Committee Report Digest

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Youth, Cultural Affairs, Procurement, General Government Operations and Public Broadcasting convened a public hearing on Tuesday, December 27th, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. and an additional hearing on January 5, 2012 at 9:00 A.M. in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslatura*. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration was Bill No. 395-31 (COR) - Sam Mabini, Ph.D. / B.J.F. Cruz—"An act to amend §4111, Title 4 Guam Code Annotated, Chapter 4, relative to lump sum payments for annual leave."

Bill 395-31 would not discontinue the Government's policy of paying out unused annual leave, but would require departments and agencies to spread out lump sum payments. The reasoning behind this legislation is to make it easier for directors and administrators to plan their budgets.

Public Notice Requirements

All legal requirements for public notices were met, with requests for publication sent to all media and all senators on December 28th, 2011 and January 3rd, 2012 via email. Copies of the hearing notices are appended to the report.

The public hearing was called to order at 9:06 a.m.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Vice Speaker Benjamin J.F. Cruz called the public hearing to order at 9:06 a.m. and announced the morning's agenda and public hearing notices. He also announced that there was an error in



sending the hearing notices, and that there would be an additional hearing to meet notice requirements.

Senator Sam Mabini Ph.D. - explained her reasoning for the legislation, made sure that the committee was aware that this legislation was not an attempt to stop Annual Leave, but rather to make it easier for directors and administrators to manage their annual budget by spreading out payments to employees' that are owed annual leave in installments. This would limit the amount of actual cash paid to employees and allow the leaders of the agencies to be able to make cuts to other areas so the department is not hamstrung by its financial constraints.

Doris Flores Brooks- Public Auditor- Agrees with Senator Mabini on the intent of the legislation. She says as she steps back and looks at the issue from the standpoint of a director, employees with more years of service do not have the opportunity to take all their leave so some payout is expected. An amendment that she would like to offer is to allow for annual leave disbursement for emergencies like medical or college tuition. She also thinks it may be wise for employees to cash out leave before moving between departments so as not to burden the new department with annual leave cash outs for employees that earned leave in another department.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee did produce a substitute version of Bill 395-31 the proposed changes are as follows;

Section 2: §4111, Chapter 4 Title 4 Guam Code Annotated is amended to

read as follows:

“§4111. Lump Sum Payment for Annual Leave.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law and subject of the availability of funds, an employee of the Government entitled to annual vacation leave shall ~~may~~, ~~prior to his taking of any such leave, receive a lump sum payment in cash equivalent to the amount of leave authorized to be taken~~ **NOT receive a cash lump sum equivalent payment. A payment schedule shall be made by appointing authority upon availability of funds- of twenty percent (20%) of total amount to be paid no sooner than 30 days after physically vacating their position. The remainder of the amount left shall be paid at twenty percent (20%) each month thereafter until**



total amount is paid in full. In the event that the same employee is reinstated into the same position vacated or into another position in the Government within 30 days of vacating former position, payment schedule of annual vacation leave cash equivalent shall be terminated.

Line 11: “may” was deleted and changed to “shall” to limit ambiguity.

Line 13: “Not” and “lump sum” was added to state that a “lump sum” will “not” be given.

Line 14 & 15: “shall be made by appointing authority-upon availability of funds” was added to ensure that only payments will be made if funds are available and that the payment schedule will be made by the appointing authority.

“Of twenty percent (20%) of total amount” was deleted and changes reflected on line 14.

Line 16: “The remainder of the amount left shall be paid at twenty percent (20%) each month thereafter until total amount is paid in full.” was deleted and revised language is reflected on line 14.
