

II. TRANSCRIPTION OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Senator Tina Muna-Barnes

Hafa Adai gentlemen, manana si yu'us the Committee on the Guam U.S Military Relocation, Veterans Affairs, Homeland Security and Judiciary is called to order, it's about 9:02 a.m. I'd like to thank my colleague Senator Tony Ada for being with me this morning. Thank you, and on the agenda ladies and gentlemen we will be discussing Bill No. 321-32(COR) An Act to Amend §80.50 to Chapter 80 of 9GCA, and it's relative to increasing the fines for felonies, misdemeanors and violations. This bill was introduced by my colleague Senator Tony Ada, or V. Anthony Ada, and Senator Chris Duenas. At this time I will, I do have some folks in the audience, I'd like to thank them for coming here this morning. Good morning. They will be presenting oral testimony, but before I call them up I will go ahead and ask Senator Ada to at least give us a brief description of the bill.

Thank you Madam Chair. Thank for conducting this public hearing this morning, and this on bill 321-32 an act to amend §80.50 to Chapter 80 of 9GCA relative to increasing fines for felonies, misdemeanors and violations. Madam Speaker, Madam Chair the fines for most violations of Guam's criminal code have not been changed since they were created, and much of Guam's criminal laws based on the model penal code which Guam adopted in the beginning of 1970. At the time the fines or felonies were established at one thousand dollars (\$1000). Misdemeanors were five hundred (500) to one thousand (1000) and petty misdemeanors and violations were below five hundred (500).

I was led to believe that it would make no sense to increase the fines since most criminals will not be able to pay for them, especially those who received prison time, but like many states, Guam law allows criminals to pay off their fines through community service. Under Guam law, the number of community service hours to convert a fine is the amount of the fine divided by the minimum wage.

In 1970, the minimum wage was one dollar and sixty cents (\$1.60) per hour. In that year a felon who is required to pay a one thousand dollar (\$1000) fine, would have been required to work six hundred and twenty five (625) hours of community service to pay off that fine.

Today at seven twenty five (7.25) an hour, the felon would work only one hundred thirty eight (138) hours to pay off that fine. In January of next year when the minimum wage goes up to eight twenty five (8.25) an hour the felon will be required to work only one hundred twenty one (121) hours to pay a one thousand (\$1000) fine.

This bill raises the fines similar to similar levels where crimes to levels similar of most states. Even with the new levels, if this bill is enacted, criminal fines, Guam fines would be much less than the limit Congress enacted for federal crimes. First and second-degree felonies will be increased from ten thousand (10,000) to one hundred thousand (100,000). Third degree felonies will be increased from five thousand (5000) to ten thousand (10,000), and misdemeanors will be increased from one thousand (1000) to five thousand (5000). Petty misdemeanors and violations will be twenty five hundred dollars (\$2500) and lower.

Those criminal acts that where the fines are specific within their sections of law will be increased by factor equal to the change in the consumer price index since over the time the fine was created by statute. And that's my presentation here Madam Chair. Thank you. I look forward to the testimonies that those who are willing to testify on the bill.



Si Yu'us Ma'ase' Senator Ada, and at this time to present testimony, on behalf of the Judiciary, I invite Mr. Joshua Tenorio, from the Attorney General's office, attorney Phil Tydingco, and Ms. Ann Keith I guess with the Judiciary? Please, you're more than welcome to come up. Ok, ok. And I will go ahead and welcome you if we need to ask you any questions. Ok, Mr. Tydingco. Since you signed up first Mr. Tenorio just go ahead and say your full name, state your full name, where you are from, and if you're in support or not in support of the bill.

Mr. Joshua Tenorio

Good morning Madam Chair and Senator Ada. My name is Joshua Tenorio, I'm the acting administrator of the courts for the Judiciary of Guam. As you noted, with me is Attorney Ann Keith, staff attorney for the court. You know the Judiciary, you know the question whether or not the judiciary is for or against, I guess it's more appropriate to say that the Judiciary respects fully that it is the legislature's authority to determine punishment, fines, levels of fines, and fees that will be assessed to those that are convicted of crimes in our communities. So, I want to point that out that the Judiciary doesn't take a position for or against the legislation.

I do note, however, that both Madam Chair and Senator Ada have been authors of legislation that I believe that have significantly improved the administration of justice on Guam and for Senator Ada, definitely in the area of domestic violence and how we deal with those things in the Judiciary. So, you know we do thank the attention, the continued constant attention that the senators have continued to place on improving the method of administering justice on Guam.

We just like to point out that with at least with regards to the last portion of the bill, which deals with paragraph F and tying fines covered by paragraph F with the Guam Consumer Price Index, there are perhaps a couple things that we can work together on. We do have a team that's analyzing this to see what the true impact would be. It's not clear when the calculation or who would make the calculation. I think those are all administrative things that we definitely will work with the committee and with Senator Ada to discuss going forward. Therefore, I do not have any further testimony on this bill.

So based on your comment Mr. Tenorio, we can look at the mark up on this provision or work closely with that. I do know that were coming against budget session, but if we want to get this on the agenda hoping that Senator Ada's office and you guys can come up with something sooner than later.

Absolutely.

Ok, Saina Ma'ase'. Mr. Tydingco.

Mr. Phil Tydingco

Yes, Good morning. Buenas Senator Tina Muna-Barnes and Senator Tony Ada. Phil Tydingco, on behalf of Attorney General Rapadas and the Office of the Attorney General. With regard to bill 321-32, of course we support any amendments that assist the effective and efficient administration of justice under criminal justice system and of course the fines like other parts of our law are in need of update. Although, I would request that we do have a markup meeting to discuss some of the provisions.

