The Committee on Appropriations, Public Debt, Legal Affairs, Retirement, Public Parks, Recreation, Historic Preservation and Land convened a public hearing on March 12, 2013 at 9:00 AM in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of Mr. Pelagio S. Sardoma to serve as a Member of the Board of Equalization, and whose appointment history is as follows:

- 1. Appointed by Governor Edward J. Calvo on February 8, 2013 for Four (4), expiring in the year 2017
- 2. Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on February 11, 2013;
- 3. Appointment packet forwarded to this committee for public hearing on February 12, 2013;

#### **Public Notice Requirements**

Notices were disseminated via email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on March 5, 2013 (5-Day Notice), and again on March 8, 2013 (48-Hour Notice).

#### Senators Present

Senator Vicente C. Pangelinan, Chairman Vice Speaker BJ Cruz, Vice Chairman Senator Tommy Morrison, Member Senator Mike Limtiaco, Member Senator Frank Aguon

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 9:00 AM.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: Good Morning to all that are here today and all those who are listening on air. We are here to conduct the Public Hearing on the Committee on Appropriations, Public Debt, Legal Affairs, Retirement, Public Parks, Recreation, Historic Preservation and Land. Here are the members of the

legislature: We have on my left Senator Tommy Morrison, Thank you for being here.

We have on our agenda two items: The confirmation of hearing for Pelagio S. Sardoma for the Board of Equalization and Mr. Victor F. Cruz, for the Board of the Guam Land Use Commission. The Bills that we are hearing to receive the public's interest are:

Bills no. 5-32 to add the new chapter referencing FQ Sanchez Elementary School under the jurisdiction of the Umatac Mayors Office;

Bill no 17-32, the author of the Bill notified us, the Committee, that this bill is withdrawn so we won't be hearing about this Bill this morning.

Bill Number 29-32 relative to the Competitive Equalization on the leasing of Government properties.

Bill Number 47-32 an act to add a new section 8103.1 to article 1 chapter 8 relative to the Internal Revenue Code Requirements applicable relative to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund.

Bill Number 54-32 relative to the Fund Management to the Host Committee Benefits.

We have joining us Senator Frank Aguon Jr. and Senator Mike Limtiaco and I would like to recognize the presence of Mayor Doris Lujan of Inalajan and the Mayor of Umatac, Mayor Quinata. Thank you sir.

We will go ahead and begin the presentation for the candidates for the Board of Equalization at this time I would like to go ahead and call Mr. Sardoma to please come forward and Mr. Art Ilagan, who is the Insurance and Banking Commissioner at the Department of Revenue and Taxation, he signed up to testify. We will begin with Mr. Ilagan and the nominee will go last.

#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

#### Mr. Art Ilagan

Mr. Ilagan: Thank you Mr. Senator, Senator Limtiaco, Senator Morrison, Senator Aguon. My name is Art Ilagan, the former Director of Revenue and Taxation and currently the Insurance and Banking Commissioner. In my ten years as Commissioner of Revenue and Taxation, Pell Sardoma was one of the board members that fill the slot on the Board of Equalization. During his tenure it was a difficult decision to fill because people were not interested and he stepped up to the plate. During his tenure he heard almost all of the protest on assessments that we made on properties and through his tenure we completed if not all, most of it. At this point on time, I don't believe the Board of Equalization has the majority and I am here to support Mr. Pell not only as a professional but I also know him personally.

His son and my son were classmates at St. Anthony and then Father Duenas. I got to know him personally, I believe his work ethics and his desire to complete his work on the Board of Equalization in the past is his true testament for what he could do for the Government. Thank you.

**Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan**: Thank you and Si Yu'os Ma'åse Mr. Ilagan. Why don't you go on now Mr. Sardoma.

#### Mr. Pelagio Sardoma

Mr. Sardoma: Good Morning everybody my name is Pelagio Sardoma, Mr friends call me "Pel" P.E.L.(spelling it out) for short. I was a member of the board since 2005 and probably until September 2011 that is when we signed the assessment for the Chair, and after that, we have not met. I have not heard from the Board. But early this year I received a call from the Governor's office asking me if I am interested to be a member again. Which I said "yes", that's why I am here this morning.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: Thank you, Si Yu'os Ma'åseMr. Sardoma. Any questions from the panel for Mr. Ilagan and Mr. Sardoma

**Senator Frank Aguon**: Thank you Senator, Mr. Ilagan for your testimony. Just a quick question what was the level activity associated with the Board of Equalization.

Mr. Sardoma: The record will speak for itself that I wasn't absent for any meetings.

**Senator Frank Aguon**: Actually Mr. Sardoma, I am not questioning your attendance and your commitment because that was highlighted by Mr. Ilagan. Really your actions in the past, I was wondering what level of activities, decisions you had to make to benefit the community like once a month you entertain 4 or 5 situations or cases, just trying to understand the volume of activities is associated with the Board of Equalization, did you meet once a month?

**Mr. Sardoma**: 2005 about a couple of years thereafter there are a lot pending appeals. Which I believe there was no board at that time that took action for these pending appeals, and for a short time we were able to take care of those cases, one by one. And to date I don't recall any pending cases.

