



I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on General Government Operations and Cultural Affairs convened a public hearing on Tuesday, June 11, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslatura*. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration was Committee Report on the Appointment of Joseph C. Wesley to serve as a Member of the Guam Parole Board.

The public hearing was called to order at 10:05 a.m.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Vice Speaker Benjamin J.F Cruz announced the appointment of Mr. Joseph C. Wesley to serve as a member of the Guam Parole Board. Senator Cruz then read written testimony submitted behalf of Michelle Hope Taitano, Chairperson, Guam Parole Board:

Senator Cruz then called on Mayor Wesley to testify on behalf of his appointment to the Guam Parole Board.

Mayor Wesley, resident of Guam, stated that he volunteered to be a member of the parole board then noted that he is honored that Governor Calvo selected him as well. Mayor Wesley stated that he had been the Mayor of Santa Rita, that he has been a Detective Investigator and a Port Police Supervisor so he feels this background in community involvement and enforcement will help him make decisions on the Guam Parole Board. Mayor Wesley stated that he realizes the being a member of the Guam Parole Board carries great responsibility for the residents of Guam and that he will do his best to properly protect and serve them.

Vice Speaker Cruz noted that Mr. Wesley has a lengthy and well qualified confirmation packet that includes crisis management training with the F.B.I.

Senator Pangelinan stated his full support for the confirmation of Mr. Wesley. Senator Pangelinan noted that Mayor Wesley has humbly served the communities of Agat and Santa Rita with conviction and compassion and that these qualities will enable him to make proper decisions on the Guam Parole Board.



Senator Anthony Ada stated that Mr. Wesley has been a key member of the community of Santa Rita and Guam. Senator Anthony Ada stated his full support for the confirmation of Mr. Wesley.

Senator Duenas stated that Mr. Wesley is a mentor and that he will make a strong addition to the Guam Parole Board then stated his support for the confirmation of Mr. Wesley to the Guam Parole Board





 - ❖ Other public relations as required;
 - ❖ Chair meetings as required;
 - ❖ Appointments to ad hoc committees as required;
 - ❖ Attend official and social functions representing the Municipality of Santa Rita.
- ✦ Cooperate with Homeland Security representatives to inform and educate our community of a potentially heightened threat environment. Contingency plans should be developing about the DHS themes of Prevent, Prepare, Respond and Recover.
- ✦ Maintain strong liaison with the municipality's Local and Federal Members of the government branches.

- ✦ Represent the MPC declaring its will and implicitly obeying its decisions in all things as quasi-judicial capacity.
- ✦ To represent the views of constituents as closely as possible when dealing with issues that comes before the MPC.
- ✦ To participate in establishing policies with the Legislative Senate to ensure that such policies are implemented and observed in an objective and consistent manner that will assist the Mayor's and their Municipalities/Villages.
- ✦ To act as liaison with the various statutory boards, commissions, committees and other levels of government on all matters of mutual concern or as directed by MPC.
- ✦ To chair the meetings of the MPC and ensure the meetings run in a smooth and orderly manner, in accordance with the Procedural By-law.
