I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 145-32 (LS) was introduced on June 19, 2013 by Senator Frank B. Aguon, Jr. and was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Municipal Affairs, Tourism, Housing and Hagåtña Restoration & Redevelopment Authority on June 19, 2013.

The Committee on Municipal Affairs, Tourism, Housing and Hagåtña Restoration & Redevelopment Authority convened a public hearing on Bill No. 145-32(LS) on Tuesday, July 30, 2013 at 10:00 AM at the Legislature's Public Hearing Room in Hagåtña.

particular measure. Thank you once again to the Mayor of Malesso and the community for their support. Thank you Mr. Chairman.

Vice Speaker Cruz: Thank you Senator Aguon. I would like to note for the record that Mayor Chargualaf has submitted written testimony in favor of this legislation as well as Mr. Taijeron, however in opposition, but if there's an amendment, we'll find out. There's only one person here to testify, Mr. San Nicolas.

The individual that previously submitted testimony in opposition of this measure, had serious concerns of deleting the word "Pier" and that's where the compromise came in, in terms of making sure that that continues as part of the name. But the tribute, the objective, is still accomplished in terms of recognizing and memorializing our veterans who have served and who are also serving. Thank you very much Arthur and please extend my appreciate to the Mayor and to the MPC for adopting the resolution. Most especially for the recognition of our veterans and all of their services, so thank you very much, thank you Mr. Chairman.

Senator McCreadie: Thank you Mr. Vice Speaker. Arthur, listening to your testimony, I agree with everyone and what they said. Thank you for taking us down memory lane and sharing some of your experiences is how close it hits home when it comes to not just veterans, but active family members serving in the military. So, I think it's important to acknowledge some and all who ever paid the ultimate price fighting for our country and our island. I do want to commend the author, Senator Aguon, for always looking out for our veterans and taking it very serious and giving them a voice through the legislature, so I think it's very important to note. Like you said, you hit right on the nail. Thank you Arthur and thank you guys for coming here today and you have my full support.

Section 1. Naming of the Malesso Pier Park in Honor of the Veterans 2 of Malesso who have served in the U. S. Armed Forces. A new §849.5.1 is 3 4 hereby added to Article 1, Chapter 8, of Title 1, Guam Code Annotated, pertaining 5 to the official naming of the Malesso Pier Park, which shall read as follows: "§849.5.1. <u>Pier Park</u>, in honor and recognition of the men and women of Malesso who have selflessly served in the U. S. Armed Forces, and as an extended acknowledgement of the veterans of Guam who have devotedly served the people of Malesso, the people of Guam, and the people of United States of America in defense of freedom.

The Malesso Municipal Planning Council (the "Council") of the Malesso Mayor's Office shall be responsible for the construction of an appropriate signage designating such park facility as the *Plåsan Bantalån Beterånon Mansendålon Malesso'* (Malesso' Veteran Sons and Daughters of Malesso Pier Park). The Council shall be authorized to receive contributions, both cash and/or in-kind, and conduct fundraisers to fund the construction, beautification and maintenance of the *Plåsan Bantalån Beterånon Mansendålon Malesso'* (Malesso' Veteran Sons and Daughters of Malesso Pier Park)."

Section 2. Effective Date. The provisions contained herein shall be effective upon enactment of this Act.

For the past 69 years the village of Merizo has been hosting Memorial Services for the Tinta & Faha Massacre Victims. Subsequently one of my predecessors and his/her Municipal Planning Council members incorporated the War Casualty Veterans of the various World Wars and made them a part of the Annual Memorial Services. When I came into office in 2009, I continued to host the Memorial Service with reservations. As the current Mayor, I strongly believe that these war casualty Veterans should be accorded their own distinct Memorial Service during Memorial Day. My name is Arthur SanNicolas, I am from the beautiful village of Malesso. I am here this morning to testify on Bill No 145-32 (COR) relative to naming the Malesso Pier Park, "Plasan Beteranon Mansendalon Malesso" (Veteran Sons and Daughters of Malesso Park)

I am sure that some may disagree on the naming of the Malesso Park. Maybe, for the reason of "too much areas being named after the veterans".

However, we must look beyond that and focus on who we are really honoring. For the Men and Women, Sons and Daughters of Malesso that haved served in WWI, WWII, Korean War, Vietnam War, Iraq War, and currently the War in Afghanistan.

Per capita Guam has more soldiers enlisted in the U.S. Armed Forces than any state. Per capita Guam, also has more casualties of war than any state.

During the vietnam war, Soldiers came back home to the U.S. being called Baby Killers or Murderers. They didn't come home to open arms nor was given a hero's welcome. However, here on Guam we welcomed our veteran's home with loving open arms. Because it's the way we were taught, our culture, our tradition, and values. By the way my brother-in-law, Albert Barcinas Doyle was the 13th. Casualty from Guam during the Vietnam war.

Some soldiers no matter what war came home having to deal with the effects of war. In which also affected their family.

A growing number of soldiers take their own life because of the effects of war.

A growing number of marriages end up in divorces because the effects of war.

Spouses playing both rolls of parenting praying that their military spouse comes back home alive. Parents also praying for the same.

But we all know that there will be soldiers that will pay the ultimate sacrifice of war. Spouses having to explain to their children why their Mommy or Daddy never came home/died. Only having memories to hold onto.

A month prior to my son-in-laws deployment in march, we had to bury his daughter Tori (my grand-daughter). Not only, having to deal with the emotional stress of losing a daughter, but also leaving his spouse Ariana (my daughter) and two year old daughter Emma behind. At the same time accomplishing the mission.

I have relatives, nieces, nephews, son-in-law that have and are currently in the U.S. Armed Forces, deployed serving this country, more importantly this island. The sworn commitment they gave when they raised their right hand.

This is only a tiny fraction of what we can do for the ultimate service and sacrifices these veterans have and continue to do for the freedom we enjoy today. We may not be able to vote for Presidents, but certainly your vote to pass this bill will be greatly appreciated and remembered by the family members of veterans that have gone before us and the veterans that are currently serving in the U.S. Armed Forces.

Merizo has few icons that draw people to the village. The Pier is one of them, and I would like for tourists and visitors to remember they were at the Malesso Pier and not at the veteran's pier.

Why don't you change Talofofo Bay to "Veteran's Bay" Same effect there if you ask me. Consider if you will the Four P's of marketing from your MBA studies and the importance "PLACE" quickly becomes apparent as well as the other P's.

I am a veteran with several DD 214s and I still wait in line with the rest of our public even though I can go to the front of the line. I think we have more than enough places named after us sir; veteran's that is.

Please feel free to call me at 688-4222 if you would like to discuss this issue further.

The people of Malesso need the continuous and consistent notoriety to ensure their small, and I mean "small" business interests remains as popular or easy to explain when referenced by the pier. To rename the pier would be to take away something that all residents of Malesso share.

I just told a Talofofo colleague of mine that they were going to rename the bay and he was very disturbed until I

told him it was the Malesso pier. He calmed down a bit but still remained disturbed and bewildered about the name change. He then shared his stories of jumping off the pier in Merizo/Malesso.

Please do not change the name of the pier.


