








I. COMMITTEE PROCEEDINGS

Chairman Benjamin Cruz: As long as we're dealing with Senator Frank's bills, we'll do a quick one on 245-32, an Act to Add a Chapter 1 Title 1 Guam Code Annotated;

relative to naming the Tiyan Football Field in honor of Mikkel Tan I. Vy. It's 295. Mr. Blas, Ken Laguana, Dave Elliott, Herbert Salumbides, Joyceline. Okay, why don't we start with...okay, go ahead. Oh Paul, go ahead I'm sorry. Is your red light on?

Paul Blas: Good afternoon Senator, [reads testimony verbatim]. Thank you.

Chairman Benjamin Cruz: Thank you, that was very touching. Anybody else wish to speak? Please.

Herbert Salumbides: Hi Senators, I don't have a written testimony but I'm here to support this bill, the renaming of the Tiyan field to Mikkel Tan I. Vy Field. My name is Herb Salumbides. I've been a youth football coach for numerous years. I have been coaching the kids, keeping them off the street. I've also been with a baseball coach, supporting the kids, coaching the kids. The Tan I. Vy family has been very supportive of us. I mean numerous years - I've seen all the improvement they've done, I've seen how they get involved in the community. So, I'm very supportive of this bill. Thank you.

Chairman Benjamin Cruz: Thank you and I want to thank the both of you for all the work you do with our young people.

David Elliott: Hi Senator. My name is Dave Elliott. All the football organizations we have on this island, each handles a minimum of a hundred and fifty kids. I think what Mr. Herb was saying is that we help them at night. We have practice every single day. It gets them off the streets, keeps them busy. So for all us volunteers, we volunteer ourselves, everyday and every night to teach these kids not only the game of the sport of football but discipline, which they carry on throughout their lives as they get older. We instill discipline in them at a young age. At night, there's no way for them to do any selfish acts or be out there in the community destructing public buildings and stuff. I am also in support of this bill, as a volunteer, as part of the board members of this great organization. Mr. Tan and his family are very, very helpful with us in getting this field operational. We're at a point now where we can actually have games on this field. A couple of years ago, there's no way we can have games on this field. We can have games now due to the support of the foundation.

Chairman Benjamin Cruz: Kenneth Laguana.

Kenneth Laguana: Hey, how are you doing Senator? My name is Ken Laguana. I'm the person that the board tasked to put this together, so I'm here to answer questions just in case you have any questions for us. I am here to answer that, just to kind of cap that off. I'm in support of the bill. The thing is, what he was trying to say is that the field was deemed unplayable and unsafe for a long time. About a hundred loads of dirt were donated. A lot of the backhoes, a lot of the people that put this together and Cencio was very instrumental behind this since we talked to him. And it didn't happen overnight, it happened every year. Every year there were projects, things to make the field playable and safe. Taking care of the kids and supporting us. And in turn, it not only took care of

the kids, which was his intention at first, it took care of the community because it went from soccer and now the National Guard is using it.

Since it was completed and done - I'm not sure if you remember that sign on the side of the road, the field restoration project. Remember Senator when I was bugging you when you had oversight at the time? [inaudible] of support in getting the field playable. We could not play games on that field for three years. It took Cencio's inspiration, support, assistance and us going out there to get this field playable and the support of the community as well.

Now, it's completed. It's done and we're now improving on it. Everyone is utilizing the field and as in the statement there, it's been beneficial to everybody; the Miller Football League, the Bud League, the Japan team that came over, for the Women's team, the Rugby team, and the soccer teams and now the National Guard uses it. Now, it's a field that everybody is able to use. We currently take care of the maintenance, by the way. Under our MOU, we handle the maintenance of the field. We're responsible, we keep the cleanliness, we cut the grass, all that stuff we handle that. We handle all that, not DPR. So we have relieved them from that responsibility under the MOU and continue to keep that responsibility of maintenance of the field. So, that's pretty much what I'm going to say.

Chairman Benjamin Cruz: Thank you again to the both of you, to all the coaches, the staff. Thank you for all the work you do with the young people. And yes, I know Cencio and he's doing all the signs throughout the island, the village entry. So, we have some other people, I'm not sure if they want to speak. Oh this panel? Go ahead.

Senator Thomas Ada: Hi, I'm sorry, your first name again? Paul, you indicated in your testimony that the Tan foundation also made improvements to the baseball, the two baseball fields...

Paul Blas: Yes sir.

Senator Thomas Ada: So I'm just curious, why are we limiting it to the football field if they are basically providing improvements to the three fields?

Paul Blas: Kenneth, do you want to answer that?

Kenneth Laguana: We did approach the Mayor's office because the Mayor has the MOU with the baseball field. At the time, he did the improvements, he never looked for any recognition in anyway. It was done in the past but we can account for the football field because we have an MOU with DPR and the Mayor was invited for the baseball field as well when we introduced this bill. However, the Mayor never attended that meeting about the naming of the baseball field. So that's a separate entity because of the MOU. It's directly with DPR and the Mayor. The football field is completely under DPR's control. So our MOU reflects with DPR and that's the reason we introduced it as the football field.

