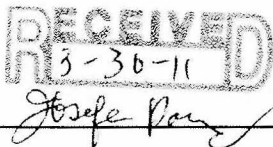

I. OVERVIEW: A public hearing was conducted on January 28, 2011, and convened at 09:00 A.M. in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of **Resolution NO. 08-31 (COR);** RELATIVE TO EXPRESSING THE OBJECTION OF *I MINA'TRENTA/ UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUAHAN* TO THE 112TH UNITED STATES CONGRESS FOR RESTRICTING THE VOTING RIGHTS OF TERRITORIAL AND DISTRICT CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATE; Sponsored by Dennis G. Rodriguez, Jr., Vicente C. Pangelinan, Rory J. Respicio, and Thomas C. Ada

The public hearing on agenda item Resolution No. 08-31 (COR) was Called-to-Order at 09:15 A.M.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION.

SENATOR DENNIS G. RODRIGUEZ, JR., convened the Public Hearing on Resolution No. 08-31 (COR).

Senator Rodriguez, Jr., author of Resolution No. 08-31 (COR), explained the intent of the Resolution.

This resolution was introduced by myself, Senator Pangelinan, Senator Respicio and Senator Tom Ada. When the 112th Congress was convened into session there was an amendment made that restricts the voting rights of the territory delegates and district delegate. We felt that it was important for the people of Guam, for the Guam legislature to make a statement and object to this. Because especially at a time when our island is being asked to bear the big burden of this military buildup, it is even more important that with the very small voice that we have in congress that our delegate be given the right to vote in the committee of the whole and be able to express the sentiments and what the people of Guam want for our island. So we introduce this and hopefully it passes will be agreed upon by the other members of the legislature. And if agreed upon and passed it will be transmitted to the Congress in making sure that it is entered into record that the people of Guam do object to this amendment to restrict the voting rights.

Senator Rodriguez, Jr.: Called the first panel to testify – No one was signed up to testify, nor came forward at the invitation of the Chairman.

Senator Rodriguez, Jr.: Noted for the record that no testimony had been received.

There being no testimony, or comments by Senators, Senator Rodriguez declared the Resolution as having been duly heard, and concluded the public hearing on Resolution No. 08-31 (COR). The Committee would continue to accept written testimony for a period of ten (10) subsequent to the public hearing.

III. FINDINGS & RECOMMENDATIONS





The findings are, that in keeping with the principles of American democracy, the people of Guam should, at the very least, have a legitimate say and voice in the determination of laws to be enacted which will affect and impact them in significant ways. This can, to a limited extent, be achieved by having a voting Delegate in the U.S. House of Representatives. Resolution No. 08-31 (COR) is once again a declaration by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, on behalf of the people of Guam, in support of our continuing effort to obtain an increased measure of self-representation in the U.S. Congress.

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I MINA'TRENTAI***
2 ***UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS,** the 112th United States Congress amended House rules whereby revoking
4 the voting privileges for territorial and district Delegates in the Committee of the Whole; and

5 **WHEREAS,** the Delegate of Guam represents 173,430 U. S. citizens, and the Delegates
6 from the District of Columbia, American Samoa, Northern Marianas, and Puerto Rico represent
7 approximately 5 million U. S. citizens; and

8 **WHEREAS,** the U.S. citizens residing in Guam and the other territories and districts are
9 NOT granted full representation and voting rights in the United States government, but have
10 been granted limited representation in the person of a non-voting delegate to the House of

1 Representatives; and

2 **WHEREAS**, the 103rd United States Congress approved a rule to allow the four
3 Delegates and One District Commissioner to vote in the Committee of the Whole as a
4 ceremonial gesture; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the voting privileges of the Territorial and District Delegates in the
6 Committee of the Whole were restored by the 111th United States Congress; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the majority in the 112th United States Congress determined that delegates
8 should not be given voting privileges in the Committee of the Whole because they are non-state
9 delegates; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the majority in the 112th United States Congress further determined that
11 Territorial and District Delegate votes violate the idea of equal representation because the
12 population of the territories and district is below the average population of a state; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the 112th United States Congress amended House Rules further restrict the
14 already limited powers of the Territorial and District Delegates; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the amendment of the House Rules by the 112th United States Congress
16 will impede the democratic process by restricting the representation of the approximately 5
17 million U.S. citizens residing in Guam and the other territories and district; now, therefore, be it

