COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Health and Human Services, Health Insurance Reform, Economic Development and Senior Citizens convened a public hearing on **Wednesday**, **December 3**, **2014 at 10:02am** in *I Liheslatura*'s Public Hearing Room.

Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of **The Executive Appointment of Dr. Gregory J. Miller as a Member of the Guam Board of Allied Health Examiners,** and whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by Governor Eddie Baza Calvo on October 21, 2014
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on October 22, 2014;
- Appointment packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on October 24, 2014.

Public Notice Requirements

Notices were disseminated via electronic-mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on Tuesday, November 18, 2013 (5-Day Notice), and again on Wednesday, November 26, 2013 (48-Hour Notice).

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Rodriguez: Hafa Adai, good morning, the Committee on Health and Human Services, Health Insurance Reform, Economic Development and Senior Citizens now convenes this public and confirmation hearing. Public hearing notices were given to the media, first notice on Tuesday, November 18th second notice was on Wednesday, November 26th. For the record today is Wednesday December 3, 2014, and the time now is 10:02am.

The committee will hear and accept testimonies both oral and written on the following. The first one is the executive appt. of Dr. Gregory Miller to serve as a member of the Guam Board of Allied Health Examiners, the executive appt. of Ms. Linda RP Perez to serve also as a member of the Guam Board of Allied Health Examiners, Bill 416 an act to add a new article to Chapter 58 relative to encouraging the development of 1600 new hotel rooms to the issuance of special qualifying certificates, Bill 422-32 an act to provide for the isolation and quarantine procedures relative to an



emergency detention order for the incubation periods of severe communicable disease as determined by the US Senator of disease control. Thank you very much for being here this morning.

I want to recognize former colleague, Senator Mona Silva Taijeron and all of you for being here this morning. We will start off the hearing with Dr. Miller and Ms. Linda Perez, if you wish to provide any testimony, I ask you to please sign up here in the forms that are to the left of us here on this table. I like to recognize the Vice Chair of the Committee, Senator Tony Ada and also Senator Aguon. Thank you for joining me this morning. We'll start off this morning with Dr. Miller, Ms. Perez. We have one, Senator Taijeron in favor of the appt of Ms. Perez and Dr. Greg Miller. Would you like to provide a testimony, Senator? No okay, thank you. Dr. Miller?

Dr. Miller: Good morning.

Chairman Rodriguez: Congratulations on the reappointment, I know you are a current member now and this is your reappointment to the Board of Allied Health Examiners and so we're here now to go through your confirmation hearing. Do you have any statements that you would like to provide the community you're free to do so now.

Dr. Miller: Currently, everything is going pretty smooth as part of the Allied health, we're still short of members, we don't have a physical therapist, a veterinarian, and a couple other ones right Linda? We are happy if we can complete the board, but outside of that, I think everything is going pretty smoothly in the board. I'll be honest with you; I think probably our major hang-up seems to be the open meeting act and getting it right. Most of the stuff that has gone through litigation in our board has been thrown back at us simply because like when you open the meeting you gave the day, the dates of your advertisements through the Guam open meeting act and we do that because a part of is the board office that controls all the boards doesn't always have the money to run the ads in some whether they are late and that just messes up the whole meeting schedule. I think probably Linda may agree with that that is our biggest hang up right now is our compliance with that and I don't know that might take a little bit of tweaking, but outside of that I think it is pretty good work and everything is going smooth I'd be happy to answer any questions.

Dr. Miller: Physical therapy, occupation therapy, veterinarian medicine has no representative. There are slots for 9-11 members. There is 15 professions actually that is represented by that board, it makes it very unique in medicine they only license medical doctors and osteopathic physicians it is very easy to propagate rules and regulations to know those rules and regulations. Allied health is very unique because with 15 professions the people on that board need to know all the rules for all the professions especially for those that are not represented which makes it a challenge too.

Chairman Rodriguez: Ill open it up I would like to recognize Mrs. Miller for being here. It takes a lot because you have your professions and your professions, what you do, your day jobs, you do a



lot of work, but you still have time to provide the service for our community, so I thank your families for the support as well. Senator Ada?

Senator Tony Ada: Thank you Mr. Chair I don't have any questions I would just like to thank both Dr. Miller and Ms. Perez for again availing yourself to the board and looking forward to working with you and hopefully those issues with the open government would be resolved and we would see smoother meetings and things like that would happen to the board and anything that we can do to help achieve that please let us know.

