#### COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

#### I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 401-32 (COR)- "AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER V (O)(3) OF PUBLIC LAW 32-181 RELATIVE TO THE PROTECTION OF GUAM'S NATURAL RESOURCES," by Senator Dennis G. Rodriguez, Jr. introduced on September 22, 2014; and was subsequently referred to the Committee on Rules; Federal, Foreign & Micronesian Affairs; and Human & Natural Resources; and Election Reform on September 22, 2014.

Senator Rory J. Respicio, Chairperson of the Committee on Rules; Federal, Foreign & Micronesian Affairs; and Human & Natural Resources; and Election Reform convened a public hearing on Bill No. 401-32 (COR) on Monday, September 29, 2014, 9:00 A.M. in the Legislature's Public Hearing Room to receive public testimony on the measure.

In accordance with the Open Government Law, notices were disseminated to all senators and to all main media broadcasting outlets, first on September 22, 2014 and again on September 25, 2014.

#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Mariquita F. Taitague, Director, Department of Agriculture, provided two (2) written statements on the bill. (Please see attached)

Senator Rory J. Respicio called the public hearing to order at 9:00 A.M. deferred to Senator Dennis G. Rodriguez, Jr. to provide opening remarks the main sponsor of Bill No. 401-32 (COR).

#### Senator Dennis G. Rodriguez, Jr.

The intent of the bill is that this provision in the budget law will ensure there is no interruption and that the identification of these funds now will remain in that capacity to protect Guam's natural resources. Working with the Department of Agriculture, the revisions that we have in this bill will ensure that the three conservation recruits are there and their services will not be interrupted after tomorrow.

The only amendment I would make to this bill is to add more co-sponsor which we can do on the Session Floor,

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER V (0)(3) OF PUBLIC LAW 32-181 RELATIVE TO THE PROTECTION OF GUAM'S NATURAL RESOURCES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Item (o)(3) of Chapter V, public Law 32-181 is hereby amended, to read:

"Protection of Guam's Natural Resources. The sum of Four Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$425,000) shall be allocated from the General Fund appropriation in Subsection (o)(1) to the AGR to pay for salaries and benefits for up to eight (8) additional, Competitive Limited Term Appointment, Forestry I positions to assist in the protection of Guam's wild land, conservation reserves and urban areas, and to further promote and support the health and productivity of Guam's forest lands. This allocation shall be used in part and as necessary to pay for salaries and benefits for the three (3) Competitive Limited Term Appointment, Conservation Officer I Recruit positions presently filled beyond the federal grant funding, which expires September 30, 2014, with no interruption in service to enforce Guam's laws and regulations for the protection of fish, wildlife, endangered and threatened species and forestry laws. AGR shall submit a status report, no later than six (6) months following the enactment of this Act, to I

Maga'lahen Guahan and to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guahan relative to the expenditure of funds allocated herein."

**Section 2. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall become immediately effective upon enactment.

Re: Justification for Keeping the 3 Conservation Officer Recruits – Bill 401-32 (P.L. 32-181)

Hafa Adai! Senator Rodriguez is considering a bill that would retain the current Conservation Officer Recruits by amending the current Budget Laws FY15 language from Conservation Officer 1 to Conservation Officer Recruit. We provide the justification for this amendment.

- 1. The initial funding source that paid for the salaries of the recruits came from a Coral Reef Initiative funding. It was incumbent upon the Government of Guam to find funding to utilize the skills initially paid for by the federal grant. Note: Should attach original MOU that states that GovGuam find funding.
- 2. By amending Public Law 32-181 from Conservation Officer I to Conservation Recruit, the Department would save approximately \$12,000 with the hiring of the three (3) Conservation Recruit Limited Term Appointments.
- 3. The three Conservation Officer Recruits have and are being trained to handle the issues and challenges that a Conservation Officer would be tasked with. These Recruits have been trained in a wide-range of duties. The Government of Guam through the program had invested time and resources to train these officers. They function as an important component and step to the protection of Guam's natural resources.
- 4. In the short time they have been with the Department (DAWR) these officers have learned and trained in a wide range of duties from basic arrest procedures, writing arrest reports, surveillance, and other conservation officer procedures.
- 5. They have had the opportunity to be in the general public for out-reach, and school presentations. The Officers possess the important combination enthusiasm and assertiveness important in law enforcement.