Senator Thomas Ada: You heard on the previous bill when the question was asked about whether the Barrigada Municipal Planning Council ever gave a resolution, saying yeah we have no problem naming this field after... does this organization have any kind of concurrence I guess, written concurrence from the Municipal Council?

Kenneth Laguana: The response I got from DPR was that all of Tiyan is under DPR, not all of them, but the area that we're speaking - the football field. So, I can only account for the football field. The football field is completely under DPR and not the Mayor's Council or the Mayor of Barrigada., I can't account for the baseball field. But the baseball field MOU was agreed to between DPR and the Mayor of Barrigada. So I would assume that it was still under DPR's control at the time.

Senator Thomas Ada: Ok, thank you.

Chairman Benjamin Cruz: Thank you very much, again for all your work. Cinda, Gwenn Aguon, Eileen Guerrero? Vincent Guerrero? If anybody wants to speak, you can come up. If not, we can take it as in support. Okay, thank you.

This concludes the testimony on Bill No. 295-32 (COR). There being no additional individuals to present any additional testimony, this Committee will continue to remain open for the acceptance of any additional information or public testimony on the bill discussed. BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. §849.7 is hereby added to Chapter 8, Article 1 of Title 1 of the Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:

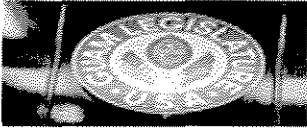
“§849.7. Mikkel Tan I. Vy Foundation Football Field.

(a) Renaming Tiyan Football Field. Tiyan Football Field, located in the municipality of Barrigada, Guam, shall hereafter be known as the "Mikkel Tan I. Vy Foundation Football Field."

(b) Name Change, Statutory References. Any provisions in the statutes referencing the Tiyan Football Field is amended to read: "Mikkel Tan I. Vy Foundation Football Field."

(c) Signs and Formal Designation of "Mikkel Tan I. Vy Foundation Football Field." I Maga'láhen Guåhan [the Governor], the Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation, the Mayor of Barrigada, the members of the Barrigada Municipal Planning Council shall cause to be erected appropriate nameplates or signs designating the Tiyan Football Field as the "Mikkel Tan I. Vy Foundation Football Field."

1 Further, at such ceremony as I Maga'lahañ Guåhan [the Governor], the
2 Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation, the Mayor of Barrigada, the
3 members of the Barrigada Municipal Planning Council deem appropriate, said

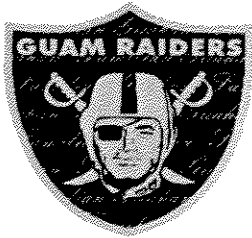

Dear Vice Speaker Cruz,

I would like to start off with a touching story about a young man named Mikkel Tan I. Vy. It started in 2005, Mikkel and his father would drive by our football field every day and see cars along the sidelines with their headlights illuminating the field to allow the kids to practice. Then one evening, Mikkel turned to his father and said, “*why don't we help the kids out and put some lights on the field for them?*”

Mr. Cencio Tan C. Vy, Owner/President of Benson Guam Enterprises Inc., was so touched by his son's interest and compassion that he started a community outreach program. Improvements started immediately:

- For the baseball field - installed lights, installed restrooms/fixtures, painted and provided fencing to complete the restoration program;
- For the football field – installation of lights and building the grandstand.

Unfortunately, Mikkel was not able to attend the completion of these projects due to his untimely passing in that same year (2005). Mr. Cencio, together with his wife, Noriko, established the “Mikkel Tan I. Vy Foundation” in honor of their son.

In 2011, the Guam Youth Raiders humbly requested for assistance to help improve our field. Mr. Cencio, together with Mr. Monito, Manager at Benson, provided support through the Mikkel Tan I. Vy Foundation:

- Replaced the grandstand flooring;

With our MOU with DPR, Mr. Ray Blas, Director, is very supportive and we received great support.

Today, the foundation sponsors the Youth Raiders and we are also known as the Mikkel Tan I. Vy Raiders and we proudly wear the Mikkel Tan I. Vy name on our uniforms in memory of his son. Our organization humbly request for your support of Bill #295-32 in renaming the field to the "Mikkel Tan I Vy Football Field" in memory of this young man who started it all because he wanted to help the kids.

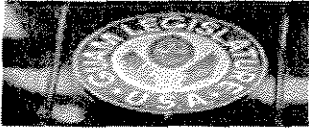

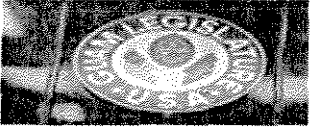

Diabetes forecast points to rise in cases

SUVA (Fiji Times) – Twenty-one years from now, the incidence of diabetes among Fiji's population could be 50 percent, equating to a ratio of one diabetic patient for every healthy person.

