I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Education, Public Library and Women's Affairs convened a public hearing on August 7, 2014 at 4:00 pm in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. - Speaker Won Pat Ed.D announced that the Committee will hear the nomination of Ms. Maria Connelley, Member, GCC Board of Trustees. Speaker acknowledged the support of Antonia Santos, Rosa Pablo, Michael Santos, Antoinette Dydasco, Vincent Santos, and Carlos Pangelinan. Speaker also mentioned that Deborah Belanger will provide written testimony. Speaker announced that Carmen Santos will provide oral testimony. Speaker mentioned that she will proceed with Mr. Vincent Santos and Ms. Carmen Santos.
- Mr. Vince Santos fully supports the appointment of Maria S. Connelley. She mentioned that Maria is dedicated, passionate, and professional. Mr. Santos mentioned that the appointee has numerous experiences in HR in the private and federal sectors and she has the knowledge that you can count on.