Especially, if well at least from a prosecution viewpoint I per see delays and challenges in our sentencing because there are a lot of offenses that specific fines enumerated by the particular offense or statute and then, you know, then everybody is going to say ok what's the Guam Consumer Price Index? Courts gonna order someone to go do this or do that, it's going to hold up things, and so I would say, if this has to go quickly on the floor it has to someone do a floor amendment and take that out. I mean, for now, until we figure out how it works because otherwise it's just gonna slow the process down I think sentencing. I'm just giving you the practical, on the ground everyday situation.

It's a great idea to adjust them, but perhaps, perhaps what we need to do is just simply go through the statutes of all those that have specific fines and just update them ourselves. You know the ones that say ok, you know for reckless its one hundred (\$100) well then we should just identify all of those and just amend them. You know, you'd have other bills to do that, so that would be my recommendation.

And then the other input I, the only thing that that raises concern that I just wanted us to research is that increasing the fines with misdemeanors and petty misdemeanors. I just wanted to make sure that the fact that you increase the fines does not, you know, in other jurisdictions not necessarily Guam, but when you increase the penalties even fines, what appears to be minor offences, that can be argued and I have argued this way, by the way, in other jurisdictions that that turns it into a felony or a higher crime.

So, again that's a technical argument or it renders it to be more serious, so I just again I don't know the case. It's been awhile since, that's over 20 years ago that I remember arguing that, you know, in either Hawaii or L square so I, that was the only thing that popped out for me was that misdemeanors and petty misdemeanors, does increasing the fines, you know, render it to a felony for not so much for the category, but for example, a petty misdemeanor generally is not tried before a jury, but the fact that you put a felony type fine on it may render that individual to demand a right to a jury when he shouldn't have a right to a jury because its just a petty misdemeanor or a violation. So, again I would say those are issues that we should address because otherwise it's fine.

The other thing is I would differentiate between felony first and felony second. I'd have different fine amounts, maximum fine amounts, because we do sort of have a maximum jail amounts for, you know, felonies five (5) to twenty (20) and second is, you know, three (3) to whatever fifteen (15), you know, so why don't we just make, you know, the first is hundred thousand (100,000) and maybe second degree should be fifty thousand (50,000). I don't know, I'll leave the numbers up to you, but rather than just saying a hundred (100) for both first or second, so that we can distinguish between the, you know, one is meant to be higher than the other. You know, just sort of a logic issue. Otherwise, we support the concept and maybe we can do a quick markup. Ok, thank you.

Senator Tina Muna-Barnes

Thank you, Attorney Tydingco. Any questions from the author?

Senator Tony Ada

No Madam Chair, I would just like to thank the court and the AG's office for their testimony here today, and I look forward to the markup to where we can come together and make this a better bill.

Senator Tina Muna-Barnes

Thank you Senator Ada, on behalf of Senator Frank Aguon, I do want to just apologize on his behalf. He was trying to get in, but apparently the flights got delayed so he should be in this evening, and he asked me to cover as his vice chair. I was glad to do that. Dear Chairman Aguon:

Hafa Adai! Thank you for providing me with the opportunity to provide testimony on Bill No. 321-32(COR), AN ACT TO AMEND §80.50 TO CHAPTER 80 OF 9GCA RELATIVE INCREASING FINES FOR FELONIES, MISDEMEANORS AND VIOLATIONS.

It is the Legislature's prerogative to fix sentences for crimes, including fines and the Judiciary declines to comment on the increase in fines proposed in this legislation.

We are unclear as to the impact of the last portion of the proposed law regarding varying the fines pursuant to paragraph (f) with the Guam Consumer Price Index. The Judiciary appreciates that this provision is designed to accommodate the possibility that inflation might dilute these fine amounts in the future. However, the Guam Consumer Price Index is adjusted on a quarterly basis and therefore as a prospective measure, it is unclear who should be applying such calculations.



AN ACT TO AMEND §80.50 TO CHAPTER 80OF 9GCA RELATIVE INCREASING FINES FOR FELONIES, MISDEMEANORS AND VIOLATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 80.50 of Chapter 80 of 9GCA is amended to read: "\\$80.50. Fines & Restitution as Sentence Allowed: Limited. A person who has been convicted of an offense may be sentenced to pay a fine or to make

- A person who has been convicted of an offense may be sentenced to pay a fine or to make restitution not exceeding:
 - (a) Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00), when the conviction is of a felony of the first or second degree
 - (b) Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), when the conviction is of a felony of the third degree;
 - (c) One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), when the conviction is of a misdemeanor;
 - (d) Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00), when the conviction is of a petty misdemeanor or and One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) when the conviction is of a violation;
 - (e) Any higher amount equal to double the pecuniary gain to the offender or loss to the victim caused by the conduct constituting the offense by the offender. In

such case the court shall make a finding as to the amount of the gain or loss, and if the record does not contain sufficient evidence to support such a finding the court may conduct a hearing upon the issue. For purposes of this Section, the term "gain" means the amount of money or the value of the property derived by the offender and the term "loss" means the amount of value separated from the victim;

(f) Any amount specifically authorized by statute.

All statutory fines, covered by paragraph (f) of this Section are hereby adjusted by a factor equal to the percentage change in the *Guam Consumer Price Index* from the date the fine was established to the effective date of this Section. For purposes of this Section, the *Guam Consumer Price Index* is the index of the periodic changes of consumer prices published by the Bureau of Statistics and Plans or its predecessors agencies."