This was revealed by medical officer-in-charge and chair of Diabetes Fiji for the Central and Eastern Division, Dr. Lisi Finiasi.

He made the assertion while commenting on predictions made by international medical experts that by 2035, the total number of people suffering

from diabetes around the world could increase to 592 million.

For Fiji, the percentage of diabetics could increase from 30 percent to 50 percent. "So instead of a 3-to-1 ratio, we are looking at a 1-to-1 ratio for diabetes patients," she said.

She said about \$548 billion was spent globally last year to combat diabetes.

Finiasi said local authorities were looking at people between the ages of 40 and 59 years, who were dying prematurely.

"About 5.1 million deaths were recorded globally last

year. This means that every six seconds, a person dies from diabetes."

Affordability

According to Finiasi, the increase in these diseases was because of the affordability of sugar-sweetened beverages and food items.

"We have to make the healthier choice the more affordable choice.

"People don't die of diabetes – they die from the complications of diabetes. We should try to control and prevent these diseases in the first place."

PNG among top 10 countries of smokers

PORT MORESBY (Loop PNG) – Papua New Guinea is one of the top 10 countries in the world with the highest smoking prevalence.

According to the World Health Organization, 60 percent of adult men and 27 percent of women in PNG are current smokers.

WHO country representative Dr. Pieter Van Maaren

says this is a major epidemic that requires urgent and swift action.

"The harm caused by tobacco is not just a set of numbers. It is the loss of mothers, fathers, sisters and brothers. It is the struggle of lifelong treatment for chronic illnesses. It is the trial that families must bear as breadwinners are unable to work."

And it is at the cost to the nation as a whole, as it tries to meet the heavy burden that the tobacco industry places on the economy," Maaren said.

He urged the government to support the proposed amendments to the Tobacco Control Act and to increase taxes on tobacco products which will discourage people from smoking and stay healthy.

Pacific forum leaders asked not to smoke, promote healthy initiatives

KOROR (RNZI) – Health authorities in Palau have asked Pacific Island Forum leaders to lead the way and not to smoke during this week's summit.

The program manager of non-communicable diseases in Palau, Edolem Ikerdeu, says several health initiatives are being promoted, including a request not to smoke, and a morning walk for the leaders on Wednesday in the main street of the capital, Koror.

Ikerdeu says Palau President Tommy Remengesau will lead the walk.

She says the summit's organizing committee is ensuring leaders will only be eating healthy food during their stay in Palau.

"For the entirety of the meetings, we recommended that we have this physical activity with the president to promote, of course, active living. We also recommended healthy eating so we put out dietary guidelines for Palau to all the vendors responsible for preparing the food for all

the meetings." Meanwhile, a Fiji academic in Australia says the Pacific Islands Forum is going through a turbulent phase but it is still a key body in the region.

Delegates are gathering in the Micronesian state of Palau for the 45th Forum summit, which opens on Tuesday.

A leaders' retreat will be held on Thursday, when a new secretary general is expected to be named as a replacement for Tuiloma Neroni Slade, who is finishing a six-year term. Brij Lal, of the Australian National University, says the

forum remains relevant.

"It might have become a bit unwieldy but I think that it certainly has a role to play in terms of providing technical advice, expert advice on topics and subjects that individual countries in the region might not have the capacity. You do have expertise in the forum and I think it is a question of harnessing those for strategic purposes."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. §849.7 is hereby added to Chapter 8, Article 1 of Title 1 of the
Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:

“§849.7. Mikkel Tan I. Vy Foundation Football Field.

(a) Renaming Tiyan Football Field. Tiyan Football Field, located in the
municipality of Barrigada, Guam, shall hereafter be known as the "Mikkel Tan I.
Vy Foundation Football Field.”

(b) Name Change, Statutory References. Any provisions in the statutes
referencing the Tiyan Football Field is amended to read: "Mikkel Tan I. Vy
Foundation Football Field.”

(c) Signs and Formal Designation of "Mikkel Tan I. Vy Foundation Football
Field.” I Maga’lahen Guåhan [the Governor], the Director of the Department of
Parks and Recreation, the Mayor of Barrigada, the members of the Barrigada
Municipal Planning Council shall cause to be erected appropriate nameplates or
signs designating the Tiyan Football Field as the "Mikkel Tan I. Vy Foundation
Football Field.”

1 Further, at such ceremony as I Maga'láhen Guåhan [the Governor], the
2 Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation, the Mayor of Barrigada, the
3 members of the Barrigada Municipal Planning Council deem appropriate, said
4 "Mikkel Tan I. Vy Foundation Football Field" shall be officially named, and a
5 plaque bearing the name, picture and brief history of the contributions of "Mikkel
6 Tan I. Vy Foundation Football Field" shall be affixed within a suitable spot on or
7 above the designated area."
