I. OVERVIEW: The Committee on Health & Human Services, Health Insurance Reform, Economic Development and Senior Citizens conducted a public hearing on October 24, 2014. The hearing convened at 2:30pm in I Liheslatura's Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration **Bill 412-32 (COR)- An act to amend Title 10, Chapter 3, Article 2 of the Guam Code Annotated to add a new subsection 3218(a)(25) to require abortion providers to include gestational age in abortion reports. Introduced by Sen. Frank B. Aguon, Jr.**

The public hearing on agenda item Bill No. 412-32 (COR) was called to order at 3:24pm.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION.

Senator Aguon: Thank you very much Mr. Chairman and also thank you for having the public hearing on this particular measure and this an act to amend certain provisions within the Guam Code Annotated to require abortion providers to include gestational age in abortion reports.

And I'd like to highlight that Bill 412-32(COR) is pro-information legislation and is neither pro-life or pro-choice. The intent of this bill is to ensure that Guam is in line with current states with similar laws. I also want to close with this statement that reporting the gestational age of an unborn child terminated by abortion is valuable information for public health purposes, tracking this information may lead to important to public health intervention and I believe that Mr. James Gillan is also supportive of that particular statement.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that the Government of Guam has a public health interest in knowing the
4 gestational age of unborn children terminated by abortion on Guam. The purpose
5 of this act (the "Act"), therefore, is to add the gestational age of the unborn child
6 terminated by the abortion to the information that abortion providers must include
7 in the abortion reports which they presently submit to the Guam Memorial
8 Hospital Medical Records Section pursuant to 10 G.C.A. §3218.

9 **Section 2. A New Subsection 3218(a)(25).** Title 10, Chapter 3, Article 2,
10 **Section 3218, Subsections (a)(23) through (a)(25) of the Guam Code**
11 **Annotated are amended to read as follows:**

12 "(23) Signature of attending physician; ~~and~~

13 "(24) Certification provided for in this section; and

1 **(25) Gestational age, as measured in weeks, of the unborn child**
2 **terminated by the abortion.**”

3 **Section 3. Severability.** Any provision of this Act held to be invalid *or*
4 unenforceable by its terms or as applied to any persons or circumstance, *shall* be
5 construed so as to give it the maximum effect permitted by law unless such holding
6 shall be one of utter invalidity or unenforceability, in which event, such provision
7 *shall* be deemed severable herefrom and *shall* not affect the remainder hereof *or*
8 the application of such provision to the other persons *not* similarly situated *or* to
9 other dissimilar circumstances.

10 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* take effect thirty (30) days after
11 enactment.
