**COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST**

**I. OVERVIEW**

The Committee on Education, Public Library and Women's Affairs convened a public hearing on October 7 2014 at 4:00 p.m. in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. On the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of Dr. Gayle F. Hendricks to serve as a member of the Guam Commission for Educator Certification for a term of three (3) years and whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by the Governor of Guam on May 29, 2014 for a term of three (3) years;
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on May 29, 2014;
- Appointment packet forwarded to the Committee on Education, Public Library and Women's Affairs for public consideration on May 30, 2014.

**Public Notice Requirements**

All legal requirements for public notices were met, with requests for publication sent to all media and all Senators on July 30, 2014 (5-Day Notice) and August 4, 2014 (48-Hour Notice) via email. Copies of the hearing notices are appended to the committee report.

## **II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION**

- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** commenced the public hearing on the nomination of Dr. Gayle Hendricks. The Speaker stated for the record that the public hearing notices were transmitted to the media as required by law and written testimonies will be accepted up to 10 days after the adjournment of the public hearing.

- **Ms. Lea Santos** is in full support of the appointment of Dr. Gayle F. Hendricks as a Member of the Guam Commission for Educator Certification. Her written testimony is appended to the committee report.

- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** announced that Liza Baza Cruz, Ed.D. provided written testimony on behalf of Dr. Gayle F. Hendricks and proceeded with the testimony of the appointee Dr. Gayle Hendricks. Her written testimony is appended to the committee report.

- **Dr. Gayle F. Hendricks** did not provide written testimony and thanked Speaker for the opportunity and support of her reappointment.

- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** asked if there are rules and regulations in operation, any update, add on, or any scenarios that need to be tweaked.

- **Dr. Gayle F. Hendricks** replied, "Yes." Dr. Hendricks also mentioned that the commission would have the rules and regulations for the ethics portion of the law. She also mentioned that it was an oversight when they first started, because the commission realized that they had no way to revoke certificates to individuals who failed to act appropriately.

- **Dr. Gayle F. Hendricks** also mentioned that there are others like teacher evaluation, approvals, rather than the unsatisfactory the commission approved that particular section. She also states that NCATE is no longer an accrediting body for teacher evaluation and it is now CAEP.

- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** asked if all teachers are certified at the Guam Charter School by the commission.

- **Dr. Gayle F. Hendricks** replied, "Reading the law I would like to think that all teachers are certified. I don't involve myself in the day to day operations at the certification office. I can't answer that with 100% that they are, but they should be. All teachers on Guam should be certified."

- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** mentioned Guam Charter School is considered a public school because of the public funds.

- **Lea Santos** replied, "Last year, a list of names was given just to see if they were certified. Some of them were people who couldn't pass the Praxis. There were also some that were not NCATE or CAEP

certified, but if you were to give me a list, I can tell you if they are certified or not certified.”

- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** mentioned that she will give a list to see if teachers to see if they are certified.

- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** mentioned that there was a big question that the score of the 3 different areas of the Praxis that no longer can they use the composite as scores to say that they pass the Praxis. Has that been adopted by the Commission and you are actually informing all of these teachers.

- **Dr. Gayle F. Hendricks** replied, “Anyone who is currently a certified teacher would already passed the Praxis and won’t be affected by the change. It was a recommendation by ETS that we do await with the composite because of the fact that the 3 tests are different entities. To try to do a composite really did not measure what we wanted to measure. As the new Praxis goes in effect on September 1, and the scores are different than the original test which is actually lower than the scores that we had originally, but is accepted nationally.”

- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** asked if the scores could be raised, or have that option?

- **Dr. Gayle F. Hendricks** replied, “Yes, we have that option.”

- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** asked, “Has the commission decided to go with the national average?”

- **Dr. Gayle F. Hendricks** replied, “Yes.”

- **Lea Santos** replied, “Speaker the Praxis Test I will not exist on Monday, it will be the Praxis Core. The test now incorporates common core and it is a little bit more difficult than the other test so that’s why I think the numerical value of the test scores have changed.”

- **Dr. Gayle F. Hendricks** replied, “To add to that we did have representatives from Guam that went to the ETS the process in evaluating the new Praxis score and making recommendations.”

- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** responded, “And what is that score?”

- **Lea Santos** mentioned that it has 3 different values, and she can provide a copy of the scores.

- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** asked, “What is the recommendation of students taking the Praxis instead of taking the Praxis toward the end of graduation, but also before graduation.”

- **Dr. Gayle F. Hendricks** replied, “ that is what we are doing, is requiring Praxis I as an entrance test, and not be admitted to the School of Education until Praxis I is completed. Praxis II, will be completed prior to student teaching. Until all Praxis I and II are complete then the student can teach and have met the requirements at that point. So there won’t be a problem for a student at SOE because there would have already met the requirements.”

- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** asked, “And when is this going into effect?”

- **Dr. Gayle F. Hendricks** responded, “This has already been implemented for about 3 or 4 years.”



- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** asked, "So how has it been working?"

- **Dr. Gayle F. Hendricks**, replied "One problem that has me concerned is reading and also the Content part for Praxis II probably 75% will pass it and 25% have to retake it."

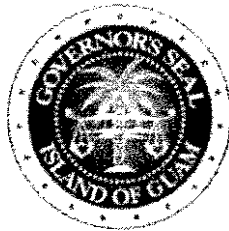
- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** asked, "Is there something in our high schools to consider why our students cannot pass the basic reading test?"

- **Dr. Gayle F. Hendricks** responded, "I can't say, but there is been discussion, with SOE, by the time students have applied they would have already have 54 credits which meant that they have met all the General Education requirements."

- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** is in full support of the appointment of Dr. Gayle F. Hendricks and concluded the public hearing.

### **III. Findings and Recommendations.**

The Committee on Education, Public Library and Women's Affairs hereby reports out the nomination of Dr. Gayle F. Hendricks to serve as a Member of the Guam Commission for Educator Certification for a term of three (3) years beginning on the date of his confirmation by *Liheslaturan Guahan* with the recommendation to CONFIRM.
