## **COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST**

#### I. OVERVIEW

The nomination of Gerard A. Cruz to serve as a member of the Guam Regional Transit Authority Board of Directors was made by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo on Mrch 31. 2014. The appointment packet was received by the Office of Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D., on April 4, 2014. The appointment of Gerard A. Cruz was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations on April 7, 2014.

The Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations convened a public hearing on June 4, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. in *I Liheslatura*'s Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was the nomination of Gerard A. Cruz. The hearing was adjourned at 11:13 a.m.

#### II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

**Chairman San Nicolas** asked the nominee, Gerard A. Cruz, and other members of the public to come forward and present their testimony. The Chairman asked Mr. Cruz if he would like to present his testimony before or after the other individuals present; Mr. Cruz indicated that he desired to go first.

Gerard Cruz asked senators for their support of his nomination. He described his experience with contracting a medical condition that resulted in his current disability. He stated that he wants to share his experience with others so that they may be further educated about blindness. Mr. Cruz stated that many island residents rely on the public transportation system. He expressed his desire to apply his experience of being a consumer of the transit and paratransit system to improve the services provided by the Guam Regional Transit Authority.

**Chairman San Nicolas** thanked Mr. Cruz for his willingness to serve and stated that he believes the Mr. Cruz will be a tremendous asset to the Board. Chairman San Nicolas stated that the nominee will bring a unique perspective and has institutional knowledge that will benefit the Board.

**Senator Aline Yamashita** commended Mr. Cruz on his service to the community and expressed her support for his nomination.

**Senator Vicente Pangelinan** reiterated the importance of the Guam Regional Transit Authority. He commended Mr. Cruz for his willingness to serve on the Board.

**R.** Arlene Santos read a prepared statement in support of the nominee. (see attachment)

**Scott Duenas** read a prepared statement in support of the nominee. (see attached)

**Frank Ungacta** spoke in support of the nominee. He spoke of his relationship with Mr. Cruz and working with him as part of New Vision Guam. He stated that the nominee will help improve public transportation services for all island residents and hoped that *I Liheslatura* will move quickly on confirming the nominee.

**Chairman San Nicolas** stated that the current Legislature continues to work on improving public transit services and pointed to Senator Yamashita as a strong advocate on this issue as a representative of the legislative minority.

**Rudy Ignacio** spoke in support of Mr. Cruz's nomination and stated that Mr. Cruz will bring new ideas to address the island's public transportation problems.

**Victor Tuquero** stated his support for the nominee and hoped that, as a member of the Board, Mr. Cruz will make improvements to public transit.

Antonette Cruz stated that Mr. Cruz currently utilizes the public transit system as his main source of transportation. She believes that his experience in using the system will help him improve the system for all.

**Dawn Maka** stated that Mr. Cruz helped her manage her medical condition. She feels strongly that he would serve the Board well and help educate the general public about individuals with disabilities.

**Mayor Dale Alvarez** testified in support of the nominee. He stated that Mr. Cruz possesses the passion, practical experience, and knowledge to help assist in improving the Guam Regional Transit Authority.

**Doris Flores Brooks** stated that she had no intention of testifying but felt that the nominee was inspiring. She stated that Mr. Cruz would bring the perspective of the public transit riders and commended him for his willingness to serve. She stated her support for the nominee.

**Bernie Grajek** thanked the nominee for his willingness to serve and stated her support for his nomination. She stated that Mr. Cruz will bring an important perspective to the Board and offer unique insight to the problems being faced by the public transit system.

**Sarah Thomas Nededog** stated her support for Mr. Cruz. She stressed the importance of having consumers of the public transit system as part of the decision-making process.

**Senator Yamashita** reiterated her support for the nomination of Mr. Cruz. She mentioned that the quality of the nominee's character is evident by the support shown at the confirmation hearing.

**Senator Pangelinan** congratulated Mr. Cruz on a successful confirmation hearing. He stated that he was inspired by Mr. Cruz's desire to move forward and progress despite the challenges in his life.


**Chairman San Nicolas** commended Mr. Cruz for being an advocate for individuals with disabilities and expressed his support for the nomination.

My name is R. Arlene Santos and I come before you this morning to testify in support of the nomination of Gerard A. Cruz to be a member of the Guam Regional Transit Authority Board.

Gerard has a very interesting story that speaks to his life's journey that brings him here today.

Gerard was born a fully capable child on June 10, 1971. At a very young age, he started learning baseball from his father who became a volunteer coach for all the levels he joined in the Guam Little League Baseball Organization.

