McManus to serve as a General Public Member of the Guam Academy Charter Schools Council for a term of three (3) years and whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointment packet forwarded to the Committee for public consideration on November 18, 2013.

#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

- Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. asked Dr. Suzanne B. McManus to testify before the Committee.
- Dr. Suzanne B. McManus written testimony is appended to the Committee report.

- Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. asked Dr. McManus if she read the charter school law.
- Dr. McManus replied yes.
- Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D asked Dr. McManus with her education and background what can she bring to the table.
- **Dr. McManus** replied that she can bring diverse perspective to families the opportunities for choices and that is what charter school offers choices. She spoke about her children's experiences with charter schools in Eugene, Oregon which the community supported and demonstrated accountability and product outcome.
- Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. expressed it is a bonus that Dr. McManus' children attended charter school and she knows what to expect from them.
- Vice Chairperson Yamashita, Ed.D. thanked McManus for her service, returning home, teaching at the College of Education and serving in the council.
- **Dr. McManus** replied that it is part of the G initiative by Dr. Underwood. She stated that you have to teaching, research and service.
- Vice Chairperson Yamashita, Ph.D. recognized Dr. McManus' mother who is the audience and thanked her for raising fine children.
- -Vice Chairperson Yamashita, Ph.D. asked Dr. McManus if she attended a council meeting.
- Dr. McManus replied no
- Vice Chairperson Yamashita, Ph.D. stated that Dr. McManus will find that the members of council are concern and committed. Vice Chairperson asked Dr. McManus that she develop strategies to help the charter schools and the council. The Vice Chairperson thanked her willingness to serve.


