AN ACT TO ADD A NEW ARTICLE 3 TO CHAPTER 70 OF TITLE 9 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO CREATING THE GUAM SOCIAL HOST ACT.

Section 1. A new Article 3 is hereby added to Chapter 70 of Title 9 Guam 2 Code Annotated to read: 3 "Article 3 4 5 The Guam Social Host Act § 70.52. Title. This Article shall be known and may be cited as *The Guam* 6 7 Social Host Act. § 70.53. Intoxication of Persons Under the Age of Twenty-One. 8 9 No person: (1) Twenty-one (21) years or older shall knowingly give or otherwise make 10 available any alcoholic beverage to a person under the age of twenty-one (21) 11 years. A person violates this subsection who gives or otherwise makes available 12 13 an alcoholic beverage to a person under the age of twenty-one (21) with the

knowledge that the person to whom the alcoholic beverage is made available will violate this subsection; or

- (2) Who owns, occupies, or controls premises on which alcoholic beverages are consumed by any person under twenty-one (21) years of age, and who knows of alcohol consumption by persons under twenty-one (21) years of age on such premises, and who reasonably could have prohibited or prevented such alcohol consumption;
 - (a) shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$2,000 or by imprisonment for not more than one year or both;
 - (b) In addition to the sentence referenced in (a) the court may require the violator to make restitution for any damages to property or a person caused by a violation of §70.53, and may require participation in volunteer service to a community service agency;
 - (c) The prohibitions of this subsection apply only to a person who is present and in control of the location at the time the consumption occurs. The prohibitions of this subsection do not apply to the owner of rental property, or the agent of an owner of rental property, unless the consumption occurs in the individual unit in which the owner or agent resides;
 - (d) The penalties of this section shall not apply to persons licensed or appointed to manufacture, transport or sell alcohol under Public Law acting in a lawful manner;
 - (e) This section shall not apply to any religious practice, observance, or ceremony;
 - (f) The violations of this Article and the resulting penalties prescribed herein this Article, supra, are in addition to other violations of Public Law related to alcoholic beverages."
