




COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Education, Public Library and Women's Affairs convened a public hearing on August 7, 2014 at 4:00 pm in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of Mrs. Maria S. Connelley as a Member of Guam Community College Board of Trustees the appointment history as follows:

- Appointed by the Governor of Guam on July 2, 2014, term to expire November 10, 2017.
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on July 2, 2014; and
- Appointment packet forwarded to the Committee for public consideration on July 7, 2014.

All legal requirements for public notices were met, with requests for publication sent to all media and all Senators on July 30, 2014, (5-Day Notice) and August 4, 2014 (48-Hour Notice) via email. Copies of the hearing notices are appended to the committee report.

- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** announced that the Committee will hear the nomination of Ms. Maria Connelley, Member, GCC Board of Trustees. Speaker acknowledged the support of Antonia Santos, Rosa Pablo, Michael Santos, Antoinette Dydasco, Vincent Santos, and Carlos Pangelinan. Speaker also mentioned that Deborah Belanger will provide written testimony. Speaker announced that Carmen Santos will provide oral testimony. Speaker mentioned that she will proceed with Mr. Vincent Santos and Ms. Carmen Santos.

- **Mr. Vince Santos** fully supports the appointment of Maria S. Connelley. She mentioned that Maria is dedicated, passionate, and professional. Mr. Santos mentioned that the appointee has numerous experiences in HR in the private and federal sectors and she has the knowledge that you can count on.

- **Ms. Carmen Santos** read the testimony for Ms. Mary Okada, President of Guam Community College. President Okada written testimony is attached to the committee report.

- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** mentioned that written testimony was given by Deborah Belanger, chairperson of GCC Board of Trustees and letter of support from Edith De Leon Guerrero from CNMI Secretary of Interior, and letter of support from Grace Donaldson. Their written testimony is attached to the committee report. Speaker asked the public if there is anyone else who would like to testify.

- **Mr. Greg Perez** gave oral testimony and is in full support of the appointment of Ms. Maria Conneley. He mentioned Maria to be an experienced, well educated, and well trained who is a result and goal oriented person. He also believes that Ms. Conneley will be a great asset to the board.

- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** called up the appointee Ms. Conneley.

- **Ms. Connelley** thanked Carmen for providing the background and work experience to the Committee. Thanked the public, family and friends in attendance. She mentioned that she was in the board of trustees 10 years ago. She mentioned that out of the 50 years of service, 40 years of that she was a public servant working for both the federal government and the government of Guam and about 10 years working in the public sector.

- **Ms. Connelley** thanked the Community College under the leadership of Mary, she has been doing a fantastic job, a tremendous job, as far apprenticeship programs.

- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** thanked the appointee for her testimony. Speaker mentioned that the appointee served as a board the first time, and that you are willing to serve a second time and thanked the appointee who is willing to help the college and institution. Speaker asked, is there anything else you are willing to do to shape Guam's workforce?

- **Ms. Connelley** mentioned to extend law to hire more jobs for apprentices and give incentives as far as their GRT. To also look closely to the Mayors, AHRD to receive workers. She also mentioned that they have the University and the Community College to provide the academics and to provide the training that they need to get the academic background to get the training that they need that are currently available for outsiders.

- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** asked what are your suggestions to entice our people for jobs that may be available?

- **Ms. Connelley** replied we need to look for people who are willing to work, who have the desire to be trained into something that will have them to have better job.

- **Vice Chairperson Yamashita, Ph.D** thanked the appointee for stepping up and taking time to serve. Senator Yamashita mentioned that AHRD, Department of Labor, and GDOE have to be in concert, because that is the human capital aspect is to get them early, to motivate them and help them learn in the world of work. Senator Yamashita thanked her insight and for taking her seat as a member of the board of trustees.

- **Senator San Nicolas** fully supports the nomination of the appointee. Senator San Nicolas mentioned that institutions of hiring learning are not only supposed to meet the mission of educating people post secondary but also supposed to meet the incubators for research development and supply side economic growth.

- **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D.** asked the appointee if there is anything else you want to add?

- **Ms. Connelley** replied that she looks forward in the confirmation with the board and with President Mary Okada.

- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** thanked the appointee for her contributions and volunteering in the board.

- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** concluded the public hearing for the nominee.

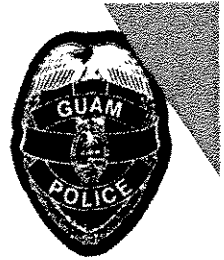

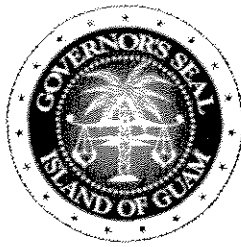