**Senator Frank Aguon**: I guess its directly linked, Mr Chairman, Mr. Speaker, in line with the nature of the activities and how much work they have to really consume on a monthly basis. I appreciate your clearing all the outstanding cases in the past and I certainly have an appreciation for your service to our island and I want to commend you for accepting the appointment on behalf of the Chief Executive

because I think that ultimately this is not only voluntary to the community, this is extending yourself above and beyond. Thank Mr. Sardoma and I wish you the best of luck. Thank you Mr. Speaker.

**Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan**: Si Yu'os Ma'åse Senator Aguon, Senator Morrison? Senator Limtiaco? Thank you very much, maybe Mr Ilagan can you tell me how many seats now have been filled and how many are vacant pending nomination.

Mr. Ilagan: Mr. chairman, in the past there was always Moe Cotton, Cynthia Ecube and Pel Sardoma. The other position were very difficult to filled because its voluntary and the work load in the past, I think we had over 100 protest or appeals or assessments on personal and also commercial properties. This year, and I believe last year, John Camacho and his real estate branch are trying to reassess the properties so I know there is going to be protest/appealing their assessments. And right now there is 5 on the board Mr. Sardoma is the third. I believe he is the third to be heard, and there is the administration and we still looking for two more, but it takes three, with the three we have the majority,

**Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan**: So at three does it have to be unanimous?

Mr. Ilagan: Yes.

**Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan:** So your still looking, so I think there are two vacant seats, you know the Governor's Office is having trouble filling it maybe Mr. Sardoma can come forward with a volunteer. And of course with the upcoming assessment we get a full contingent with the board so that we can allow the general public full representation, when they may have an issue with upcoming valuations. They get a full compliment to plead their case should they wish to do so. Somebody who is in a Management structure please relay to John that there is a need to do this. I think it's critical and urgent to identify individuals who may wish to serve on the Board of Equalization and we will do the same and maybe we can make suggestions if we still have trouble with finding nominees. We will try to assist in that. Mr. Sardoma the property valuations are going to be very critical to the financial position with the government. We have already maxed out the valuations of the property for the purpose of borrowing. What do you think, do you think the legislature or the administration should entertain any additional increase in the borrowing of the government that would require and would you support increasing the value of properties for that purpose.

**Mr. Sardoma**: Increasing the value of the properties just to satisfy the provisions of this borrowing I am not sure that is really a good idea. But we hire professionals that interact appraisals and we hope that based on the actual conditions right now, we

hope the value of the property has increase since the last time the property was appraised

**Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan**: Thank you very much. I noticed in your nomination packets that you're a real estate broker are you still active.

Mr. Sardoma: Yes sir.

**Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan**: And you're still active in that practice and you're still active in your accounting service practice.

Mr. Sardoma: Yes sir.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: Mr. Limtiaco?

**Senator Limtiaco**: Mr. Sardoma just one question, what is holding us back, you mention that there are five positions and three are filled, there are two vacant positions.

Mr. Ilagan: People are not willing to step up, there is work that needs to get done. I believe they don't even get a stipend for it. They just come in once a month. For somebody who has a profession they rather work and make money than to volunteer their time. Sometimes it takes a whole afternoon to go over these appeals or to hear what's going on with the real estate industry. It takes time it is not an easy job. I thank Pel for the past, and Moe and Cynthia for staying there and accepting again under this administration. We are trying very hard to look for people. We have asked and most of the time they don't want to be scrutinized in front of the legislature. It takes somebody special like Pel, Moe and Cynthia.

**Senator Mike Limtiaco**: So you feel the confirmation portion is the main impediment to being on the board. People do not want to come before the legislature.

**Mr. Ilagan**: That is part of it but it is also the work they have to do.

**Senator Mike Limtiaco**: What would you do, the workload is going to be pretty intense for the three, do you have any idea how to rally the troops and get some other people to help you. Do you know anybody that you might be able to convince to come on board to assist?

**Mr. Sardoma**: Right now I have nobody in mind, but now that you mention I will try to maybe inform Mr. Ilagan if I find somebody.

**Senator Mike Limtiaco:** Thank you for you service I am just concern that in the absence of one individual that you cannot proceed with any of the protest.

Mr. Sardoma: That is correct.

**Senator Mike Limtiaco**: Thank you for stepping up and providing your service to the community.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: Art, what is the frequency of the meetings?

**Mr. Ilagan**: It suppose to be once a month.

**Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan**: I also want to thank Vice Speaker BJ Cruz for joining us this morning. Any other questions or comments.....Senator Aguon?

**Senator Frank Aguon**: Thank you very much Mr.Speaker, Mr Sardoma I noticed that you highlighted that you are self employeed, is that under a business or just yourself? Do you own a business?

Mr. Sardoma: Pardon?

Senator Frank Aguon: Do you own a business?

Mr. Sardoma: Yes sir.

Senator Frank Aguon: And it's a Sole Proprietor.

Mr. Sardoma: Yes, Sole Proprietor.

**Senator Frank Aguon**: The only reason I ask is because in the Statement of Liabilities does not highlight any business interest that you own so .......I think that should have been reflected in this particular document for the record in recognition that he does own a business.

**Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan**: Thank you very much Mr. Sardoma and congratulations on your nomination. Thank you for agreeing to continue into this public service on the Board of Equalization. Si Yu'os Ma'åse.

**Chairman Pangelinan:** Thank you. Si Yu'os Ma'ase. That concludes the testimony for Pelagio Sardoma's appointment to the Board of Equalization.

The public hearing was adjourned at 11:39 AM.

#### III. FINDINGS & RECOMMENDATIONS




