COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

Bill No. 331-32 (LS): An act to add a new § 10315 to Chapter 10, Title 5 of Guam Code Annotated; relative to the online and public disclosure of medical license issued by Guam Board of Medical Examiners.

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 331-32 (LS) was introduced by Senator Tina R. Muña Barnes on May 6, 2014, and subsequently referred to the Committee on General Government Operations and Cultural Affairs on May 7, 2014.

The Committee on General Government Operations and Cultural Affairs convened a public hearing on Tuesday, July 22, 2014, at 6:00PM in the Guam Legislature Public Hearing Room. The hearing for Bill No. 331-32 (LS) began at 6:14PM and ended at 6:18PM.

All legal requirements for public notices were met, with requests for publication sent to all media and all Senators on July 14, 2014, and July 20, 2014, via email. Copies of the hearing notices are appended to the report.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairperson Benjamin J.F. Cruz announced Bill No. 331-32 (LS) and called on Senator Tina R. Muña Barnes to provide sponsor statement.

Senator Tina R. Muña Barnes thanked Chairperson Cruz and proceeded to provide her statement:

"This is Bill 331-32 (LS), an act to add a new §13015, Chapter 10, Title 5 of [the] Guam Code Annotated. It is relative to online and public disclosure of medical

licenses issued by the Guam Board of Medical Examiners (GBME). I just want to state for the record, Mr. Chair, that this bill is meant to provide the public with the access to a list of all licensed medical professionals on Guam. Currently, I want to note for the record that there is a list provided by the Guam Medical Association (GMA) of their members and there is also one that is provided by the Guam Medical Society (GMS) of their members. However, there is no combined list of all the medical professionals that are licensed here on Guam. GMA and GMS provided great service by publishing their membership directories, but there needs to be at least one list compiled by the GBME of all the individuals who hold Guam licenses, and I do know that there are some folks here that may want to chime in on this bill. There have been request in the past to see if there was any official government listing, and all we're asking is that this listing of all medical professionals be uploaded into an email or [allow for its electronic access] so that those who are looking for medical practitioners or medical professionals [can view and look over the information].

Chairperson Cruz thanked Senator Muña Barnes and recognized Mr. Carlos B. Pangelinan who appeared before the Committee.

Mr. Carlos B. Pangelinan greeted members of the Committee and introduced himself, remarking that he is appearing as a private citizen and as resident of Barrigada. He stated that he supports Bill No. 331-32 (LS) and clarified that although the GBME provides an online list, it only contains the names and license expiration dates. He corroborated that GMA and GMS do publish lists but stated that he knows from his work in the health industry that much of that information is not always accurate, "particularly with respect to board licensure" and their current physical location. He explained that many doctors may be here for a short period of time and may be listed in directories, but do not actually maintain active practice in Guam. He concluded that there is a need for an official source for information on medical practitioners and this endeavor is within the ability and scope of duties of GBME.

Senator Frank Aguon, Jr. asked Mr. Pangelinan what type of information should be included in the database, in addition to license expiration dates.

Mr. Pangelinan stated that consumers should have access to "just about everything that's allowable publicly", to include information about malpractice cases. He added that there are statutes in place that are not currently implemented. He concluded that that there is no reason why people in Guam should not have access to at least the "basic things"—such as licensure, specialty, expiration, address, and contact information—that is already available to people all over the country.

Chairperson Cruz, on the account that there were neither additional questions from the Committee nor was there any one else present to testify, considered Bill No. 331-32 (LS) heard.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Within six (6) calendar months of the enactment hereof, the Guam Board of Medical Examiners shall publish and update on a quarterly basis on its website a listing of licenses issued pursuant to Chapter 12, Article2, Title 10 of the Guam Code Annotated (*Physicians Practice Act*), including the license holder's name, primary work address, phone number, specialty, initial date of licensure, license status, and board certifications."

Section 2. Enactment. This Act is effective upon enactment.

The bill teeks to require the Guam Board of Medical Examiners (GBME) to publish, via its website, a listing of licenses issued to include the license holder's name, primary work address, phone number, specialty, initial date of licensure, license status and board certifications. 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COMMENTS TO BILL 331-32(LS)

BILL NO. 331-32 (LS) IS AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 10315 TO CHAPTER 10, TITLE 5 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED (GCA); RELATIVE TO THE ONLINE AND PUBLIC DISCLOSURE OF MEDICAL LICENSES ISSUED BY THE GUAM BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS (GBME).

