COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 171-32 (LS) was introduced on August 20, 2013 by Senators V. Anthony Ada and Benjamin J.F. Cruz. The bill was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations on August 21, 2013.

The Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations convened a public hearing on September 16, 2013 at 2:00 p.m. in *I Liheslatura*'s Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was Bill 171-32 (LS). The hearing was adjourned at 3:23 p.m.

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via electronic mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on September 9, 2013, and again on September 12, 2013.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Michael San Nicolas: We will now move on to Bill 171-32. I'd like to turn it over to the main sponsor, Senator Tony Ada.

Senator Tony Ada: Thank you, Mister Chair. This bill is relative to the Guam ID cards issued to individuals under the age of 21. What this does is raises the age from 18 to 21 for government of Guam ID cards that must be distinguishable from other IDs. The bill amends four sections of the law that were enacted by Public Law 24-169 to reflect the age that the individuals are allowed to purchase alcoholic beverages. The bill affects driver's licenses, Guam IDs, employment IDs, and school IDs. Since this Legislature increased the drinking age to 21, several laws have been enacted to hand out harsh punishments to those who sell or transfer alcoholic beverages to individuals under 21. When they had Operation Dragon, GPD along with the ABC Board had issued numerous citations for violations of the law. Guam law makes enforcement extremely difficult in that individuals, who are between the ages of 18 and 21, are allowed to patronize the bars but not allowed to consume the alcohol. Often, bartenders and waitstaff are frustrated with having to police the patrons who

transfer alcohol to underage patrons. In 1998, Senator Kasperbauer authored Public Law 25-169. This law brought Guam into parity with other jurisdictions that made it easier to identify patrons. At the time the law was enacted, we know that the drinking age was 18. Bill 171-32 just updates the law from 18 to 21 and is a reintroduction of Bill 456-31 which was introduced in May of last year but was never heard by the Committee to which it was referred. Thank you.

Chairman San Nicolas: Thank you, Senator Ada. I understand that we have no individuals signed up to testify on Bill 171-32. We do have written testimony from the Department of Revenue and Taxation that will be appended to the committee report. That will conclude the hearing of Bill 171-32.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations hereby reports out Bill No. 171-32 (LS) with the recommendation TO REPORT ON TOWN.



Dear Senator Ada:

The Department of Revenue and Tax concurs with your intent to make the age of persons with a Guam license or Identification be prominently visible, however, DRT, Driver's License Branch as of January 11, 2013, implemented the driver's license layout that is currently described in your Bill. It reflects the age warning alert, which is prominently displayed in red on the face of the card. To further differentiate drivers under 21 years of age, the positioning of the driver's license information is displayed vertically on the actual card, unlike the licenses issued to persons 21 and over, which is formatted horizontally (attached is a sample of our current layout). This new driver's license format has been adopted nationwide and is currently being regulated by the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators, which we are members of.

The Department is also tasked with the responsibility to issue Guam Identification Cards. We are currently working towards reformatting the cards using the same concept as the Driver's License (i.e. age warning alert and vertically positioning for persons under 21 years).

In addition, we applaud your efforts to update the law to reflect the new age requirements.

At this time, we need your support to identify funding appropriation to defray the cost to reconfigure the formatting of the Guam Identification Cards and other incidental costs associated with this change.

Thank you for allowing us the opportunity to provide testimony on this Bill.




Fig. 39.1 Pennsylvania Driver's License Current Issue




Fig. 39.2 Pennsylvania Minor's License Current Issue






