


**I. OVERVIEW**

The Committee on Education, Public Library and Women's Affairs convened a public hearing on November 19, 2014 at 4:00 pm in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. - Appointed by the Governor of Guam on October 28, 2014, for a term of Three (3) years.
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on October 29, 2014; and
- Appointment packet forwarded to the Committee for public consideration on October 30 2014.

## **II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION**

- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D.** announced the public hearing for Dr. Elisabeth Ichihara Rosario to serve as member of the Guam Commission for Educator Certification will be heard. Speaker Won Pat Ed.D. also mentioned that proper and adequate notices were given: 5 days notice was sent on Nov. 12, 2014 and a 48 hours notice was sent on Nov. 16, 2014.

- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D.** also mentioned that testimonies should be addressed to Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D. and will be accepted via hand delivery at the Speaker's office; Speaker's mailbox at reproduction room of the Main Legislature Building at 155 Hesler Place, Hagatna, Guam 96910; or [fbtorres@judiwonpat.com](mailto:fbtorres@judiwonpat.com) or through facsimile at 472-3589.

**Speaker Won Pat Ed.D.** called up Ms. Lea Santos, Dr. Gayle Hendricks, Mr. Eloy Hara, and Dr. Kelly Sukola to testify.

- **Ms. Lea Santos** is in full support of the nomination of Dr. Elisabeth Ichihara Rosario; her written testimony is appended to the committee report.

- **Dr. Gayle Hendricks** is in full support of the nomination of Dr. Elisabeth Ichihara Rosario. She has worked with Dr. Elisabeth Ichihara Rosario for 8 years and found Dr. Rosario to be professional and dedicated to the duties and responsibilities she has assumed. Dr. Hendricks mentioned that if Dr. Rosario has a fault, it is being over dedicated. Dr. Hendricks also mentioned that Dr. Rosario is willing to work in to the early hours, if that is what it takes to complete a task. Dr. Hendricks believes that same dedication will be brought to the GCEC. She also mentioned that Dr. Rosario will address any and all issues that come before the commission with an open mind and will provide sound input because she has been an educator under the certification of rules and regulations. Dr. Hendricks mentioned that Dr. Rosario will bring a new perspective as to what is needed to continue to support educational quality on Guam. Dr. Hendricks lastly mentioned that "She can only be an asset to the GCEC."


