COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Education, Public Library and Women's Affairs convened a public hearing on November 25., 2013 at 2:00 pm in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of Mr. Christopher K. Felix to serve as a Member of the University of Guam, Board of Regents for a term of six (6) years and whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by the Governor of Guam on October 31, 2013, for a term of six (6) years;
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on October 31, 2013;
- Appointment packet forwarded to the Committee for public consideration on October 31, 2013.

All legal requirements for public notices were met, with requests for publication sent to all media and all Senators on November 18, 2013, (5-Day Notice) and November 22 and 23 2013 (48-Hour Notice) via email. Copies of the hearing notices are appended to the committee report.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** asked Mr. Felix, President Underwood and Mrs. Toni Sanford to testify before the Committee.

- **Mrs. Sanford** expressed support for Mr. Felix. She stated that as a member of the Regent Nominating Committee she sought for Mr. Felix to apply to be a member of Board of Regents. She spoke about the university making critical progress and there is more progress to be made. She believes the regent should be very perspective and she noted that Mr. Felix

perspective is welcomed, especially in line with the capital improvement projects that are undergoing right now to bring the university at the next level. She stated that Guam is Mr. Felix's home and he wants to make the university the natural choice. She pointed out that he is a successful business man and this is a testimony to his commitment and determination especially when you are working for yourself. She expressed that his willingness is underscored, his labor love with the Skip program and the Academy of Our Lady Board. She believes that his perspective in the real estate business is great for the ongoing projects at the university. She believes that he is willing to volunteer lets welcome Mr. Felix and put him work.

- **President Underwood** testified in support of Mr. Felix. His written testimony is appended to the Committee report.

- **Mr. Felix** expressed he was honored to be asked to be a Regent and if the legislature confirms him. He spoke about being on Guam for 41 years and that Guam has blessed him and his family. He feels that he is indebted to the island. He articulated that he wants the island to be the best it can be and that is the same commitment he will deliver to the university

- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** read from Mr. Felix's appointment packet a list of volunteer service to the community. The Speaker asked Mr. Felix when he will find time for himself and his family.

- **Mr. Felix** replied now he has more free time to give back to Guam since he has good staff to help run his business and his daughter will be going to college.

- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** stated that his background would be beneficial to the board. The Speaker thanked Mr. Felix for accepting to be a regent. The Speaker asked Mr. Felix he has read the enabling legislation.

- **Mr. Felix** replied no but he attended last week board meeting and he will be attending an orientation class for the board.

- **Vice Chairperson Yamashita, Ph.D.** stated that she sense the sincerity of Mr. Felix to serve. The Vice Chairperson asked Mr. Felix to remember that developing teachers is what started the university and should be highlighted. The Vice Chairperson expressed concern for early childhood and teaching and its importance to the community. The Vice Chairperson shared a conversation that she had with elderly gentleman and he told her that Guam gave her so much that she had to give back. The Vice Chairperson agreed with his statement and that is why we serve. The Vice Chairperson thanked Mr. Felix for serving.

- **Senator Limtiaco** thanked Mr. Felix for his willingness to serve. The senator spoke about Mr. Felix's impressive prior public service to the community and that he brings a lot to the table. The senator stated that Mr. Felix will be a welcome addition to the board. The senator stated he will be voting for Mr. Felix.

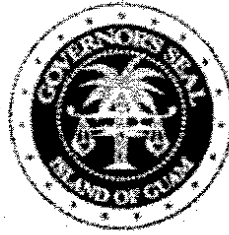
- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** closed by thanking Mr. Felix for accepting the nomination.

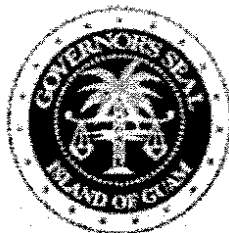



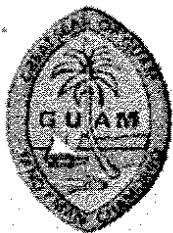
