COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 327-32 (COR) was introduced on May 1, 2014 by Senator Tina Muña Barnes, and was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Municipal Affairs, Tourism, Housing and Hagåtña Restoration and Redevelopment Authority on May 1, 2014.

The Committee on Municipal Affairs, Tourism, Housing and Hagåtña Restoration and Redevelopment Authority convened a public hearing on Bill No. 327-32 (COR) on Thursday, May 15, 2014 at 11:00 AM in I Liheslatura's Public Hearing Room.

Public Notice Requirements

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via e-mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on Thursday, May 8, 2014 (5-Day Notice), and again on Tuesday, May 13, 2014 (48-Hour Notice).

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 11:09 AM.

Chairperson – Good morning and Manana Si Yu'os. We are back from recess and it's about 11:09 a.m. right now. We are going to hear Bill No. 327-32 (COR) "An act relative to amending 12 GCA § 5135 (D) to place the GHURA 500 Lot Sale Fund under the custodianship, discretion and purview of the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority". I want to note for the record, that pursuant to 5 GCA, Chapter 8, Subsection 8107, public hearing notices were sent on Thursday, May 8, 2014 which is five (5) working days prior and then a second notice was sent on Tuesday, May 13, 2014 which is forty-eight (48) hours prior. I would like to note that if there's anyone out there that would like to provide written testimony, they could deliver it to our office at 155 Hesler Place, Hagåtña or email it to senator@tinamunabarnes.com or fax it to 472-3400. I would like to thank the Chairperson of the GHURA Board for being here and I'd like to acknowledge the presence of the President of the Guam Housing Corporation. We have both housing entities and thank them for being here. Let's go ahead and get started. Mr. Sablan let's go ahead and start with you. Please proceed.

Mr. David Sablan – Thank you very much Madam Chair and again I appreciate very much on behalf of GHURA this opportunity to provide testimony and basically in support of this bill for

purposes of continuing our programs up there at GHURA. Thank you as well for recognizing my colleagues. We were actually in a board meeting and decided to recess and come down here to show our full support of this bill. Let me read my testimony, which is very brief. Mr. Sablan reads his testimony, which is attached for review. Thank you Madam Chair.

Chairperson - You're very welcome Mr. Sablan. Mr. Duenas?

Mr. Michael Duenas – For the record, my name is Michael Duenas and I am the Executive Director of the Guam Housing and Renewal Authority. I will go ahead and read my written testimony, which is attached for review. Thank you Madam Chair.

Chairperson – Thank you Mr. Duenas, Mr. Benavente?

Mr. Martin Benavente – Good morning and Hafa Adai Chairwoman Muna Barnes and all other members that are not here but are watching me on TV. Mr. Benavente reads his testimony, which is attached for review.

Chairperson – Si Yu'os Ma'ase Mr. Benavente. I want to say that when the opportunity came to introduce this bill, and with the cooperation between both housing entities, this bill would be a win win. I want to say that if anybody would want to submit additional testimony, please send it to us at 155 Hesler Place or you may email it or fax it. I know that it's not oversight, but could I ask both agencies to give me an update and sneak peak of what's to come?

Mr. David Sablan – One thing that I want to say that it's always great working with the President of the Guam Housing Corporation, Mr. Martin Benavente. He's been an excellent partner in everything that we do. We absolutely enjoy working with him and his board and his people at Guam Housing. We have about 2,500 people on the waiting list of the section 8 program. We are looking at ways and means of how to increase that voucher number so that we can address those needs. We are looking at the probability of establishing a lottery system. I think that this system would help these individuals, rather than the current system. It's not fair to some people, so we will be developing a policy or program and maybe implement that in 2015. So that's one of the highlights. Otherwise, it's just business as usual. We just finished our audit. We had our meeting with the auditor and he's given us some areas that we need to work on. Not so much on our operational side as our administrative side. We just finished our insurance program. We were paying more than 250,000 per year in premiums and never evaluated the assets of GHURA. It took about a year to put that whole program together. We put out the RFP and made the award by the end of April and we saved 162,000 in premium costs to GHURA. That's another cost savings of GHURA. Our staffing plan has been pretty

much ok as far as meeting the challenges of GHURA. That's pretty much we've been working on the past month, maybe a year. Thank you!

