COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The nomination of Andrew S. Tydingco to serve as a member of the Guam Regional Transit Authority Board of Directors was made by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo on July 15, 2014. The nomination packet was received by the Office of Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D., on July 16, 2014. The nomination of Andrew S. Tydingco was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations on July 16, 2014.

The Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations convened a legislative hearing on August 1, 2014 at 10:02 a.m. in *I Liheslatura*'s Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was the nomination of Andrew S. Tydingco. The hearing was adjourned at 11:30 a.m.

Public Notice Requirements

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via electronic mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on July 25, 2014, and July 29, 2014. Notice was also posted on *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*'s website beginning on July 25, 2014.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Michael San Nicolas opened the floor for individuals wishing to provide public testimony on the nomination of Andrew S. Tydingco.

Lisa C. Ogo expressed her support for the nominee. She stated that with Mr. Tydingco's experience, as part of the mass transit system, he understands what changes need to be made. She also mentioned that the nominee not only thinks about the improvements that are needed today but also looks into future improvements.

Roy Rosario spoke about the nominee's ability to make sound decisions and expressed his support for the nomination.

Chairman San Nicolas thanked the members of the public who provided testimony and opened the floor to the nominee.

Andrew Tydingco stated that he previously served as a Board member but resigned for personal reasons. He mentioned that the transit system needs to implement a better scheduling system and also needs to acquire additional buses. Mr. Tydingco spoke about bringing accountability back to the transit system and aggressively moving forward on improving it. He stated that, with new Board members, he is optimistic that the Guam Regional Transit Authority can improve the quality of service to the public.

Chairman San Nicolas stated that he believes that the increased focus on transit services will lead to positive changes in the area of public transportation. He did say, however, that the amount of money currently being spent to fund and operate the GRTA has not been producing the level of service satisfaction expected. Chairman San Nicolas did mention the need for the government of Guam to seriously invest in the GRTA operations but that, with that type of investment, comes the critical need to get the operations right the first time and ultimately meet its overall mission. He asked Mr. Tydingco to explain the direction that transit system needs to go in order to achieve an acceptable level of service satisfaction for its current and potential customers.

Mr. Tydingco mentioned that a more active Board will help to improve things. He also stated that there needs to be more responsibility taken by Board members and the staff with respect to the jobs they have. He stated that there is a need for greater collaboration between the Board and the Legislature. He explained that the authority needs to implement the skills and utilize the technology that they have. Mr. Tydingco also mentioned that the GRTA needs to hire additional staff members.

Chairman San Nicolas asked the nominee how he envisions the mass transit system growing and what direction he sees it going. He mentioned how several ideas are being discussed by members of the community including privatizing GRTA or acquiring government-owned buses to be utilized for public transit.

Mr. Tydingco stated that the GRTA needs to re-establish a "home" for its operations and not rely on contracting out its services. He suggested that the GRTA expand and improve its routes.

Chairman San Nicolas asked about the status of permanently filling the vacant General Manager position. He stated that his office has received requests to amend existing law with regards to the requirements necessary for the position. He mentions that current requirements include the possession of a college degree and that several recent applicants did not meet that require but instead had commensurate experience. He asked the nominee to explain his position on the issue.

Mr. Tydingco stated that he believes applicants from on-island should be given first consideration. He stated that he was part of several of the interviews conducted with applicants from off-island and felt that there were candidates on-island who brought just as much to the table. He stated that he feels that the interim general manager is a good candidate to fill the

position permanently but currently lacks the necessary requirements. Mr. Tydingco mentioned that experience and knowledge is, at times, just as important as possessing a college degree.

Chairman San Nicolas mentioned that he has observed many challenges at GRTA. He stated that many of the internal challenges create uncertainty with operations and whether or not the operations are being run efficiently and effectively. He expressed his concern with the lack of a permanent agency head stating that he would like to see a permanent manager in place so that a goal-based plan to improve services can be implemented.

Senator Tom Ada thanked the nominee for accepting the nomination to the Board. He expressed concern about the size of the current GRTA staff and pointed to that as likely being a reason for some of the challenges being encountered. Senator Ada suggested that the staff place greater emphasis on monitoring quality control with the contracted vendor that provides public transportation services and ensuring that it adequately serves the public. The Senator then asked the nominee if GRTA was still on a month-to-month service contract with a private vendor.

Mr. Tydingco answered yes.

Senator Tom Ada inquired whether the nominee thought that the inability of the Board to meet quorum affected its ability to enter into to a more permanent contract agreement with regards to services.

Mr. Tydingco stated that he believed that was part of the reason. He expressed his optimism that, with new Board members being appointed and confirmed, it is likely that they are closer to deciding on a more permanent policy decision with regards to contracting bus services.

Senator Tom Ada stated his concern with changing the requirements for the general manager position. He stated that there are many qualified applicants, both on-island and from off-island, that must be given serious consideration. He expressed support for the nominee.

Senator Tony Ada thanked the nominee for his desire to serve on the Board. He asked Mr. Tydingco when the last time GRTA had a permanent general manager.

Mr. Tydingco answered that he did not know.

Senator Tony Ada stated that he believed that the requirements for for the general manager position should be adjusted so the qualifications are easier to meet for local applicants. He stated that it is important to get that position permanently filled.

Mr. Tydingco stated that he agreed with Senator Tony Ada. He stated that he hopes to fill the position with the new Board.

Senator Tony Ada indicated his support for the nominee.

Senator Tina Muna Barnes stated her appreciation for Mr. Tydingco's acceptance of the nomination. She stated that there is an urgency to improve things at the GRTA. She stated her support for the nominee.

Chairman San Nicolas stated that it is important that a plan be in place to improve the GRTA. He indicated his support for the nominee and thanked him for his attendance.

HI. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS
