COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Education, Public Library and Women's Affairs convened a public hearing on November 19, 2014 at 4:00 pm in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of Dr. Michelle M.S. Santos, Ed.D., Community at Large Member, Guam Commission for Educator Certification the appointment history as follows:

- Appointed by the Governor of Guam on October 28, 2014, for a term of Three (3) years.
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on October 29, 2014;
 and
- Appointment packet forwarded to the Committee for public consideration on October 30, 2014.

Public Notice Requirements

All legal requirements for public notices were met, with requests for publication sent to all media and all Senators on November 12, 2014, (5-Day Notice) and November 16, 2014 (48-Hour Notice) via email. Copies of the hearing notices are appended to the committee report.

II. SUMMARY OF TESITMONY AND DISCUSSION

- Speaker Won Pat Ed.D. announced the public hearing for Dr. Michelle Santos to serve as member of the Guam Commission for Educator Certification will be heard. Speaker Won Pat Ed.D. also mentioned that proper and adequate notices were given: a 5 days notice was sent on Nov. 12, 2014 and a 48 hours notice was sent on Nov. 16, 2014.
- Speaker Won Pat Ed.D. also mentioned that testimonies should be addressed to Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D. and will be accepted via hand delivery at the Speaker's office; Speaker's mailbox at reproduction room of the Main Legislature Building at 155 Hesler Place, Hagatna, Guam 96910; or fbtorres@judiwonpat.com or through facsimile at 472-3589.
- Speaker Won Pat Ed.D. called up Ms. Lea Santos, Dr. Gayle Hendricks, and Mr. Eloy Hara.
- Ms. Lea Santos is in full support of the nomination of Dr. Michelle Santos; her written testimony is appended to the committee report.
- Dr. Gayle Hendricks is in full support of the nomination of Dr. Michelle Santos; her written testimony is appended to the committee report.
- Mr. Eloy P. Hara apologized for the situation of mistaken identity, in which he thought the hearing was for Dr. Annette Santos.
- Speaker Won Pat Ed.D mentioned that she usually gives 10 days for people in the community to provide written testimony and mentioned that she would repeat those addresses at the end. She also mentioned that the community does have ample time before the next session which will be in December.
- Speaker Won Pat Ed.D mentioned that she has received a letter of support from Roberta Abaday in support of Dr. Michelle Santos.
- Speaker Won Pat Ed.D called up Dr. Michelle Santos to testify.
- **Dr. Michelle Santos** mentioned that she does get her name mistaken for Dr. Michelle B. Santos who is Francis Santos's wife. Dr. Michelle Santos thanked Speaker Won Pat Ed.D. for considering her as a potential member for the GCEC representing the community at large. Dr. Michelle Santos mentioned that she has been resident of Guam since 1989 and involved in education since 1991. She also mentioned that she had the privilege in working in the Guam Department of Education, the Guam Community College, and now the University of Guam. Dr.

Michelle Santos also mentioned in her capacity that there always been some connection with her and the former certification office- now commission. That connection where she began seeking teacher certification in the early 90's, serving as an officer at the Guam Community college, and now as a role as faculty member helping prepare future teachers. So there has been a constant connection with this commission. As a community member she feels a greater interest because she has children who will directly benefit for having qualified educators in a class room. She also mentioned that she has a 7 year old attending Agana Heights Elementary. She believes that her experiences in education and her educational background with a Bachelors degree in English from the University of California at Santa Barbara, a Masters in Education with Administration and Supervision from the University of Guam, and a Doctorate in Education in the area of Leadership from the University of San Diego. These combined, has provided her with the breadth of experience to understand, respect, empathize, with all the different scenarios that a commission member might face. She hopes for the support of nomination, and she mentioned that she will best serve the community of Guam at the best of her ability.

- Speaker Won Pat Ed.D thanked Dr. Michelle Santos for her testimony. Speaker asked out of all the jobs what job she finds most rewarding.
- **Dr. Michelle Santos** replied that rewards come more quickly as a teacher in the classroom. She also mentions that in an administration you may think that you can change the world and have an impact on greater people but you may not see the rewards as quickly. The rewards in a classroom from seeing students, it doesn't matter whether they are high school students, 10th graders, a student who is court ordered to be there, or a senior in college who seen their hard work come to fruition and becoming a teacher themselves. Those are the rewards, seeing students with their excitement and helping making a difference in someone's life. It really keeps you going in the day, she responds.
- Speaker Won Pat Ed.D. replied, "I'm glad you got to share that you were not only a teacher but an administrator. Also working at the Guam Community College and the University of Guam. So you most likely fit to be a community member at large for GCEC. So all of that is important to bring, all your personal experiences."
- Speaker Won Pat Ed.D. asked, "Can you also share your strengths and weaknesses?"
- Dr. Michelle Santos mentioned that it is kind of hard going after another person, because you do not want to steal their answer. She also responds, "My response for

me is that I am a rule follower. Being a rule follower you see things black and white. Sometimes there are advantages as being a commission member because things are black and white and these are the rules. A disadvantage to that is that there is a human component and you still have to know that there are circumstances, there is a family, there is a heart, there is a person and in the end you have to make decisions and following the rules and knowing that you have done the best to support the rules to support what has been decided on by a larger body. And in the end I know I can sleep at night, but I know sometimes that can be interpreted as being little hard. A hard line person."

- Speaker Won Pat Ed.D. mentions this commission in particular is very strict in terms of rules, certification requirement hours and test scores there is no choice about it. Especially then, when these standards become law. That is going to be the hardest of them all. I hope you all realize that when the time comes that you are able to revoke these certifications. This is why I'm with you because you guys bring those personal experiences that you had in the educational system.
- Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. concluded the public hearing.






