#### COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

#### I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 023-32(COR) was introduced on January 25, 2013 by Senator Aline A. Yamashita, PhD and Senator Tina Rose Muna Barnes and was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Municipal Affairs, Tourism, Housing and Hagåtña Restoration & Redevelopment Authority on January 29, 2013.

The Committee on Municipal Affairs, Tourism, Housing and Hagåtña Restoration & Redevelopment Authority convened a public hearing on Bill No. 023-32(COR) on Wednesday, February 13, 2013 at 3:00 PM at the Legislature's Public Hearing Room in Hagåtña.

#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Senator Tina Muna Barnes – Thanked her colleagues for being here: Senator Aline Yamashita, Senator Tony Ada, Senator Chris Duenas and Senator Brant McCreadie. Yamashita, PhD and myself as a co-sponsor. It was subsequently referred by Committee on Rules to the Committee on Municipal Affairs,

I would like to advise the Public that Public Hearing notices were sent out on Wednesday, February 6, 2013 which is five (5) working days prior to the hearing date and once again on Friday, February 8, 2013 which completes the forty-eight (48) hour notice which is to adhere to the 5 GCA, Chapter 8, Subsection 8107. There are several individuals that are present to testify, Acting Fire Chief John Wusstig, Mayor Carol Tayama and Executive Director of the Mayor's Council, Mr. Angel Sablan. invitation was extended to Department of Land Management, however Director Monte Mafnas is currently off-island, but Acting Director David Camacho had called our office this afternoon to advise us that they are in support of this bill before us and that written testimony will be provided. An invitation was also extended to Mr. Salas from Sanctuary and he is on his way, however should he not be able to attend, he will submit written testimony in support of the bill. Senator Aline Yamashita, PhD - Thank you very much Madam Chair for allowing me to speak. Hafa Adai everyone and welcome to the Legislature. My fine colleague to my right is acting like this is her bill because it really is her bill. It was introduced last term, but for technical reasons, it never made it and so right away she called me and said let's do it again. We made some corrections and we found out some information that was needed that kept it from passing last term. The reason for resubmitting this bill once again is that, like I said last term, the fact that the Mayors are the hardest working people here. They are on the ground, 24-7 they work with our families and certainly need a place that is safe and happy so that you could take a break every now and then or you could work with your constituents in a safe place. I know that Mayor Carol Tayama has been working in a termite infested office for a while now. So this idea came about when we knew that the fire house was going to move to a new facility and it was an opportunity to transfer that property to you and we engaged in conversation and everyone was very supportive of this. And so what was even more attractive about this idea was that if indeed we let sanctuary a non-profit take over your current property then they can renovate it with their funding sources and open up those kinds of opportunities for our people who live a little bit further from Mangilao where their

main office is and I think that's a real big win for all our families. I am honored to have Senator Tina Rose Muna Barnes has stepped up. She just introduced this and we are having a public hearing right now so that really talks about really true support. I appreciate that and we hope that this will help the 5,000 people who live in Agat. Certainly we know that Agat has a lot of needs and this will help you to be secure and stable as you continue to work with your fine Vice Mayor Quintanilla.

Agat Mayor Carol Tayama - Si Yu'os Ma'åse' madam chair. Buenas yan Hafa Adai. For the record my name is Carol Tayama and I am the Mayor of Agat. In front of you, you have my testimony that I presented back in October of 2012. I am here today to ask and to first of all to thank the honorable Senator Tina Muña Barnes and Senator Aline for pushing for this. We have been trying to get this building so that our office can have a better place to serve the people of Agat. Right now, it's truly infested with termites. The wall is being held up by the termites and ready to collapse. We worry about the safety of the people when they come in for registration, verifications and stuff like that. So with the fire moving to a state of the art bldg, we figure that their building can be given to us. And like I mentioned Senator, we have worked with Sanctuary, we are in communication so that they can use our current facility so that they can do research work down there. We have outreach programs that they are planning to do. We have met with the principals of the different high schools and elementary schools. So they have all this in plan and this movement from the current mayor's office to the old fire station is truly appreciated if you would graciously all agree to give that to us. And I thank you again for giving us this opportunity to come this afternoon.

