues to reap dividends for individuals and our community as a whole. In 1951, Jose R. Palomo had the bold idea of establishing a teacher training college on island with a curriculum that was on par with US mainland colleges. Island leaders approved his proposal and the Territorial College of Guam was established just one year later. Jose Palomo was a man of incredible foresight who was determined to improve the lives of Guamanians through higher education. Your actions to approve Bill 372-31 demonstrate your foresight and determination to shape the next 60 years of higher education on Guam for the betterment of our people, our island, and our region's future.

The Bill proposes the appropriation of \$6 M for deposit into the said Fund beginning in FY 2013, provided that the General Fund Tax Revenues projection exceeds \$600 M. Deposits to the Fund shall not exceed the aggregate amount of \$30 M in a total of 5 years. The GCC must match on a dollar per dollar basis any monies expended under the said Fund. However, the Bill, in its present form does not provide for a contingency action plan to impose, as an offset for expenditure against the Fund, in the event actual General Fund Tax Revenue collections fall short of the \$600 M as projected for the given year.