- 6. They are being qualified to handle firearms.
- 7. The Department has already invested a lot of time and effort to train the officers in the duties and responsibilities required of an officer. If the Department is unable to maintain the officers, and the hiring of officers has to be reinitiated, it may be the better part of the FY15 before officers can be interviewed, tested and then hired. More time and effort would have to be invested to retrain new officers. We have officers who have passed the initial phase, and we have trained them, as well.
- 8. The current Officer Recruits are very enthusiastic and willing group of individuals. Their enthusiasm and training will provide the Department/Division with the capacity to protect Guam resources. The current pool of veteran officers makes it important that the Department begins training its officers now.

Thank you for the opportunity to replace a slowly senescent law enforcement force, with vibrant energetic officers should not be missed. It would be unfortunate if we lose them.

## Bureau of Budget & Management Research Attachment to Fiscal Note No. 401-32 (COR)

#### Comments:

Sec. I of Bill 401-32 (COR) amends Chapter V (0)(3) of P.L. 32-181 (FY15 Budget Act), to change the positions to be funded in FY15 from Conservation Officer I(s) to Conservation Officer Recruits. The projected fiscal impact on the General Fund (GF) in FY15 is approximately \$118,755 but would increase to \$133,423 in FY16 and prospectively assuming the same three (3) FTE(s) are promoted to Conservation Office I(s). FY15 costs would be covered by the funding authority in the aforementioned Chapter of P.L.32-181. It should be noted that the affected positions are currently 100% federally-funded and were filled via Competitive Limited Term Appointments (CLTA). The Bureau is highly concerned with the proposed shift of federally-funded positions to the GF as it may set precedence for other Government of Guam departments to take similar action in order to retain employees hired via CLTA. The proposed Bill also contradicts provisions of P.L. 28-187 relative to CLTA hiring as, in this case, it provides added employment protection to limited-term employees and thereby places undue financial pressure on the Government of Guam's GF. Needless to say, the Department has existing mandates that must be met and which the aforementioned appropriation can be applied towards. These include additional personnel and equipment needed by the Department's Animal Health Division to increase its stray animal control efforts as well as funding needs in the Forestry Division due to non-availability of federal matching funds in FY15.

Pursuant to P.L. 32-181, the Department of Agriculture was budgeted \$425,000 to recruit 11 Competitive Limited Term Appointment (LTA) positions (8 Forestry Aide I and 3 Conservation Officer I) for FY2015. These positions are needed in these Divisions - Forestry & Soil Resources and Aquatic & Wildlife Resources, Law Enforcement Section to replace positions vacated due to separation, retirement or resignation. Thus, the nature of these new hires is a temporary status subject to expiration September 30, 2015.

The Department's General Fund budget ceiling in the amount \$3,00,986 covered existing employees and vacant positions of three (3) Animal Control Officer I with 2 vehicles in the Animal Health Division that village Mayors' continue to insist the dire need of increasing personnel in compliance with local laws that cannot be accomplished with only 3 existing employees to oversee the demand of residents, communities and other entities for assistance for either biting dogs, stray, running at large, sick, vicious or carcasses on roadways or government properties. The approved budget of \$3,424,312 (GF) is inclusive of \$94,955 for Guam Animal In Need (G.A.I.N.), a Non-Profit Organization, and \$425,000 for the new LTA positions, with a remainder of \$2,904.357. This is a reduction of \$105,629 from our budget ceiling.

This reduction from our budget impacted our ability to increase much needed manpower and to fulfill the duties and responsibilities in the Animal Health Division.

The Forestry and Soil Resources is a federal/local match program, and unfortunately, will not receive federal match funding for their FY2014 but with 100% General Fund. (Their match fund grant period would have started June 1, 2014 – May 31, 2015.) The Conservation Recruits (3) were recruited at LTA status with a 100% Federal Fund and will expire 30 September 2014.

