COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Health and Human Services, Health Insurance Reform, Economic Development and Senior Citizens convened a public hearing on **Wednesday**, **February 20**, **2013** at **5:30pm** in *I Liheslatura*'s Public Hearing Room.

Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of Mr. Monte Del Mar Mesa as a Member of the Guam Economic Development Authority Board of Directors, and whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo on January 7, 2013.
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on January 31, 2013;
- Appointment packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on February 02, 2013.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 5:32pm.

Chairman Rodriguez invited those who signed up to testify:

Jeff Marchesseault: Please see attached written testimony.



Chairman Rodriguez: Thank you. Mr. Baldyga, before you begin your testimony, I would just like to thank you for your leadership in GVB, most especially in responding with the recent tragedy that occurred in Tumon. We would also like to let you know that the Legislature is here to support.

Mark Baldyga: Please see attached written testimony

Senator Yamashita: I want to echo what our Chairman had said. I want to thank you for your efforts as a leader.

Monte Mesa, Appointee: I appreciate the comments and the testimonies and I am here and honored to continue to serve and contribute positively. I look forward to working with all of you as I have in my previous capacity. I look forward to continuing this island paradise to making Guam a place to live and making a place to grow with our family. I would like to try to achieve that in whatever capacity.

Senator Yamashita: I have gotten to know you in the last two years, everywhere I go you are there and you are a very humble person. GEDA, I am learning a lot from GEDA and I ask at the whole buy local campaign you keep that moving and growing with. The farmers coop in Dededo and I would like all schools to buy local. We have 7 and lost one so I want to know what happened. We would live to see that be a priority. I hope you are looking at transportation to help our people. As it also affect economic development. We met with GEDA and talking about the regional health distribution center plan and I am wondering what you think about that?

Monte Mesa: I believe that there is an opportunity in that regard. I can see that report and dealing with national retailers and off course a lot of manufacturing is done in Asia. I know that the shipping channels to China and the West Coast can sometimes be challenging and maybe temporarily disrupted. I saw that study and that can be an opportunity for Guam in regards to dock where we can bring ships to Guam or fly merchandise to the US. Again, these are for high valued brands that want to be first in the shelves in the market. We would like to see an opportunity for Guam to serve as a hub, potentially, as an option for distribution.

Senator Yamashita: Is that something we can talk about a little bit more at another time?

Monte Mesa: Yes. Again, it can be a certain interest of particular brands but there are more viable options that can be developed. We hope to be fruitful in a 3-5 year strategy based on what the business model is.

Senator Yamashita: My concern is that, when the industry takes a dip, we all know what happens. I really want to see to diversify our economic development. I really hope that we can do new things as well and that all people are welcomed to be trained in the industry. I look forward



to sitting down with you and discussing more of this.

Senator Morrison: What will be your top priority going into GEDA?

Monte Mesa: One of them would be attracting hotel investments. Second, a long term strategy would be developing the cruise industry. I think that as the critical mass of source market focuses onto Asia, a tropical paradise destination, like Guam and the Micronesia, can be something like what the Carribean has done for the cruise industry. I see that future where Guam can be a crossroad between China and Australia. Another option that I am passionate about is the Buy Local products. I have been observing the strategy of what the Chamorro Village was set up to do. I am looking to push for made in Guam products as we establish a great marketing effort. I have stated to GVB as one of my priorities to creating a marketing effort to attract visitors to come here. Now I have developed a plan that I will introduce with GEDA. I know they now have a step grant that can be an avenue to provide our local carvers or weavers which will enable them to produce made in Guam products.

Senator Morrison: I am not sure if you are aware of another initiative that has been discussed which is the "Eat Local"

Monte Mesa: No, not yet but I will definitely look into and how we can continue to foster that

Senator McCreadie: What is your solution in giving small businesses that work hard but fall short in capital and at the same time not needing the government being in the way of their progress? How would you market cultural arts and/or the night market?

Monte Mesa: I think one of the ways is where GEDA can assist. The Federal grants are supposed to give opportunities for small businesses to succeed. I think that as we continue to bring awareness to these grants, there is a significant amount to support small businesses that has a lot of restriction. In this, they can show that there is a lot of viability in their products or service and as long as they comply with all the reporting and measuring of their continual progress, hopefully help them in their endeavors. The STEP grant can encourage them more because there is assistance that can help them.

Senator McCreadie: I think that it is important to educate them with the available grants as well facilitating nit to make sure that their businesses are sustainable.

Senator Limitaco: I have a high regard for you and your experience and you have my support.

Senator pangelinan: In what other capacity have you recently served in a commission for the government of Guam?

Monte Mesa: I served on the GVB Board as an elected member and I served as a Chairman for Chairman, Committee on Health & Human Services, Health Insurance Reform, Economic Development, & Senior Citizens

the Port Authority on Guam.

Senator pangelinan: The one that Governor Calvo said that corruption was pervasive at the Port and that what we're seeing in the most recent issues at the port is that the tip of the ice in terms of corruption at the Port. Are you familiar with any corruption at the Port? How long was your service as a Chairman at the Port?

Monte Mesa: I served six years as Chairman.

Senator pangelinan: Six years. Did you see any corruption at the port?

Monte Mesa: Not when I was in charge of it.

Senator pangelinan: So, you think they were hiding it from you that you couldn't see any corruption at the Port, or it just wasn't there?

Monte Mesa: It wasn't apparent to me, at the time I was there. We were looking for a master plan and getting the funding for it and we succeeded and got \$50 million from the Department of Defense who supported our plan. There was corruption at the Port and you are saying that you didn't see it and that they hid it from you really well. I just see a problem that you don't have the capacity, if Governor Calvo is correct, to find, see, or smell any corruption that can occur and they appoint you to another agency. He would call your agency under your direction under a policy perspective, a leadership perspective, and everybody reporting to you and that there was nothing there that you saw that was corrupt or was not in the public interest at all. Then, Governor Calvo comes in a year and say that it's in the tip of the ice berg, corruption is pervasive, I have to change the manager and take the manager somewhere else. I have a problem with that. You know that I am a blunt, honest person, and sometimes people do not appreciate that. They just know that's just the way I am. For me that is a mixed message that he would take the same p[people he blames for corruption and take them somewhere else where they are in the same position. What is going to occur?

Monte Mesa: I disagree with you, Senator. I think you painted a broad brush on the situation. Again, it was an alleged mismanagement..

Senator pangelinan: The Governor said it was not alleged. He had the Port reported to the FBI, the Attorney General. If it's alleged it would be written as alleged that there was corruption at the p[ort and that it was pervasive and it occurred under your watch as well.

Monte Mesa: I disagree with that. That is not how the story went out in the paper. There was no reference to me as a Chairman...



a part of that.

Monte Mesa: I'm not aware of that when I was a Chairman there. Looking at the long term vision, looking at what the Port needs in the master plan development because that was the focus at the time. Again, I disagree of your reading of the situation in saying that my leadership was corrupt.

Senator pangelinan: Again, that is what the Governor said on his press release.

Monte Mesa: I think that's misleading because I don't think he named me.

Monte Mesa: In light of that message, in leading GVB for ten years, we've accomplished and came back in a very remarkable fashion despite the tsunami in Japan. I think those are some that we need to look at in positive aspects.

Senator Rodriguez: You spoke about the STEP grant in GEDA, are you familiar with the SSBCI program, a 13.1 million grant received from the US treasury. As an incoming member, I ask that you also push for that and promote it to our small businesses.

Senator Yamashita: your vision to help small businesses and I hope you get GEDA to talk to agriculture to get agencies together. Wish you the best of luck.