**Senator Tina Muna Barnes** – Saina Ma'åse' Mayor Tayama. Acting Chief.

Acting Fire Chief John L. Wusstig – Buenas yan Hafa Adai Madam Chair, honorable Senators, thank you for having me. My name is John L. Wusstig. I am a Battalion Chief of the Guam Fire Department and currently the Acting Fire Chief (proceeded to read from the letter (written testimony) which is attached). Concluded by saying, "Thank you."

Senator Tina Muna Barnes - Saina Ma'åse' Chief and at this time I'd ask Mr. Sablan.

Angel Sablan, Executive Director, Mayors Council of Guam – Angel Sablan Executive Director of the Mayor's Council of Guam and good afternoon to all of you. I would like to take this opportunity to thank Sen. Aline Yamashita and of course our oversight Chairman Senator Tina Muna Barnes, Senator McCreadie, Senator Ada, Senator Duenas and I'm sure everyone will support this legislation. If there is any change to this legislation that I might suggest, it's just to change the implementation date to immediately instead of 6 months after. And I say that because we've already actually anticipated on working with this building since the Governor told us that there would be an Executive Order. So we've actually already purchased some material already. And I don't want the termites to eat those materials up before we start working on the renovations that could be done. And I'm sure that the Mayor here is going to be working with a public private partnership with the "lease McDonald's of Guam" to see whether or not they can also assist us in retiling or doing some work with the office. I am sure that they are more than happy, they have done some work with Agat in the past and I'm sure they will continue to do so, so, we appreciate all your support. And this is just one way of taking the resources we already have that another agency does not need that the Mayor's Council of Guam would happily take and use and turn it into something that is useful. And also again, whatever we have, turn it around and give it to other nonprofit groups or agencies that may need them and make them make it useful. So it's a win-win situation for everybody all around. And we certainly thank you for your support of this legislation

Senator Tina Muna Barnes – Si Yu'os Ma'åse' talo Mr. Sablan.

Senator Brant McCreadie – Thank you madam chairperson. I particularly like the "immediately" transfer the fire station over to you guys. But one question is if you did get your wish, which I commend the author and co-sponsor for reintroducing this bill because I think it should happen. But if you were to get your wish and get that immediate attention to switch offices, is there any way that we could somehow use our networks or someone use their networks to mitigate the problem of the termites so when sanctuary gets in how long are they going to have to wait for their grants to become available to fix it? Would we be able to then go in and say well, so and so knew

a termite owner and he took care of the termite problem for now therefore we have a little more time to work on the grant but sanctuary or whoever else needs to use it as an outreach, they can go ahead and it's safe for them to use.

Angel Sablan, Executive Director, Mayors Council of Guam – Certainly Senator, the Agat Mayor's Office is totally gutted with termites so it just has to be torn down internally—just all the walls removed even before sanctuary could do anything with it. And so the faster the office moves out into the Agat fire station the faster that we can clear that out and have it ready for, in the meantime have Sanctuary be applying for their grants to make it work

**Senator Brant McCreadie** – Would you consider it immediately a safety problem for your current office?

**Angel Sablan, Executive Director, Mayors Council of Guam** – It has been a safety problem.

**Senator Brant**: **McCreadie** – Therefore you would need the immediate assistance to move. Thank you Madam Chair.

Senator Tina Muna Barnes – In our commitment of moving this forward and making this happen for the village of Agat, we have also committed to seeing what we could do to expedite it to see how we can get it on this session agenda so know that we are going to try very, very hard, and with the support of her working closely with our office we will submit the paperwork. The team here has committed to making sure that the reporting and transcriptions are done immediately, as soon as we adjourn they said that we have got it in motion. I s there anybody else who wishes to have comments or submit? 

I am Mayor Carol S. Tayama, Mayor of Agat and I come here today to testify in favor of Bill No. \$18-31. This legislation will only place into statute an administrative move that was supposed to be accomplished through Executive Order and a Memorandum of Understanding with the Guam Fire Department. We have opted to take this route as time is of the essence to get repairs done to the existing Mayor's office and to utilize a building that has essentially become abandoned and an eyesore along Agat's main thoroughfare.