Dr. Miller: I would like to respond to that I think really as far as the open meeting law it could be tweaked a little bit. Actually, I worked with Senator Benjamin Cruz about that to allow that law to work only through—to allow the meeting notices to be on websites or the government TV channel that our AG represents our board that still has to be in the paper along with that and the paper costs money so really it is a financial issue right now and if you work with Marlene Carbullido's people they would be eternally grateful if you can help so that we post to some two hundred some dollars per meeting and then we get off cycle and then we would have to reschedule the meeting and buy new ads and it is really tough on the board office to come up with that money and sometimes it is very last minute so we don't know if we are going to have a meeting or not and then of course I don't have to reschedule patients because it is during lunch time, but for FHP representatives and even our respiratory therapist, a lot of the times, they are rescheduling patients and the meetings are canceled because their purchase order didn't go through so I think mostly the people from the office could probably say before we do anything at law if we could have a way of advertising those meetings. It's either funded well or be totally on our website that would be ideal thank you.

Senator Tony Ada: Thank you. Thank you Mr. Chair.

Chairman Rodriguez: Thank you very much Senator. Senator Aguon?

Senator Aguon: Thank you very much Mr. Chairman and good morning Dr. Miller and Ms. Perez. Thank you for offering your assistance to our community just a couple questions and you hit on the issue with regards to the public notification for meetings because I was in the impression that the most recent change amendments to the law would authorized as an alternative either an electronic notification or public notification let's say in the government TV, so that I think has to be clarified. I know you alluded to your AG's representative legal counsel saying it has to be both so I think I need to revisit that particular because one of the premise of that amendment when it was going to this body was allowing the flexibility with electronic media with different forms that are available to allow government entities to provide public notifications through other mediums so I will see how the Vice Speaker would like to precede with this because I know it was his legislation.

Dr. Miller: I would love it if you do that I sat with the Vice Speaker we came up with this idea, but then it was past everything was perfect but she probably admit this I come close to arguing with our



AG, I said, no we can use websites and now we have a TV channel and his report was know the last minute they are reading the print media came in and added "and" when there was and an "or" you still have to use the newspaper. He is asking me to prove it to him but if your office could come up with proof or something like that says yeah you can use a website, but why use a website when we have this great government channel to announce meetings which I think that are only logistical problem I think on that having some sort of affidavit our meeting was on that TV channel on the right dates because you have these dates, but I think that can be done on whoever manages a channel, but if your office can contact us if it's true then a website or the TV channel satisfies that law you can solve a whole lot of financial problems because Marlene could probably tell you about money because all those notices add up to a lot of money and that is probably why the print media wants it the other way.

Senator Aguon: Okay well obviously we definitely don't want to take away from the requirements that in fact our people have the opportunity to acknowledge there is a meeting for different boards and commissions out there. This is something that we do need to revisit. Just a couple of other questions, I know Dr. Miller and Ms. Perez you alluded to the membership you may possibly 15 positions available for various specialties and you've only been able to fill 7 or 8. Now, in the last year alone do you have any issues regards to quorum aside from your scheduled meetings.

Dr. Miller: No we never missed a meeting due to a lack of quorum.

Senator Aguon: The reason I bring this up is that I was speaking to a medical professional a couple months back and he shared with me that he is having difficulties getting doctors who are originally from Guam certified to come back to Guam and serve in our community and this one particular doctor he is trying to recruit, he received the initial commitment and they are going through this certification and this authorization to practice on this island unfortunately he is experiencing serious difficulties to the point where the doctor who is now practicing off island is reconsidering his option of coming to Guam and serving here in our community so that is why I want to inquire about the quorum if in fact there is any difficulty for the process to proceed. I know 3 locally grown and professionally educated who are practicing doctors in the mainland who would like to come back home and serve in this community, but they are going through the process right now of getting that certification and authorization to practice on island and it is very critical Mr. Chairman and I am sure you are very much aware of this that the paneling of this body continues and that every effort be made to try to pursue other individuals in the community who would like to serve in this position in the community because anytime we're bringing in a professional to provide direct service to our people we need to not only provide that direct certification but assurance to our community that these individuals are readily available and properly credentialed to serve in our community, so I want to bring that to your attention if we can have a side bar discussion on how the process actually works and if there is anything my office can do in terms of communicating this particular locally grown now doctor to possibly to continue to consider his options of coming back and serving in this community, I would certainly like to work with the board of allied health and the chairman. Aside



from that I want to once again thank you very much for service to our community this is obviously a volunteer effort on your part to try and ensure the regulations and the restrictions and the policies that are required by the board that you have that opportunity to oversee the medical professionals in the community and I commend you for that and to please continue to seek the support of the chairman or any of the members of the legislature or in terms of any legislation of policy that you would need to have us reconsider or recommend that we reconsider.

