COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 413-32 (LS) was introduced on October 16, 2014 by Senator Michael T. Limtiaco. The bill was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns, and Future Generations on October 16, 2014.

The Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations convened a public hearing on November 18, 2014 at 9:33 a.m. in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was Bill 413-32 (LS). The hearing was adjourned at 11:50 a.m.

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via electronic mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on November 10, 2014, and again on November 14, 2014. Notice was also posted on *I Liheslatura's* website beginning on November 10, 2014.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Michael San Nicolas convened the hearing for Bill 413-32 and yielded to the bill's main author, Senator Michael Limtiaco, for an opening statement.

Senator Michael Limtiaco explained that the bill contains much of the information included in Bill 362, which was vetoed by the Governor. He stated that the main change is changing the statute of limitations on the removal of the real property tax lien.

Mana Silva Tajjeron read a prepared statement indicating the Guam Economic Development Authority's support of the bill. (*see attached*)

John Camacho submitted written testimony to indicate the Department of Revenue and Taxation's support of the bill (*see attached*). He reiterated the main points of the Department's testimony.

Chairman San Nicolas asked if individuals are still coming in to apply for the property tax exemptions.

Mr. Camacho stated that applications for the exemptions are still being accepted and, pending any change in law, the applications which were submitted after the current deadline will also be accepted.

Attorney Phil Tydingco spoke on behalf of the Attorney General's Office in favor of the bill. He stated that the law needs to be changed in order to extend the deadline to accept applications for exemptions.

Chairman San Nicolas commented that he was happy that the Department of Revenue Taxation was continuing to accept applications for exemptions. He asked Mr. Camacho if the appropriate deadlines would still be met if the Legislature passes the bill in December.

Mr. Camacho stated that the deadline that needs to be met is not until February 2015.

Chairman San Nicolas thanked the panel for their participation and adjourned the hearing.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Real Property Tax Exemption Filing Deadline Extension.**

3 For tax year 2014, notwithstanding any other provision of law, rule, or regulation
4 to the contrary, residents of Guam who qualify for reduced tax rates pursuant to 11
5 GCA §§24110, 24112, 24401, and 24402 as of March 15, 2014, and who have not
6 already availed themselves of permanent exemptions, may file with the assessor's
7 office on or before December 31, 2014. Any application for reduced tax rates filed
8 after March 15, 2013 and on or before December 31, 2014 pursuant to the
9 provisions affected by this Section *shall* be effective as though it were filed on or

1 before March 15, 2013, with respect to *both* the rates of tax provided under 11
2 GCA §24110 or 11 GCA §24112, as applicable, *and* the fixed level of the
3 valuation of the applicant's residential property pursuant to 11 GCA §24113, for
4 U.S. citizens who qualify under 11 GCA §§24110 and 24112.

5 **Section 2. Failure to Supply Identifying Number.** §24109, Article 1,
6 Chapter 24, Title 11, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *added*, to read:

7 **"§24109. Failure to Supply Identifying Number.**

8 Every person required to pay property taxes, *shall* provide his
9 taxpayer identification number to the Department. If any person fails to
10 comply with such requirement, such person *shall*, unless it is shown that
11 such failure is due to reasonable cause and not to willful neglect, pay a
12 penalty of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each failure. The Department
13 may make use of the taxpayer identification number for intern al purposes
14 only, to include, but not be limited to the assessment and collection of
15 taxes."

16 **Section 3. Removal of the Real Property Tax Lien.** §24204 of Article 2,
17 Chapter 24, Title 11, Guam Code Annotated hereby *amended*, to read:

18 **"§24204. Same: Removal.**

19 For tax years prior to 2014, Aafter thirty (30) years succeeding the
20 time, heretofore ~~or hereafter~~ and for tax years after 2013, after ten (10) years

1 succeeding the time, hereafter, when any tax becomes a lien, if the lien has
2 not been otherwise removed, then the lien ceases to exist and the tax is
3 conclusively presumed to have been paid. The tax collector shall mark the
4 tax paid in the records."

5 **Section 4. Effect upon Enactment: Payments Made Prior to**
6 **Enactment for Liens Ten (10) Years or Older.** No payment made prior to the
7 date of enactment of this Act to the government of Guam *shall* be held invalid due
8 to the provisions of §3 of this Act.