The existing Agat Mayor's Office is located at the Agat Community Center complex and is completely overtaken by termites. In our effort to make do with the resources we have on hand, I personally requested from Governor Eddie Calvo to transfer the old Agat Fire Station to the jurisdiction of the Agat Mayor's Office for use as our office, since the Guam Fire Department vacated the property to their new location in Agat. In turn I would allow Sanctuary, Inc. a non-profit organization that has been serving the youth of Agat for many years, to occupy the current Mayor's offices for their programs. While I realize that the facility is termite-ridden, Sanctuary is in a position to apply for grants to refurbish and rehabilitate the space that will be given to them through federal grants. Governor Calvo was very supportive of the request and in fact had instructed his Chief of Staff and the Guam Fire Department to accomplish my request.

The Agat Municipal Planning Council and the Agat Mayor's Office do not have the funds to completely repair the current offices. We have, however, determined that it would be in our interest and in the interest of the people of Agat to use the former Agat Fire Station as the Mayoral offices because it would require less funds and in fact is more spacious and adequate for our needs.

I thank Senator Aline Yamashita for going the extra step to make this transfer permanent. Just as I have been doing for the past 8 years, she too is making great things happen for Agat. I know that all the Senators of *I Mina Trentai Uno na Liheslaturan Guahan* will support and pass Bill 518-31. The only amendment I will request is to adjust the effective date of the transfer after it becomes law to "immediately" instead of "not later than 120 days". We would like to begin this process as soon as we can.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guahan finds that the Agat Mayor has requested to have administrative jurisdiction of the former Agat FireStation located along Route 2 just south of the mayor's office. The Agat Mayor and Vice Mayor are in need of a new office as the facility they now occupy is infested with termites, and a lack of funds prevents them from obtaining immediate services to remedy the situation.

I Liheslatura findsthat in October 2010, the Guam Fire Department commissioned a new fire station located near Erskin Drive, Agat, and for the past five months, after a verbal agreement was made between the Agat Mayor and the Guam Fire Department Chief, the Mayor's office began cleaning and removing debris from the former fire station with the intent to use the building for administrative functions of the Mayor's office.

I Liheslatura further finds that after the Mayor's office is relocated to the former fire station, the Mayor intends to allow non-profit organization Sanctuary, Inc. to utilize the mayor's current facility as an outreach center to service the families of the six (6) southern villages of Agat, Santa Rita, Umatac, Merizo, Inarajan and Talofofo. The NPO's status allows them to qualify for federal assistance to renovate/rehabilitate the current mayor's office for its use.

Section 2. Transfer of Property. I Liheslaturan Guahan does hereby transfer the former Agat Fire Station, located on Lot # 443 Part 1-2 New R-1, Route 2, Agat, from the administrative jurisdiction of the Guam Fire Department to the administrative jurisdiction of the Office of the Mayor of Agat. The transfer of said administrative jurisdiction shall become effective no later than one hundred twenty (120) daysfrom the enactment of this Act.

**Section 3.** Item (1) of §40113(b), Chapter 40 of Title 5, Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read:

"(1) The Mayor of Agat is responsible for the Agat Recreation Area and, San Jose Circle, and the former Agat Fire Station building."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that in the event the aforesaid sum of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) awarded to UNKNOWN OWNERS shall have remained deposited in the registry of this court and unclaimed for five (5) years from the date of entry of this judgment, then and in that event said sum shall be deposited in the Treasury in the name and to the credit of the United States of America, all pursuant to Section 2042 of Title 28, United States Code.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the District Court of Guam shall pay to the said Defendants the respective sums hereinabove awarded, now on deposit in the registry of this Court, by checks drawn on said funds countersigned by the Judge of this Court, upon taking proper receipts therefore, and when all of the said sums have been so paid, the Clerk shall thereupon note upon the docket that this judgment has been paid in full.
