Hafa Adai! I, Eddie Baza Calvo, as Governor of Guam, am submitting written testimony in favor of Bill 42-31 (COR).

In my years of experience as a senator, I noticed the great divide between the Governor's Office and the Guam Department of Education. I have attributed this in part, to the lack of a closer working relationship between the Superintendent of Education and the Administration of the Government of Guam. I truly believe that attendance at Cabinet meetings, together with the appointment of an education policy advisor, will greatly facilitate a closer partnership and working relationship between my administration and the Superintendent of the Guam Department of Education.

So I would like to applaud the Speaker for introducing this bill to effectuate by legislation, the return to the fold of the Superintendent of Education to Cabinet level status.