## Bureau of Budget & Management Research Attachment to Fiscal Note No. 401-32 (COR)

#### Comments:

Sec. I of Bill 401-32 (COR) amends Chapter V (0)(3) of P.L. 32-181 (FY15 Budget Act), to change the positions to be funded in FY15 from Conservation Officer I(s) to Conservation Officer Recruits. The projected fiscal impact on the General Fund (GF) in FY15 is approximately \$118,755 but would increase to \$133,423 in FY16 and prospectively assuming the same three (3) FTE(s) are promoted to Conservation Office I(s). FY15 costs would be covered by the funding authority in the aforementioned Chapter of P.L.32-181. It should be noted that the affected positions are currently 100% federally-funded and were filled via Competitive Limited Term Appointments (CLTA). The Bureau is highly concerned with the proposed shift of federally-funded positions to the GF as it may set precedence for other Government of Guam departments to take similar action in order to retain employees hired via CLTA. The proposed Bill also contradicts provisions of P.L. 28-187 relative to CLTA hiring as, in this case, it provides added employment protection to limited-term employees and thereby places undue financial pressure on the Government of Guam's GF. Needless to say, the Department has existing mandates that must be met and which the aforementioned appropriation can be applied towards. These include additional personnel and equipment needed by the Department's Animal Health Division to increase its stray animal control efforts as well as funding needs in the Forestry Division due to non-availability of federal matching funds in FY15.

Pursuant to P.L. 32-181, the Department of Agriculture was budgeted \$425,000 to recruit 11 Competitive Limited Term Appointment (LTA) positions (8 Forestry Aide I and 3 Conservation Officer I) for FY2015. These positions are needed in these Divisions - Forestry & Soil Resources and Aquatic & Wildlife Resources, Law Enforcement Section to replace positions vacated due to separation, retirement or resignation. Thus, the nature of these new hires is a temporary status subject to expiration September 30, 2015.

The Department's General Fund budget ceiling in the amount \$3,00,986 covered existing employees and vacant positions of three (3) Animal Control Officer I with 2 vehicles in the Animal Health Division that village Mayors' continue to insist the dire need of increasing personnel in compliance with local laws that cannot be accomplished with only 3 existing employees to oversee the demand of residents, communities and other entities for assistance for either biting dogs, stray, running at large, sick, vicious or carcasses on roadways or government properties. The approved budget of \$3,424,312 (GF) is inclusive of \$94,955 for Guam Animal In Need (G.A.I.N.), a Non-Profit Organization, and \$425,000 for the new LTA positions, with a remainder of \$2,904.357. This is a reduction of \$105,629 from our budget ceiling.

This reduction from our budget impacted our ability to increase much needed manpower and to fulfill the duties and responsibilities in the Animal Health Division.

The Forestry and Soil Resources is a federal/local match program, and unfortunately, will not receive federal match funding for their FY2014 but with 100% General Fund. (Their match fund grant period would have started June 1, 2014 – May 31, 2015.) The Conservation Recruits (3) were recruited at LTA status with a 100% Federal Fund and will expire 30 September 2014.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Item (o)(3) of Chapter V, public Law 32-181 is hereby amended, to read:

"Protection of Guam's Natural Resources. The sum of Four Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$425,000) shall be allocated from the General Fund appropriation in Subsection (o)(1) to the AGR to pay for salaries and benefits for up to eight (8) additional, Competitive Limited Term Appointment, Forestry I positions to assist in the protection of Guam's wild land, conservation reserves and urban areas, and to further promote and support the health and productivity of Guam's forest lands. This allocation shall be used in part and as necessary to pay for salaries and benefits for the three (3) Competitive Limited Term Appointment, Conservation Officer I Recruit positions presently filled beyond the federal grant funding, which expires September 30, 2014, with no interruption in service to enforce Guam's laws and regulations for the protection of fish, wildlife, endangered and threatened species and forestry laws. AGR shall submit a status report, no later than six (6) months following the enactment of this Act, to I

Maga'lahen Guahan and to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guahan relative to the expenditure of funds allocated herein."

**Section 2. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall become immediately effective upon enactment.
