COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The nomination of Renie A. Llaneta to serve as a member of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board was made by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo on September 30, 2014. The nomination packet was received by the Office of Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D., on October 1, 2014. The nomination of Renie A. Llaneta was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations on October 2, 2014.

The Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations convened a legislative hearing on October 14, 2014 at 2:04 p.m. in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was the nomination of Renie A. Llaneta. The hearing was adjourned at 2:47 p.m.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Michael San Nicolas convened a hearing for the nomination of Renie Llaneta to serve on the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board. He stated that Mr. Llaneta is currently serving as member and has again been nominated to serve. Chairman San Nicolas asked how Mr. Llaneta's current term has been.

Renie Llaneta stated that his experience has been very good. He stated that there are many challenges facing the Board and he believed that there remains lots of unfinished business. He stated that the current Board has many ideas that they are working on which he believed to be beneficial to the people of Guam.

Chairman San Nicolas asked if he has encountered operational challenges as a member of the Board.

Mr. Lianeta stated that he understands that there are resource issues being encountered throughout the entire government. He stated that the Board is currently facing a lack of manpower which has made it difficult to conduct inspections of businesses. Mr. Llaneta stated that the current Board has asked the Executive Branch to allow its members to assist with inspections.

Chairman San Nicolas asked Mr. Llaneta if he, as a Board member and in accordance with public law, received training and education on the role of the Board and its duties and responsibilities.

Mr. Llaneta stated that he did receive the necessary training.

Chairman San Nicolas asked Mr. Llaneta his thoughts about deputizing individuals to serve as inspectors with regards to the Alcoholic Beverage Control laws.

Mr. Llaneta expressed interest in the concept. He stated that additional manpower will create more visibility. He mentioned that if these deputized individuals would need to be properly trained and educated about the role and responsibility they will possess.

Chairman San Nicolas explained the impetus for his idea and informed Mr. Llaneta that proposed legislation is being drafted. He thanked the nominee for accepting the nomination. Chairman San Nicolas proceeded to explain a little about Mr. Llaneta's background.

Senator Frank Aguon mentioned that if the Board finds the need for legal authority to assist in carrying out its responsibilities, the members should not hesitate to inform the Committee if such need arises. He further asked about the alcoholic beverage licenses issued per village.

Mr. Llaneta stated that the Board is currently enforcing that law.

Senator Aguon thanked the nominee for accepting the nomination.

Mr. Llaneta mentioned that the Board has been very strict about ensuring that all alcoholic beverage licensing requirements are followed.

Chairman San Nicolas asked if a large number of license requests have been rejected as a result of the village quota.

Mr. Llaneta stated that, since public awareness about the issue has increased, not many requests are being sought. He mentioned that the employees at the Department of Revenue and Taxation have been very good about informing prospective applicants about the village quota and that the Board has been strongly enforcing the law.

Chairman San Nicolas stated that he was glad to hear that the Department of Revenue and Taxation are informing the prospective applicants as to not let the issue reach the Board level. He stated that he is pleased to learn that the process is being more closely monitored and that everyone is working together to ensure a smoother process.

Mr. Llaneta stated that everyone is more aware of the process because the individuals who are processing the licenses are the same individuals who are supposed to conduct the inspections.

Senator Aguon expressed concern that the village quota with regards to alcoholic beverage licensing could serve as a hindrance to the creation of certain small businesses and hoped that potential business owners would be directed toward other avenues in which they could start their business. He mentioned the example of a prospective bar owner being informed of the village quota and being advised to instead start a restaurant that would be able to serve alcoholic beverages.


Mr. Llaneta stated that he only knows of a few instances in which this type of situation occurred. He mentioned that the advice to explore the restaurant option has always been given. Mr. Llaneta stated that the intention of the Board has never been to curtail the establishment of small businesses. He stated that there will always be businesses that may try to circumvent the law and stated that one of the ideas mentioned to help stop that type of behavior is the increase in fines.

Chairman San Nicolas cautioned against increasing fines before increasing the frequency of the onsite inspections. He stated his belief that increasing the frequency of inspections will help deter any blatant non-compliance with current laws. He thanked the Board and the Department of Revenue and Taxation employees for the improvement of the process. Chairman San Nicolas stated his support for the nominee and convened the hearing.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns, and Future Generations hereby reports out the nomination of Renie A. Llaneta to serve as a member of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, for a term of two (2) years expiring on June 30, 2016, with the recommendation
