IL SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

- Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. asked Mr. James A. Mason to testify before the Committee.
- Mr. Mason stated that he is extremely pleased that he has been re-nominated to the charter school council. He stated that a lot of life has been service oriented. He explained his service in GAIN and Habitat of Humanity. He spoke about the rough waters during his first term as member of the charter school council. He stated like anything new is going to take wading through and taking out the chinks in the armor. He stated the group of people he has worked with our extremely dedicated and they want to help the youths especially with the new ways of teaching. He further stated that the youths will not only be prepared locally, nationally but internationally challenges.

- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** thanked Mr. Mason for accepting the appointment again. The Speaker spoke about this a new concept to education on Guam and it has faces hurdles and we want to help the charter school.
- Mr. Mason stated it is important that we help with the quality of education for the youth.
- Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. asked for recommendations to changes to the public law for charter school.
- **Mr. Mason** replied we tried to make the process seamless and we made suggestions and it was approved by the legislature. He stated it help us tremendously. He asked if the council can handle the procedural matters.
- Vice Chairperson Yamashita, Ph.D. thanked Mr. Mason for serving. The Vice Chairperson asked the role of the legislature, charter school council and the board of trustees.
- Mr. Mason replied that charter school council duty is to monitor.
- Vice Chairperson Yamashita, Ph.D. comments not audible because microphone is off.
- Mr. Mason replied of course these are public funds just like other agencies.
- Vice Chairperson Yamashita, Ph.D. comments not audible because microphone is off.
- Mr. Mason stated he feels for the charter school because they are the first and they are working out the kinks. He stated that everyone needs to trust each other. He also stated that we have to remember the goal is and that is to educate our youth.
- Vice Chairperson Yamashita, Ph.D. comments not audible because microphone is off.
- Mr. Mason replied thank you.
- **Senator Limitaco** stated in reviewing Mr. Mason's appointment packet, the senator believes Mr. Mason is well qualified and the senator will support his nomination.
- Senator Muna Barnes thanked Mr. Mason for his willingness to serve. The senator supports the Vice Chairperson's comments about public funds and the legislature having oversight. The senator stated she will be supporting Mr. Mason.
- Mr. Mason stated that the legislature is the one empowered the charter schools it almost looking your own children.


