




## **II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION**

- **Senator Ada** thanked Ms. Ramos for her willingness to continue her service at GCC Board of Trustees and the supporting President Okada in her goals to expand the GCC Community. The Senator congratulated Ms. Ramos and endorsed her appointment.
- **Senator Respicio** thanked the leadership of GCC and support of GGC Board of Trustees members. The Senator expressed support for the nominee.
- **Senator Aguon** asked for the committee to clarify the term of the nomination. The Senator acknowledged the nominee's work done for the veteran, Guam National Guard and the community. The Senator ended by stating he fully supports the Ms. Ramos's nomination.
- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** further elaborated that the nominee is also a member of the Guam Chambers of Commerce Armed Forces Sub Committee and a Member of the Navy League Chapter of Guam.
- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** stated that the nominee knows the ropes and what is expected to be done as a member of the trustees. The Speaker expressed support of the nominee.

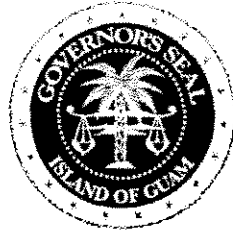

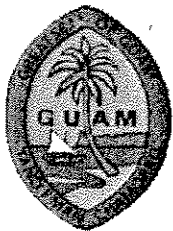

Hafa Adai Speaker Won Pat:

Thank you for this opportunity to provide testimony in support of my re-appointment to the Guam Community College Board of Trustees.

It has, indeed, been a pleasure and a privilege to serve on the GCC Board of Trustees for the last eight years and as Chairperson of the Board for five of those eight years. In those eight years I have seen, first hand, the efforts the College has made to be “the leader in career and technical workforce development and job training” in Micronesia. And I hope to continue to help the Guam Community College fulfill its mission through my efforts as a member of the Board of Trustees.

When I first joined the GCC Board of Trustees in September of 2005, the theme for the 2004 – 2005 Annual Report was “Evolve”. This was a very prescient theme because “evolve” is exactly what GCC has done during my time on the Board of Trustees.

One of the first major tasks that I, along with other members of the GCC Board of Trustees, faced back in 2007 was a sort of “changing of the Guard”, the search for a new President; a daunting task for any Board to undertake, but a task that served as a catalyst for GCC. With the selection of Dr. Mary Okada as President of GCC an “evolution” of sorts began for the Guam Community College.

In the last eight years, with the support of the Board of Trustees, President Okada and her team at Guam Community College has achieved much, not just in terms of infrastructure and enrollment but also in program offerings, community outreach, and governance. The College has achieved record levels of enrollment, constructed three new buildings and is currently renovating several existing buildings, has added new programs, has successfully re-negotiated the union contract, and has now come to the end of its 2009 – 2014 Institutional Strategic Master Plan (IMSP). As President Okada mentioned in her message in the 2012 – 2013 Annual Report, the College has successfully “closed the loop” with regard to the IMSP’s key initiatives of Pioneering, Educational Excellence, Community Interaction, and Dedicated Planning.

As a member of the Board of Trustees these past several years, I have experienced the process of re-affirmation of Accreditation, twice. And both times the College successfully achieved re-affirmation of its Accreditation. In fact, the performance of the GCC Board of Trustees went from being an area needing improvement or a “recommendation” by the accreditation team in 2006 to a “commendation” by the accreditation team of 2012.

The commendations that the Board of Trustees received from the 2012 Accreditation team is a testament to the stability and the support that the BOT has provided to President Okada and the College community enabling them to focus on achieving their mission.

I hope to be part of the Board of Trustees that will help President Okada and the team at Guam Community College develop the next Institutional Strategic Master Plan. These past eight years on the Board has provided me with the institutional knowledge and experience that form a foundation for my decisions and discussions at the Board level.

As a member of local business community and because of my work experience in the hospitality and healthcare industries I bring a specific business perspective to the Board of Trustees that I hope will help continue to move the College's initiatives forward in the next few years and continue its "evolution."

Last but not least, as I have mentioned in previous confirmation hearings, I would like to continue my work as a member of the Guam Community College Board of Trustees because, although I am not an educator by training, I have a very strong personal commitment to education. My father always used to tell me that when he passed away he would not be able to leave me a monetary inheritance, but he would leave me with the education he provided to me. He said that no one would ever be able to take my education away and that my education would open many doors for me.

By helping the Guam Community College fulfill its mission I hope to provide my fellow residents of Guam the educational opportunities that will open doors for them.




