I. OVERVIEW

The appointment of Donald G. Taitano to serve as a member of the Cockpit License Board was made by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo on February 8, 2013. The appointment packet was received by the Office of Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D., on February 11, 2013. The appointment of Donald G. Taitano was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations on February 12, 2013.

The Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations convened a public hearing on April 8, 2013 at 10:06 a.m. in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was the appointment of Donald G. Taitano. The hearing was adjourned at 10:55 a.m.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Michael San Nicolas: We will begin to hear testimony for the appointment of Mister Taitano to serve as a member of the Cockpit License Board. Before your testimony, we'll go ahead and call anybody who wishes to testify on your behalf if there is anyone present to testify. We do have several written testimonies submitted on behalf of your confirmation. The floor is yours.

Mr. Donald Taitano: Thank you very much, Mister Chairman. My name is Donald Taitano. Thank you for the opportunity to appear before you regarding my nomination to serve as a member of the Cockpit License Board. I think that it is important to disclose that I do not have any experience or interests with

the cockfighting industry at any level. I am not a cockfighter nor are members of my immediate family engaged in this enterprise. I am humbled by the confidence Governor Calvo has placed in me to serve on this board and I want to ensure you of my commitment to serve. My nomination packet outlines my educational, training, and work experience which includes public service in the judiciary, legislative, and executive branches. Because I have worked for all three branches of government, I have an appreciation and understanding of the work of each branch in the development, application, and interpretation of the law and public policy. Additionally, my years of experience as a licensed consultant and insurance and financial services professional will guide me in addressing governmental regulatory compliance matters. In order to maintain my contractual obligations with the insurance companies I represent, I am required to undergo annual training on best practices for insurance producers. One such compliance requirement is focused on all matters regarding anti-money laundering. I believe this will be a benefit to the Board. In my professional career, I have adopted a solutions-minded approach in dealing with challenges and opportunities as I am always open to improvement and change. With regard to my duties and obligations on the Board, I will be focused on accomplishing operational efficiency, measuring public confidence and expectations for transparency, and ensuring compliance with the statutes of Guam. Mister Chair, I have been fortunate to know and work with you and most of the Committee members and I look forward to the opportunity to know and work with all the members of this esteemed body. Thank you.

Chairman San Nicolas: Thank you, Donald. I do have a few questions but before I begin, I'll go ahead and yield to any of my colleagues who may have any questions.

Senator Brant McCreadie: Thank you, Donald. Congratulations. I've known Mister Taitano for a number of years. You have my full support for this position. You are very level-headed. Your business background in the community and how you give back to the community is very positive. I'm excited for you. After this year is up, hopefully the Governor can appoint you to a different board that can utilize your skills in a much better and needed place. As far as the person, you have my full support and you'll be very good for the intended need of this board. Thank you.

Chairman San Nicolas: Senator Morrison.

Senator Thomas Morrison: Thank you, Mister Chair. Good morning. Congratulations, as well, on your nomination. I know this is a very important board. I appreciate you coming by and visiting me and letting me know what your intentions are there. But, I also ask that you take some time to review Bill 19. I don't want to get into the specifics of that but if you have any thoughts or positions as it refers to the gaming tax.

Mr. Taitano: I did have an opportunity to review the bill. If the bill is successful and passes, and I am confirmed to the Board, we will do everything to ensure the revenues are collected as taxed through the bill.

Sen. Morrison: Thank you, Mister Chairman. I appreciate it and you have my full support.

Chairman San Nicolas: Donald, I know your background. When you came and visited me and shared with me that you're not a cockfighter, no one in your family is – you're stepping up just to serve. That's a wonderful thing. When it comes to cockfighting, it sometimes gets contentious because there are two sides. One side has a strong position that is very cultural and another side has a position that it promotes gambling. As a board member, that is something that you're going to be in the way of and you'll be in the line of fire for those kinds of issues. I wanted to ask your position on whether or not cockfighting is more predominantly a cultural practice, that we need to protect on the island, or is it a back door to gambling that we're leaving open and needing to close if we're going to be moving away from that in this community.

Mr. Taitano: Mister Chair, I do not have an opinion nor a position on this. I know there is legislation in place and there are rules and regulations on how the industry needs to proceed. I would use that as the framework in how I formulate my decisions moving forward.

Chairman San Nicolas: Okay. It's a tough question. It's one of those that we're going to be faced with from time to time. I just want to get a feel on where you are on that because, as the Cockpit Board begins to form, we want to make sure that on the policy side that we understand where we're coming from and we have an idea of where you guys are coming from on the Board's side. Thank you, Donald. Are there any other questions for Mister Taitano? Is there anyone else with comments or testimony which they wish to submit at this time? Thank you very much, Mister Taitano.

III. RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations hereby reports out the nomination of Donald G. Taitano to serve as a member of the Cockpit License Board for a term of one year, beginning on the date of his confirmation by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, with the recommendation TO CONFIRM.