Section 1 of the bill proposes to establish a special requirement to be imposed whereby the GBME will be mandated to publish and update quarterly on the GBME website a listing of licenses issued pursuant to Chapter 12, Article 2, Title 10 of the GCA, 'Physicians Practice Act, to include the:

- 1) License holder's name
- 2) Primary work address
- 3) Phone number
- 4) Specialty
- 5) Initial date of licensure
- 6) License status
- 7) Board certifications

According to information received from Department of Public Health and Social Service (DPHSS) on May 21, 2014, the GBME does not currently have their own dedicated website. Rather, DPHSS has established and maintained an existing listing of current medical licenses on the DPHSS website at: http://www.dphss.guam.gov/document/gbme-renewal-listing-2013— Additionally, DPHSS states that to establish a physician online management system for the GBME will cost an estimated \$165,000.

In summary, the overall intent of this bill is to mandate the GBME to maintain a list, per the specific requirements outlined in the bill, to establish, maintain and update a listing of current medical licenses. The Health Professional Licensing Fund collects an average of \$181,800 annually and is a revolving fund. An estimated \$165,000 would be necessary just to establish such a system. To be in compliance with such legislation would incur a significant fiscal impact to the GBME's Health Professional Licensing Fund which would include any additional costs for the expected and subsequent maintenance of an exclusively established website for the GBME.

The bill seeks to require the Guam Board of Medical Examiners (GBME) to publish, via its website, a listing of licenses issued to include the license holder's name, primary work address, phone number, specialty, initial date of licensure, license status and board certifications. See attached Comments.

COMMENTS TO BILL 331-32(LS)

BILL NO. 331-32 (LS) IS AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 10315 TO CHAPTER 10, TITLE 5 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED (GCA); RELATIVE TO THE ONLINE AND PUBLIC DISCLOSURE OF MEDICAL LICENSES ISSUED BY THE GUAM BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS (GBME).

Section 1 of the bill proposes to establish a special requirement to be imposed whereby the GBME will be mandated to publish and update quarterly on the GBME website a listing of licenses issued pursuant to Chapter 12, Article 2, Title 10 of the GCA, "Physicians Practice Act, to include the:

- 1) License holder's name
- 2) Primary work address
- 3) Phone number
- 4) Specialty
- 5) Initial date of licensure
- 6) License status
- 7) Board certifications

According to information received from Department of Public Health and Social Service (DPHSS) on May 21, 2014, the GBME does not currently have their own dedicated website. Rather, DPHSS has established and maintained an existing listing of current medical licenses on the DPHSS website at: http://www.dphss.guam.gov/document/gbme-renewal-listing-2013. Additionally, DPHSS states that to establish a physician online management system for the GBME will cost an estimated \$165.000.

In summary, the overall intent of this bill is to mandate the GBME to maintain a list, per the specific requirements outlined in the bill, to establish, maintain and update a listing of current medical licenses. The Health Professional Licensing Fund collects an average of \$181,800 annually and is a revolving fund. An estimated \$165,000 would be necessary just to establish such a system. To be in compliance with such legislation would incur a significant fiscal impact to the GBME's Health Professional Licensing Fund which would include any additional costs for the expected and subsequent maintenance of an exclusively established website for the GBME.

Introduced by:

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AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 10315 TO CHAPTER 10, TITLE 5 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED; RELATIVE TO THE ONLINE AND PUBLIC DISCLOSURE OF MEDICAL LICENCES ISSUED BY THE GUAM BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new § 10315 is hereby *added* to 5 GCA Chapter 10 to read as follows:

"§ 10315. Special Requirement for Medical Licenses.

Within six (6) calendar months of the enactment hereof, the Guam Board of Medical Examiners shall publish and update on a quarterly basis on its website a listing of licenses issued pursuant to Chapter 12, Article2, Title 10 of the Guam Code Annotated (*Physicians Practice Act*), including the license holder's name, primary work address, phone number, specialty, initial date of licensure, license status, and board certifications."

Section 2. Enactment. This Act is effective upon enactment.