He was educated in the Guam Public School System and graduated in 1989 from Oceanview High School now known as Southern High School. As a high school student, he did well academically, was a member of the award winning ROTC Drill Team and remained active in many sports programs.

Gerard's life's journey moved forward on the track of a typical young Chamorro adult after his high school years. He enrolled as a student at the University of Guam, was gainfully employed in the Visitor Industry as a licensed tour guide and father to two children.

As fate would have it, Gerard's life came to a screeching halt in 2003 when he became blind as a result of his diabetic condition. This was only aggravated by chronic kidney failure that required hemodialysis treatments.

Imagine having all this happening to you when you are only 32 years old. These ordeals ended the promising career he loved with the Visitor Industry and his college education then led to the placement of his children with his mother and siblings who became largely responsible for their care and upbringing.

For 7 years, Gerard struggled with his blindness and the hemodialysis treatments. He ultimately left his homeland and family to register as a candidate for a kidney transplant in New Mexico. His Supreme Being must have had plans for him to continue living for he underwent a successful kidney transplant in 2010.

The next chapter of Gerard's life journey had him knocking on the doors of the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation. Gerard was not spared the multitude of systemic struggles that accompany seeking services for the physically challenged here on Guam.

Through Gerard's persistence, determination and the support he received from those who believed in him, he overcame the bureaucratic obstacles he encountered and successfully got selected for rehabilitative training for the blind at Ho'opono services in Honolulu, Hawaii. He successfully completed this training in 2012. This experience is a great example of the unwavering desire and fortitude of this physically challenged man to become independent and self-sufficient.

There is more to this story, but I think I have said enough to demonstrate that this nominee will be a great asset to the Guam Regional Transit Authority Board.

From his training and life experiences, Gerard is someone who knows and understands the service needs of all kinds of consumers having lived a life without any physical impairment then subsequently a life of a physically challenged individual who, by the way, regularly utilizes the Guam Mass Transit system.


With total confidence in Gerard Cruz's qualifications, I whole heartily endorse his confirmation as a Board Member of the Guam Regional Transit Authority.

I have had the distinct honor and privilege of knowing Mr. Cruz since 2011 when he served as a volunteer for a steering committee of New Vision, Guam Inc., a community-based organization whose mission is to provide practical and technical information, training, and advocacy to help improve the lives of island residents who are blind.

Mr. Cruz was instrumental in assisting New Vision Guam Inc. to establish their organization's mission statement, articles of incorporation and bylaws and in 2012 they were able to apply and receive approval for their Non-Profit Organization (NPO) status.

He also made home visits and worked collaboratively with the Health and Medical community in reaching out to patients and their families that are dealing with blindness to inform them about New Vision and the various public/private program resources that exist including assistive technologies to help them live more independently.

Mr. Cruz introduced the Guam Para-Transit system as a way for them to get out of the house to go to the post office, pay bills, go to medical appointments, go shopping, and to pursue employment opportunities.

I truly feel that Mr. Cruz has the passion, education, commitment, and practical experience necessary to improve Guam's public transit system. He is a rider of both the Fixed Route and Para-Transit System and he also utilizes other alternative modes of public transportation.

At the age of 32, he lost his vision as a result of diabetes and this life-changing experience brought a greater awareness and understanding of the many challenges that people with vision impairments have to deal with everyday. Not having the ability to drive reinforced the fact that a sustainable, reliable, efficient and innovative public transit system is a basic need, not a want. He, along with many island residents who are blind, depend on a viable public transit system in order to meet life's basic needs, including shopping, going to church, work, medical care, recreation, socialization, commerce, and civic activities.

Mr. Cruz understands the importance of a fixed-route system that is accessible and exemplifies the standards of inclusivity that the "Hafa Adai" Spirit embodies. He is proud to have worked in the tourism industry and he continues to promote this standard and spirit though out his daily life.

Mr. Cruz has received the highest standard of Independent Living instruction, in the area of Orientation & Mobility using Structured Discovery White Cane Travel and has conducted new driver orientation for the O'ahu Transit services with his O&M instructor in Hawaii. He is currently working on becoming a certified O&M instructor in the hopes of one day providing orientation and mobility services on Guam so that our people will no longer have to leave island to receive this type of specialized training.

I seek the Legislative Committee's confirmation approval to allow Mr. Gerard A. Cruz to serve as a member of the Board of Directors of GRTA and look forward to working collaboratively with him and the rest of the Board Members to help enhance access to affordable and reliable public transportation services for individuals with disabilities. military families and spouses, veterans, visitors, and the rest of the community on Guam.


