

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Vice Speaker Benjamin J.F Cruz announced Bill No. 158-32 (COR) then called on Senator San Nicolas as its sponsor to provide opening remarks.

Senator San Nicolas stated that the intent of Bill No. 158-32 (COR) is to streamline the bill paying process for residents by allowing them to pay for government services online. It is therefore the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to require that the Director of each agency review payments that are made to the respective agency to determine which could be made through each agency's website.

Section 3. Determination of Payments. The Director or equivalent of each agency or instrumentality (hereinafter, 'agency') of the government of Guam, supported by the Department of Administration for line agencies of the government of Guam, shall make a review of all payments made through the normal course of business to the agency to determine which payments could be remitted through the agency's website. All payments shall be determined as "plausible" or "implausible" for online transactions, with all "implausible" determinations requiring an explanation for such categorization. The findings thereof shall be reported to the Bureau of Information Technology, I Liheslaturan Guåhan and I Maga'lahen Guåhan by no later than ninety (90) days following the enactment of this Act.

Section 4. Estimation of Costs. The Bureau of Information Technology *shall*, upon receipt of the findings of each agency or instrumentality of the government of Guam pursuant to §3 of this Act, estimate the costs associated with implementing "plausible" online payments as proposed pursuant to such findings and report the same to *I*

- 1 Liheslaturan Guåhan and I Maga'lahen Guåhan within ninety (90) days
- 2 following receipt of the report of the agency.
- 3 Section 5. Consideration for Action. I Liheslaturan Guåhan shall

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 **Short Title.** This Act *shall* be referred to as the Section 1.
- "Responsible Online Payments Act". 3
- Section 2. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan 4
- finds the people of Guam will benefit greatly from online payment 5
- opportunities that will save them time and reduce the wait times for 6
- 7 residents who wish to avail themselves of government services in person.
- Additionally, road travel by residents to take care of business which may 8
- 9 reasonably be accomplished online adds to traffic congestion on Guam's
- roadways. 10

I Liheslatura further finds that every improvement to transactional efficiency and reduced traffic congestion results in economic benefits in the form of higher productivity, lower fuel consumption and positive consumer morale.

It is therefore the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to require that the Director of each agency review payments that are made to the respective agency to determine which could be made through each agency's website.

Section 3. Determination of Payments. The Director or equivalent of each agency or instrumentality (hereinafter, 'agency') of the government of Guam, supported by the Department of Administration for line agencies of the government of Guam, shall make a review of all payments made through the normal course of business to the agency to determine which payments could be remitted through the agency's website. All payments shall be determined as "plausible" or "implausible" for online transactions, with all "implausible" determinations requiring an explanation for such categorization. The findings thereof shall be reported to the Bureau of Information Technology, I Liheslaturan Guåhan and I Maga'lahen Guåhan by no later than ninety (90) days following the enactment of this Act.

Section 4. Estimation of Costs. The Bureau of Information Technology *shall*, upon receipt of the findings of each agency or instrumentality of the government of Guam pursuant to §3 of this Act, estimate the costs associated with implementing "plausible" online payments as proposed pursuant to such findings and report the same to *I*

- 1 Liheslaturan Guåhan and I Maga'lahen Guåhan within ninety (90) days
- 2 following receipt of the report of the agency.
- 3 Section 5. Consideration for Action. I Liheslaturan Guåhan shall
- 4 review the cost estimates of implementing online payments, as reported by
- 5 the Bureau of Information Technology, and *shall* determine if "plausible"
- 6 payments warrant appropriation to allow implementation. Those
- 7 payments determined "implausible" shall be reviewed for policy solutions
- 8 that may render such payments "plausible" for online payment.