Chairperson – Thank you! Mr. Benavente?

Mr. Martin Benavente – Most of what Mike and I are working on are top secret but if I tell you now we might have to shoot you. (said with a laugh) But like I said in my testimony, we're working on building model homes and hopefully tomorrow will be submission day. The contractors are coming in and putting in proposals and we'll look at it. There a lot of things that are still on the back burner. Most of the things that Mike and I can do until the end of this year, we promise to come back in January to continue doing what we do. The partnership with GHURA is great. We do have many serious problems when it comes to homelessness and we have to come back to the Legislature to help us out. We see more people out on the streets. We try to pick up where GHURA has left off, but it's not easy because we are not funded as much as they are. We could list all the projects that Mike and I have worked on but you know what they are because you've been invited to all the ribbon cuttings. We continue to be excited to do what we do but it's going to take a lot of work with the Legislature. Thank you!

Chairperson – Thank you very much Mr. Benavente. With all that said, between GHURA and Guam Housing we continue the collaboration to turn abandoned homes into sustainable housing. We could look at all of that and continue to work together to find creative resources, and it may not be easy, but we will continue to have that collaboration with both entities. Thank you very much. If there are no other comments, I will call this bill duly heard and adjourned at 11:40AM.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO AMENDING 12 GCA § 5135 (D) TO PLACE THE GHURA 500 LOT SALE FUND UNDER THE CUSTODIANSHIP, DISCRETION AND PURVIEW OF THE GUAM HOUSING AND URBAN RENEWAL AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. Guam Public Law 15-12, codified at 12 GCA § 5133, authorized the Governor of Guam to transfer to the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority ("GHURA") five parcels of property located in Dededo and Yigo for the development of five hundred (500) single family homes for sale and/or lease to Guam residents who agree to own and occupy the units. Guam Public Law 16-90, codified at 12 GCA § 5135, authorized GHURA to sell each of the five hundred (500) home lots at a price of \$2,500.00.

Receipts from any sale of the lots shall be deposited in a special fund, known as the GHURA 500 Lot Sale Fund, kept separate and apart from other funds of the government of Guam. The Custodian of this Fund is the Director of the Department of Administration, and monies from the Fund may only be expended upon appropriation by law. The Director of the Department of Administration shall report the fund balance to the Legislature at the beginning of each quarter.



GHURA was created as a public body corporate and politic within the meaning of the United States Housing Act of 1937, as amended, and a local public agency within the meaning of Title I of the Housing Act of 1949, as amended. GHURA has experienced a shortfall of funding which has hindered its ability to undertake capital improvement projects, and for general operational expenses.

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GHURA seeks to utilize funds from the GHURA 500 Lot Sale Fund to fund capital improvement projects, and for general operational expenses. To do so, GHURA needs legislation amending 12 GCA § 5135 to place the Executive Director of GHURA as the custodian of the GHURA 500 Lot Sale Fund, and to authorize expenditures of the Fund within the discretion and purview of the Board of Commissioners of GHURA.

Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to amend 12 GCA 5135 (d) to place the GHURA 500 Lot Sale Fund under the custodianship, discretion, and purview of GHURA.

Section 2. Sale of lots Authorized. 12 GCA § 5135 (d) is hereby *amended* to read:

**§ 5135. Sale of Lots Authorized.

Receipts from any sale shall be deposited in a special fund kept separate and apart from other funds of the government of Guam. The fund shall be known as the "GHURA 500 Lot Sale Fund." The custodian of the fund shall be the Director of the Department of Administration Executive Director of the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority. The fund balance shall be reported to the Legislature at the beginning of each quarter. The fund may be expended only upon appropriation by law within the discretion and purview of the Board of Commissioners of the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority."

Section 3. Effective date. This act shall be effective upon enactment.

The Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA) is pleased to offer its support and insight into this discussion of Bill 327-32(COR) which intends to render custodianship of the GHURA 500 Lot Sale Fund to GHURA.

