



## COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

**Bill No. 405-32 (COR):** An act to amend § 4108(c)(2) of Chapter 4, Title 4 of the Guam Code Annotated, relative to sick leave.

### **I. OVERVIEW**

**Bill No. 405-32 (COR)** was introduced by Senator Tina R. Muña Barnes and Senator V. Anthony Ada on October 7, 2014, and subsequently referred to the Committee on General Government Operations and Cultural Affairs on the same day.

The Committee on General Government Operations and Cultural Affairs convened a public hearing on Thursday, November 20, 2014, at 3:30PM in the Guam Legislature Public Hearing Room. The hearing for Bill No. 405-32 (COR) began at 5:00PM and ended at 5:04PM.

### **II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION**

Chairperson Benjamin J.F. Cruz announced Bill No. 405-32 (COR).

Vice Chairperson Tina R. Muña Barnes provided her sponsor statement:

*"Si yu'us ma'ase, Mr. Chair and thank you Vice Speaker for giving me the opportunity to speak on Bill No. 405-32 (COR), as introduced by myself, and*

getting bipartisan support from Senator V. Anthony Ada. This is an act to amend § 4108 (c)(2) of Chapter 4, Title 4 of the Guam Code Annotated, relative to sick leave. And if I may, this just provides that employees be given the opportunity to provide health care to immediate family members and they're required to exhaust their annual leave and compensatory time prior to utilizing their sick leave. This just gives us an opportunity for family members and employees to use sick leave to take care of a loved one. I did have Mrs. Chelsa [Muña-Brecht], who was here to testify, and I have her [testimony]. She did send a note [saying] she couldn't wait and she had to go back to work. And if I could just read the testimony?"

**Vice Chairperson Muña Barnes** read **Mrs. Chelsa Muña-Brecht's** written testimony, which is been appended to this report.

**Chairperson Cruz**, on account that there was no one present to provide testimony, considered Bill No. 405-32 (COR) as heard.

### III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on General Government Operations and Cultural Affairs to which was referred "Bill No. 405-32 (COR) - T.R. Muña Barnes / V.A. **AN ACT AMEND §4108 (c)(2) OF CHAPTER 4, TITLE 4 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO SICK LEAVE.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

**Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that often times employees find the need to be absent from duty to provide for the health care of an immediate family member and are currently required to exhaust all annual leave and compensatory time prior to utilizing their sick leave. *Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that employees should not be penalized for having to care for immediate family members who are seriously ill or injured by having to exhaust their annual leave and compensatory time prior to being allowed to use accrued sick leave.

**Section 2. §4108 (c) (2) of Chapter 4, Title 4 of the Guam Code Annotated is amended to read:**

(c) When Allowed. Sick leave with pay is allowed whenever:

(1) The employee is compelled to be absent from duty on account

1 of physical or mental illness; injury; mental health examination,  
2 counseling or treatment; pregnancy; childbirth; medical, dental or  
3 optical examination or treatment; or because of quarantine due to his  
4 own or another's illness.

5 (2) The employee is compelled to be absent from duty to provide  
6 health care for a member of the employee's immediate family as a  
7 result of serious illness or injury ~~and the employee has exhausted all~~  
8 ~~annual leave and compensatory time available.~~

9 (A) Serious illness or injury means an urgent condition that  
10 is certified by the attending physician as requiring hospitalization,  
11 institutionalization, or extended home care in which the person  
12 needs the constant administration of special medical care or  
13 support.

14 (B) Immediate family member means the employee's  
15 spouse, common law, parents, parents-in-law, grandparents,  
16 brothers, sisters, children, grandchildren, any step or adoptive  
17 parents, adopted children or grandchildren of both the employee  
18 and the spouse, a guardian or person in loco parentis.

Hafa Adai, I would like to voice publicly, my support for Bill 405-32 relative to allowing employees of the Government of Guam to use sick leave, rather than annual leave, when caring for immediately family members. Senator Muña Barnes, I am grateful to you for keeping parents and families in mind with this introduction.

I, as the eldest grandchild, have always been the primary agent for my Okinawaan grandmother. I make all her medical appointments and take her to them as well. I am her agent, her driver, and her translator for all things medical. I am also a mother to two boys, ages 8 and 9. Any parent will agree with me and attest to the fact that if you have one sick child, you will likely have a sick household at some point. Last month alone, I spent three days out of one week caring for one son and then spent three days of the following week caring for the other. During this time, I had to expend annual leave. Even with a doctor's note, I could only use my annual leave.

I strongly believe that rather than hoarding this sick leave until I am of retiring age, I should be able to use this leave to care for my family. I value my annual leave because I use that time to spend with my children and husband during summer and Christmas breaks. My husband works as an educator so he is on the same schedule as my children and it is much harder for him to take time off to care for our kids. He is an excellent educator who is dedicated to his students. We make every effort to ensure he does not leave his students without a teacher. I admire that about him.

Making this change to the legislation will not cost the government any extra money. All it will do is allow family members to use sick leave to care for the sick and annual leave to be with their families. I hope that this legislature will keep families in their minds and vote yes when this bill makes it to session floor.