Dr. Miller: Just a brief comment on that too, I'm not too sure which board, it sounds like it might be the medical physicians, but either way I think one of the problems we have with off island health care providers whether medical doctors or chiropractors or PTs is you know my plug in for our hardworking board staff is like a lot of gov Guam agencies, they need more funds. For health care to grow properly on Guam especially as regional medical brings more and more physicians there are times when the fax machine doesn't work, they needed an upgraded computer system and probably at least a couple more employees because there's a lot of licensees on Guam and this is just not enough money to go around. I'm just simply updating the hardware some fax machines phone lines and all that stuff because all her stories where people are saying that they are trying to renew but my fax won't go through and they are not receiving my stuff; they will say, oh it is not working right now simple stuff like that cause I know I think it was Dr. Shieh who told me that somebody in the states got so frustrated trying to get his information in and started saying I don't think I want to go there and he just backs off so I think of just taking care of simple logistics simple for most doctors. Outside of that I think we go pretty smooth.

Ms. Linda Perez: I like to add to what Greg is saying. Yes, definitely we have a problem with the office. There is not a lot of staff to assist with a lot of licensees that are trying to get information or even trying to get their application in on a timely manner. Some of the phones, no one is answering the phone and these are the complaints I'm hearing from people. I don't even know if this is the forms to do it but if you want to hear it, the complaints I'm hearing are no one is answering the phone, when they are calling in, when they do come, the office of operation hours are limited. The other thing is the webpage our government can save a lot of money if the webpage is available and people can access the information regarding our profession. Access application, access other information that is prudent to their application their requirements for licensure here so if the office is not available for them what are the options do they have and I worked in the mainland and lived in the mainland as well. Our webpage is up and running, we could easy access, easy communicate, and we can submit our application in a timely manner, but because we don't have a webpage here and even for a lot of professionals to look at the Guam laws they have to go to the legislature's website just to understand our laws so that is frustration for a lot of us and of course I hear it and I understand I get frustrated we get frustrated. We understand that Marlene doesn't have a lot of staff members with her helping her out and it is not just 1 board that she is working with, she is working with several other boards nursing board, medical board, Guam board of allied health that's a lot for 3 people to man how many applications, how many licensure, how many people who want to come in and work, so yes those are the things that are kind of being hindrance is true to the people.



Senator Aguon: I understand and I really appreciate this conversation. Obviously the focus is on your reappointment and you both certainly have my support, but these are real issues affecting either potential applicants or existing physicians who are serving our community so if you can direct inquiry or any suggestions send your request to the Chairman so that we can address it because obviously the addition of the Guam Medical City Hospital and GMH, some of our professionals are now transferring over to that new facility and now GMH is going to have to cover down and make sure they are able to effectively recruit professionals and medical physicians to be able to serve at our public hospitals, so there is really a lot and also expansion of other clinics that are ongoing and maybe opening in a few months and they need medical professionals. We are at a critical time where we need to provide you with the support whether it is logistics whether it is additional personnel whether it is a fax machine we need to work collectively with the executive branch definitely will the powers of the executive branch those would not be the issues you properly credential do you meet all the specifics and requirements that your board and your commission requires for you to sign off and approve the application or their recertification your focus should not necessarily be on logistical concerns that should be moving as smoothly as possible. Please send your concerns to the Chairman and we will work with the Chair. Thank you very much, thank you Mr. Chair.

Chairman Rodriguez: Thank you very much Senator. Again thank you very much and congratulations on your reappointment. We'll make sure the committee report is ready for session that is going to happen later this month and the concerns that are raised these are concerns that we'll continue to work with the board and also with public health and the deputy director is here he heard all the concerns and so the licensing offices under the department of Public Health, so we will make sure we address these concerns moving forward thank you very much.