9 **Section 5. Extended Administrative Timeline.** Notwithstanding any
10 other provision of law to the contrary, for the 2014 Real Property Tax Year *only*,
11 the Preliminary Assessment Roll shall be issued on or before February 2, 2015,
12 appeals may be filed from February 16, 2015 to March 16, 2015, the Board of
13 Equalization shall certify the 2014 Assessment Roll on or before March 31, 2015,
14 the first installment of taxes shall be paid on or before April 20, 2015, the second
15 installment of taxes shall be paid on or before May 20, 2015, any late payment
16 shall be subject to the penalties under §§24701 and 24702 of Chapter 24, Title 11,
17 Guam Code Annotated, and the publication of the delinquent list pursuant to
18 §§24801 and 24802 of Chapter 24, Title 11, Guam Code Annotated, shall be on or
19 before June 8, 2015.

1 **Section 6. Public Notice of the Extension of Exemptions Filing**

2 **Deadline.** The Department of Revenue and Taxation shall publish notice of the
3 extended filing deadline for the exemptions pursuant §1 of this Act not later than
4 fifteen (15) days following the enactment of this Act in a newspaper of general
5 circulation and post a copy of such notice at each mayor's office.

6 **Section 7.** Any rules and regulations promulgated by the Director of the
7 Department of Revenue and Taxation governing the process of the sale of tax sold
8 property by operation of law shall be promulgated pursuant to the Administrative
9 Adjudication Law.

10 **Section 8.** The Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation *shall*
11 be authorized to administratively take action to collect and resolve delinquent
12 property taxes.

13 **Section 9. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to
14 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such
15 invalidity *shall* not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which *can* be

3 **Section 2. Failure to Supply Identifying Number.** §24109, Article 1,

5 **“§24109. Failure to Supply Identifying Number.**

6 Every person required to pay property taxes, *shall* provide his
7 taxpayer identification number to the Department. If any person fails to
8 comply with such requirement, such person *shall*, unless it is shown that
9 such failure is due to reasonable cause and not to willful neglect, pay a
10 penalty of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each failure. The Department
11 may make use of the taxpayer identification number for internal purposes

13 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, tax returns, tax
14 information, or other tax records pursuant to the administration of the Real
15 Property Tax are not ‘returns’ or ‘return information’ for the purposes of
16 United States Code Title 26 §6103, as applied to Guam and are therefore
17 exempt from non-disclosure under that section. The taxpayer identification
18 number associated with a Real Property Taxpayer shall not be disclosed.
19 However, the staff of the Office of Public Accountability acting in their
20 official capacity, may review Real Property Tax return or return information
21 for which the taxpayer identification number has not been redacted, provided
22 the review is conducted within the Department. Upon written request by the
23 Chairman of the Committee with jurisdiction over tax matters in the Guam
24 Legislature or the Public Auditor, the Department shall furnish him with any
25 Real Property Tax return or return information specified in such request,

1 except that any return or return information shall have the taxpayer
2 identification number redacted for all Real Property Taxpayers.”

3 **Section 3. Removal of the Real Property Tax Lien.** §24204 of Article 2,
4 Chapter 24, Title 11, Guam Code Annotated hereby *amended*, to read:

5 **“§24204. Same: Removal.**

6 ~~For tax years prior to 2014, A~~after ten (10) thirty (30) years
7 succeeding the time, heretofore or hereafter or hereafter and for tax years
8 ~~after 2004 2013, after ten (10) years succeeding the time, hereafter,~~ when
9 any tax becomes a lien, if the lien has not been otherwise removed, *then* the
10 lien ceases to exist and the tax is conclusively presumed to have been paid.
11 The tax collector shall mark the tax paid in the records.”

12 **Section 4. Effect upon Enactment: ~~Payments Made Prior to~~**
13 ~~**Enactment for Liens Ten (10) Years or Older.**~~ The amendments made pursuant
14 to §3 of this Act shall not apply to liens over ten (10) years as of the date of
15 enactment of this Act, and n~~No payment made to the government of Guam prior to~~
16 ~~the date of enactment of this Act to the government of Guam~~ *shall* be held invalid
17 due to the provisions of §3 of this Act. The amendments made pursuant to §3 of
18 this Act shall apply to all liens under ten (10) years as of the date of enactment.
19 Not later than one hundred eighty (180) days from the enactment of this Act, the
20 Public Auditor shall audit the tax records of all taxes for which a lien has existed
21 for over ten (10) years and shall issue findings relative to whether any lien
22 recorded is in error. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, if
23 a single lien is found by the Public Auditor to be in error, then all existing liens
24 which have existed for over ten (10) years shall be removed and the tax shall be
25 conclusively presumed to have been paid.