18 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan*, on behalf of the people of
19 Guam, believes in the principles of democracy upon which the United States of America was
20 founded; and be it further

21 **RESOLVED**, that *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* expresses its clear and unequivocal objection
22 to the amendment of the House Rules by the 112th United States Congress, which amendment
23 restricts voting rights for Territorial and District Delegates in the Committee of the Whole; and

1 be it further

2 **RESOLVED**, that the people of Guam, as U.S. citizens, must be granted full
3 representation before the United States Congress; and be it further

4 **RESOLVED**, that *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* opposes all legislation, resolutions, and/or
5 amendments that may limit and/or restrict the rights of citizens of Guam to representation before
6 the United States Congress and/or any entity of the United States government; and be it further

7 **RESOLVED**, that *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* supports full restoration of voting privileges
8 for Territorial and District Delegates, including the resolution introduced by Democratic
9 Minority Whip Steny H. Hoyer (MD) to amend the 112th House Standing rules to allow the
10 Territorial Delegates and Resident Commissioner to vote in the Committee of the Whole House;
11 and be it further

12 **RESOLVED**, that *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* recognizes the United States government's
13 duty to protect human rights and to ensure that all U. S. citizens have proper and adequate
14 representation; and be it further

15 **RESOLVED**, that *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* urges the United States Congress to take
16 immediate action to restore voting privileges to Territorial and District Delegates so as to ensure
17 a fair democratic system for all U.S. citizens; and be it further

18 **RESOLVED**, that *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* urges the United States Congress to
19 demonstrate a strong commitment to the U.S. citizens residing in Guam and the other territories
20 and districts, recognizing that the voices of ALL U.S. citizens are important and must be
21 recognized and represented in the United States House of Representatives; and be it further

22 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the
23 adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Rep. John Boehner,

- 1 Speaker of the House of Representatives of the 112th United States Congress; to Rep. Eric
- 2 Cantor, Majority Leader of the House of Representatives of the 112th United States Congress; to
- 3 Rep. Nancy Pelosi, House Democratic Leader; to Rep. Steny Hoyer, Democratic Minority Whip;

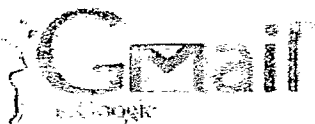

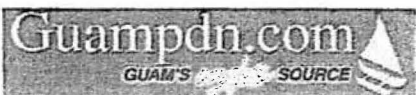

The Committee on Health and Human Services, Economic Development, Senior Citizens and Election Reform will be conducting a public hearing on Friday, Jan. 28.

The hearing will take place at 9 a.m. in the Legislature public hearing room.

The public will be able to submit testimony on the following bills:

Bill 24-31 which would change the guidelines by which the Guam Economic Development Authority makes loans. (Introduced by T.R. Mufia Barnes).

Bill 27-31 would require the disclosure of the names of candidates or groups paying for political advertisements. (Introduced by R.J. Respicio).

Bill 31-31 would require that at the time of filing for candidacy with the Guam Election Commission, a candidate shall submit a clearance from the Department of Revenue and Taxation's collections branch, on a form provided by the commission, showing there is no past-due tax obligation owed by the candidate to the government of Guam. (Introduced by B.J.F. Cruz).

Bill 36-31 would establish a Government of Guam Mitigation Program for Business Interruption. (Introduced by Sen. Ben Pangelinan).

Resolution No.008-31 would express the objection of the Legislature to the 112th United States Congress for restricting the voting rights of Territorial and District Congressional Delegates. (Introduced by Sens. Rodriguez, Pangelinan and Respicio.)
