COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The nomination of Edward G. Untalan to serve as a member of the A.B. Won Pat International Airport Authority, Guam Board of Directors was made by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo on February 26, 2014. The appointment packet was received by the Office of Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D., on March 6, 2014. The appointment of Edward G. Untalan was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations on March 7, 2014.

The Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations convened a public hearing on May 13, 2014 at 2:02 p.m. in *I Liheslatura*'s Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was the nomination of Edward G. Untalan. The hearing was adjourned at 2:55 p.m.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Michael San Nicolas opened the floor for individuals wishing to provide public testimony.

Peter Roy Martinez read a prepared statement in support of Mr. Untalan's nomination. (see attached)

Chairman San Nicolas called the nominee to provide his statement to the Committee.

Edward Untalan read a prepared statement. (see attached)

Chairman San Nicolas spoke about Mr. Untalan's current experience on the Board and commended him for his leadership as the Board's current chairman. He spoke about the recent bonds that the Airport was issued and asked the nominee about his thoughts on the oversubscription of the bonds with regards to the actual orders.

Mr. Untalan explained that many factors may have affected the awarding of bonds and the rate associated with it. He stated that the bond was already priced when the Airport began floating it. He further stated that, although he agreed that the rate could have been brought down, he believed that the demand was driven by the amount of effort that was put in to attract investors. Mr. Untalan further clarified that the bonds issued to the Airport included money for new spending as well as additional grant funding to spend on renovations.

Chairman San Nicolas inquired if the Airport had any immediate plans for additional borrowing.

Mr. Untalan stated that there are no plans for borrowing in the foreseeable future. He did mention that federal grants have helped to subsidize the expenses at the airport with regards to construction and renovation. However, he cautioned that grant funding eventually diminishes with the completion of projects so there are plans to look at other ways to increase the revenue stream into the Airport. Mr. Untalan mentions that one of the challenges of getting new investors at the Airport is that they are only allowed to enter into an initial five year contract which needs legislative approval in order to extend beyond the initial term.

Chairman San Nicolas stated that part of the reason for the need of legislative approval to extend beyond five years is to ensure that the return in investment is realized. He did mention that he is open to revisit the policy and make adjustments that make it more beneficial for all parties involved. Chairman San Nicolas spoke about creating and implementing a biometrics program as it relates to keeping track of visitors who use the visa-waiver program. He asked if the Airport had any plans to implement or invest in a biometrics program.

Mr. Untalan stated that the Airport is very interested in working with all the pertinent stakeholders and partners to explore the possibility of a biometrics system. He mentioned that the largest challenge they face is ensuring that all requirements are met by all stakeholders at all levels of government. Mr. Untalan reiterated the willingness of the Airport to work with *I Liheslatura*.

Senator Aline Yamashita thanked Mr. Untalan for his willingness to continue serving. She stated that she mentioned in a previous hearing the need to ensure quality customer service at the Airport. She asked Mr. Untalan if he viewed "customer service" as a core value as it relates to Airport operations.

Mr. Untalan stated that he wants to ensure that one of the core values he wants to instill is "caring." He said that everyone involved at the Airport needs to care about their jobs, their families, their customers, and their tenants. He stated that he hoped that this would emanate with each employee and stakeholder associated with the Airport.

Senator Yamashita asked for clarification on what constitutes non-aeronautical revenue.

Mr. Untalan stated that it refers to revenue derived from rental. He mentioned that the Airport has lots of property that can be developed.

Senator Yamashita mentioned various ideas for use of the Airport property that needs to be developed and expressed hope that the Airport explores different ideas.

Mr. Untalan mentioned that there are several regulations that may have to be met but he is willing to explore the idea.

Senator Yamashita asked about noise mitigation for homes, not just in the area surrounding the Airport, but for the entire island.

Mr. Untalan stated that there are studies available but he was unsure if any studies included the entire island.


Senator Frank Aguon, Jr. commended the leadership of Mr. Untalan. He mentioned that Mr. Untalan has almost perfect attendance at the Board meeting which Sen. Aguon said demonstrates the nominee's commitment to his responsibilities as a member of the Board. He expressed his support for Mr. Untalan's nomination.

Senator Tony Ada thanked Mr. Untalan for his service. He commended Mr. Untalan for his attendance at the Board meetings and for the additional time he devotes to his Board responsibilities. He stated his support for the nominee.

Senator Brant McCreadie expressed his appreciation for Mr. Untalan's commitment to improving the operations and services at the Airport. He stated his support for the nominee.

Chariman San Nicolas stated that his perspective of autonomous government agencies has changed during the course of this term. He stated that autonomous and line agencies must work together to properly serve the entire island of Guam. Chairman San Nicolas stated that he looks forward to working with the Board in the future to improve services for our people and visitors. He concluded by indicating his support for Mr. Untalan's nomination.







Hafa Adai Chairperson San Nicolas, distinguished Senators of the 32nd Guam Legislature, ladies and gentlemen. My name is Ed Untalan and I am coming again before this body, almost a year and 3 months later, to request your support on my reconfirmation as a member of the Board of Directors for the AB Won Pat Guam International Airport Authority (GIAA).

After being confirmed last year, I originally began my tenure as the Chairperson on the Finance Subcommittee. After the resignation of the former Chairman (Mr. Frank Santos) in September of 2013, and having being unanimously voted by the remaining directors to assume his position, I assumed the role of Chairman on October of 2013.

I have to admit, the last year and three months have been quite exciting, with four main accomplishments: 1) the selection of a new concessionaire; 2) the successful issuance of the 2013 GIAA bonds; 3) the release of an unqualified audit for FY 2012-2013; and, 4) the commencement of the development of the Tiyan parkway.

Going forward, the next couple of years will prove to be even more exciting. With \$150 million in bond and grant funds, the Board has tasked Management to push out as many projects as quickly as possible, not only to benefit the GIAA, but to help stimulate jobs in the construction industry. The two largest projects that are vital and specific to the Airport are the new Arrivals Corridor (\$54 million) and the relocation of the Hold Bag Screening area (\$26 million). While it is estimated that it will take approximately 3 years to complete the Corridor, the Board is pushing to reduce that time line. With its completion, we will be able to finally get rid of those grey dividers and the relocation of the Hold Bag Screening to an area behind the ticket counters would for additional counter space, both leading to a more pleasant customer experience.

During my confirmation hearing last year, I was asked what I wanted to accomplish as a Board member and I had mentioned that I wanted to see a set of Core Values established. Over the last 15 months, I was able to review the organization's Strategic Plan, which had Vision and Mission Statements stated. I also discovered that the Plan has not been updated for a couple of years, many items have been accomplished and it was created via a top-down approach. I have tasked Management to update the Plan, but now through a bottoms-up approach, where the employees would all have input giving them a sense of ownership. Through this plan, I would now like to see these "Core Values" created.

While I have a laundry list of other things I would also like to see accomplished, my desire is to simply transform the GIAA into a property and operation that not only our Island visitors can be proud of, but especially our local people.

Last year I had asked and you provided me with your support. If this body should determine that I am still qualified to continue to serve on the GIAA Board, I will be humbled and honored to do so.