GHURA supports the work of the Committee and particularly the intent of Bill 327-32(COR). Custodianship of the GHURA 500 Lot Sale Fund to GHURA is fundamentally logical.

The Authority has been responsible for the development and disposition of the GHURA 500 Affordable Homeownership Program for the last 35 years. and activities in line with GHURA's goals. The Authority has the financial and operational capacity to continue

to manage the GHURA 500 Fund in line with GHURA's mission.

In its 52 year history, GHURA has contributed to the development of strong, stable neighborhoods throughout

Guam. GHURA is built upon a solid governance structure beginning with the GHURA Board of Commissioners

empowered with the authority to guide Executive Management and staff in pursuit of its mission. GHURA's

Board of Commissioners supports the Administration's mission of meeting the need for 3000 additional

homes.

Our challenge today is not only to continue to develop affordable housing. We must now find ways to sustain

the existing stock of affordable housing by exploring ways to finance the rehabilitation of projects developed

over the last 50 years.

We believe in our ability to continue the good work of affordable housing management at GHURA. We

maintain an ongoing commitment to build upon our financial and development skills to meet the needs of our

On behalf of the Board of Commissioners of the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority, I submit this testimony in support of Bill 327-32(COR) pertaining to the transfer of custodianship of the GHURA 500 Lot Sale Fund to GHURA from the Department of Administration.

led this quiet but effective organization to provide quality services to the people of Guam. With your support

of Bill 327-32(COR), GHURA will be afforded the opportunity to leverage the GHURA 500 Lot Sale funds to

continue to meet the programmatic and operational needs of the Authority.

for entertaining this legislation, on behalf of the people of Guam.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO AMENDING 12 GCA § 5135 (D) TO PLACE THE GHURA 500 LOT SALE FUND UNDER THE CUSTODIANSHIP, DISCRETION AND PURVIEW OF THE GUAM HOUSING AND URBAN RENEWAL AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. Guam Public Law 15-12,

codified at 12 GCA § 5133, authorized the Governor of Guam to transfer to the

Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority ("GHURA") five parcels of property

5 located in Dededo and Yigo for the development of five hundred (500) single

family homes for sale and/or lease to Guam residents who agree to own and

occupy the units. Guam Public Law 16-90, codified at 12 GCA § 5135, authorized

GHURA to sell each of the five hundred (500) home lots at a price of \$2,500.00.

Receipts from any sale of the lots shall be deposited in a special fund, known

as the GHURA 500 Lot Sale Fund, kept separate and apart from other funds of the

government of Guam. The Custodian of this Fund is the Director of the

12 Department of Administration, and monies from the Fund may only be expended

13 upon appropriation by law. The Director of the Department of Administration

shall report the fund balance to the Legislature at the beginning of each quarter.



GHURA was created as a public body corporate and politic within the meaning of the United States Housing Act of 1937, as amended, and a local public agency within the meaning of Title I of the Housing Act of 1949, as amended. GHURA has experienced a shortfall of funding which has hindered its ability to undertake capital improvement projects, and for general operational expenses.

GHURA seeks to utilize funds from the GHURA 500 Lot Sale Fund to fund capital improvement projects, and for general operational expenses. To do so, GHURA needs legislation amending 12 GCA § 5135 to place the Executive Director of GHURA as the custodian of the GHURA 500 Lot Sale Fund, and to authorize expenditures of the Fund within the discretion and purview of the Board of Commissioners of GHURA.

Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to amend 12 GCA 5135 (d) to place the GHURA 500 Lot Sale Fund under the custodianship, discretion, and purview of GHURA.

Section 2. Sale of lots Authorized. 12 GCA § 5135 (d) is hereby *amended* to read:

"§ 5135. Sale of Lots Authorized.

- (d) Receipts from any sale shall be deposited in a special fund kept separate and apart from other funds of the government of Guam. The fund shall be known as the "GHURA 500 Lot Sale Fund." The custodian of the fund shall be the Director of the Department of Administration Executive Director of the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority. The fund balance shall be reported to the Legislature at the beginning of each quarter. The fund may be expended only upon appropriation by law within the discretion and purview of the Board of Commissioners of the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority."
- **Section 3. Effective date**. This act shall be effective upon enactment.