1 **Section 5. Extended Administrative Timeline.** Notwithstanding any
2 other provision of law to the contrary, for the 2014 Real Property Tax Year *only*,
3 the Preliminary Assessment Roll shall be issued on or before February 2, 2015,
4 appeals may be filed from February 16, 2015 to March 16, 2015, the Board of
5 Equalization shall certify the 2014 Assessment Roll on or before March 31, 2015,
6 the first installment of taxes shall be paid on or before April 20, 2015, the second
7 installment of taxes shall be paid on or before May 20, 2015, any late payment

22 be authorized to administratively take action to collect and resolve delinquent
23 property taxes, except that no process for the sale of tax sold property by operation
24 of law shall be initiated pursuant to a lien on the subject property for which the lien
25 has existed for more than ten (10) years until the Public Auditor has completed the

1 tax record audit and issued findings relative to whether any lien recorded is in error
2 pursuant to §4 of this Act.

3 **Section 9. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to
4 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such
5 invalidity *shall* not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which *can* be
6 given effect *without* the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the
7 provisions of this Act *are* severable.



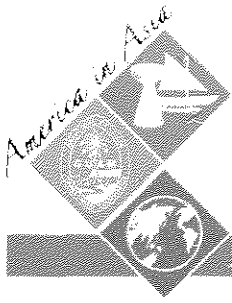

Buenas Yan Hafa Adai:

The Department of Revenue & Taxation (DRT) hereby supports the passage of Bill No. 413-32, as follows:

First, the deadline to extend and allow Guam real property taxpayers the opportunity to avail themselves of all exemptions such as senior citizens, citizens with disabilities, homeowners, etc., up to December 31, 2014 contained herein is supported by DRT. The extension for these exemptions has also impacted other deadlines and the proposed extended dates in Section 5 will accommodate for this change. The proposed dates are as follows:

Proposed Real Property Tax Due Dates for tax year 2014

December 31, 2014	Exemption Application for Senior Citizens, Homeowners, Others, Etc.
On or before February 2, 2015	Print the 2014 Preliminary Assessment Roll
February 16 to March 16, 2015	Filing period for appeals
On or before March 31 st , 2015	Board of Equalization certifies 2014 Assessment Roll
April 20, 2015	1 st Installment deadline
May 20, 2015	2 nd Installment deadline
June 8, 2015	Publish 2014 delinquent list

Second, the addition of Section 24109 requiring persons to provide Taxpayer Identification Numbers (TINs) such as social security or employer identification numbers for the collection of RPT is greatly supported. The section should also include "entity" after "every person" on line 8 in Section 2 so as to include corporations, partnerships, etc. DRT would like to recommend that all owners of real property on Guam complete and submit an affidavit or similar document (to be developed) attesting that all information such as property description, ownership, mailing addresses, etc. are correct and that they are submitting a TIN related to said property. Also, properties with undivided interests, probate, etc. should designate a responsible person or entity authorized to represent said property and submit a TIN for it. This would allow and assists taxpayers who are due an income tax refund the opportunity to have their refunds automatically offset to pay outstanding RPT.

Third, DRT supports with reservation, the change of the statute of limitations from 30 years to 10 years prospectively as stated in Section 3 of this bill. This would mean DRT would still be able to collect assessments for years 2013 and prior, using the 30 year statute of limitation period. DRT, however through Section 8 of this proposed legislation, shall be authorized administratively to collect and resolve delinquent real property taxes. DRT proposes to collect all delinquent taxes via a Real Property Tax Amnesty Program whereby if all delinquent taxes are paid in full within a defined amnesty period, DRT shall waive or abate all other costs associated with the delinquency including penalties, fees and interest. This would insure equity to other taxpayers who may have already paid real property taxes for those prior years while at the same time minimizing the financial burden on Guam taxpayers. If this bill is passed, DRT will then develop the procedures and timelines to implement the Real Property Tax Amnesty program. This Program would also provide a quick infusion of cash for the Territorial Education Facilities Fund. Feel free to contact me should you have other concerns.


