### COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

#### I. OVERVIEW

The appointment of Dr. Judith S. Flores to serve as a Member of the Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency was executed by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo on October 4, 2013. The appointment packet was received by the Office of Speaker Judith T. Won Pat on October 4, 2013, and the appointment was subsequently referred to the Committee on General Government Operations and Cultural Affairs on the same day.

The Committee on General Government Operations and Cultural Affairs convened a Confirmation Hearing on Thursday, November 14, 2013, at 2:00PM in the Public Hearing Room of I Liheslatura. Among the items on the agenda was the appointment of Dr. Judith S. Flores to serve as a Member of the Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency. The Confirmation Hearing for the appointment of Dr. Judith S. Flores began at 2:05 p.m. and ended at 2:10 p.m.

#### II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

**Vice Speaker Benjamin J.F Cruz** began his opening statements for the Confirmation Hearing.

"This Confirmation Hearing conducted by the Committee on General Government Operations and Cultural Affairs will come back to order. We had met this morning and recessed until two o'clock this afternoon for the purpose of hearing two confirmations to the [Council on the Arts and

Humanities Agency] Board. Notice of the Public Hearing was disseminated to all local media outlets via electronic format on November 6, 2013, with a second notice provided on November 12, 2013. Notice of the hearing was also made known on the Guam Legislature's website. We have two confirmations today, one is the Executive Appointment of Dr. Judith S. Flores as Member of the Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency, also the Executive Appointment of Dr. Michael L. Bevacqua as Literature Arts of the Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency."

**Vice Speaker Cruz** acknowledged the presence of Dr. Judith S. Flores and invited her to approach the panel.

Dr. Judith S. Flores approached the panel and began her oral statement.

"Good afternoon, Senator BJ Cruz. I am here to accept the appointment by the Governor and hope to be supported by the Legislature in my appointment as CAHA member of the board. I have many years of association with CAHA; I began working for CAHA in 1985 all the way through to 1995. And during those years I had the pleasure of identifying and promoting the many artists, traditional artists, and many of them now are masters [with whom] I [have] made friends for life. I hope now--and CAHA has helped me in so many ways to learn more about my adopted culture through my job as folk arts coordinator there, and then when I left I was running Gef Pago again CAHA was very supportive with grants for the projects that we did there, and I feel now after 20 years, it is my turn to give back. I would really like to serve on the board and be on the other side of the table and help upcoming artists fulfill their dreams as well, so thank you."

Vice Speaker Cruz made the following statement in response.

"No, it is we who should thank you for deciding that you're going to come back and help us. I mean, you ran the agency for a while and you have done all the arts and development of all the arts and have been a founder for so many organizations, besides Inetnon, Pa'a, and other groups, so it would be great to have you back on. Why don't I just read into the record Cathy Gogue's testimony and then we'll conclude this hearing."

**Vice Speaker Cruz** read a written testimony submitted by Cathy Gogue, Acting President of the Department of Chamorro Affairs.

"Hafa Adai, Vice Speaker Cruz and members of the Committee on Procurement, Cultural Affairs, Public Broadcasting, Youth & General Government Operations.

"I am providing testimony for Dr. Judy Flores as she seeks to serve as a member to the Guam Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency for a four-year term. Having known Dr. Flores for many years and having had the privilege to work with her during my tenure with the Guam Visitors Bureau – [I testify that] Dr. Flores will be a great asset to the CAHA Board of Directors.

"Individuals involved in the arts and humanities know all the great things Dr. Flores has done for the preservation and promotion of our Chamorro culture. Having attended the Administration for Native Americans' grant workshop back in 2003, Dr. Flores was recognized by the ANA grant representatives as one of the first Guam recipients to receive a grant from their distinguished organization. There are many more [of] Dr. Flores' accomplishments, too numerous to mention, that have helped perpetuate and advance Guam's unique history, language, traditions and heritage so that our future generation can enjoy, understand and appreciate all that is Chamorro.

"Grateful to have Dr. Flores accept Governor Calvo's nomination, the Department of Chamorro Affairs requests the full support of the Legislature to approve her nomination to the CAHA Board."

Vice Speaker Cruz thanked Dr. Flores and concluded her Confirmation Hearing.

#### III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on General Government Operations and Cultural Affairs hereby reports out the nomination of Dr. Judith S. Flores to serve as a Member of the Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency for a term of four years, beginning on the date of her confirmation by *I Liheslaturan* Guåhan, with the recommendation TO CONFIRM.



Centerstone Creations replicates her art in glass, hand painted by artists in the Chinese traditional reverse painting style, in glass latte, ornaments and candleholders. Her original art can be seen in many professional offices, hotels and restaurants, such as the Hilton Resort & Spa, Pacific Islands Club, TakeCare Administrative offices, Bank of Guam, First Hawaiian Bank, Kings Restaurant, and Kaneshiro Orthodontist Clinic. Her paintings are in homes all over the world, collected by people who have lived in Guam and want to have a fine art memory of their time spent on the island.
