COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Public Safety, Infrastructure and Maritime Transportation convened a public hearing on December 12, 2013 at 2:00 pm in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. The sole item on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of Timothy T. Kernaghan to serve as a Member to the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port Authority of Guam, whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by Eddie Baza Calvo, Governor, on October 29, 2013;
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on October 30, 2013;
- Appointment packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on October 30, 2013.

Notices were disseminated via email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on Wednesday, December 4, 2013 (5-Day Notice), and again on Tuesday, December 10, 2013 (48-Hour Notice).

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 2:27 pm.

Chairperson Ada opens the floor for testimony and announces that Ms. Christine Baleto (Vice-Chairperson PAG BOD), Ms. Mary Michelle Gibson (Secretary, PAG BOD), and Mr. John Thomas Brown submitted written testimony before the hearing. (Please see attached for written testimony)

Mr. Francisco Santos, Port Authority of Guam Board of Directors Chairperson

Oral Testimony

Mr. Santos states that on behalf of the other board members [of the Port Authority's Board of Directors] he is present to give his [their] 100% support for the confirmation of Mr. Kernaghan. Mr. Santos further states that he believes based on Mr. Kernaghan's management skills and experience, he will contribute to the many ongoing at the projects at the Port. He closes by

stating that Mr. Kernaghans leadership will help him and the other Board Members take care of the number one asset of the Port, the Port's Employees.

Dr. Lee Yudin, University of Guam, Dean, College of Natural and Applied Sciences
Oral Testimony

Dr. Yudin states that he is in favor of the nomination of Mr. Tim Kernaghan. He further states that he has served on numerous projects and committees with Mr. Kernaghan. One is the Sanctuary Board where he'd like the committee to know he saw Mr. Kernaghan is not a micro manager and he understands his role as a board member and policy-maker. He further states that the Legislature will not find a better person who understands the roles of Boards and Board Members and their responsibility to the Island of Guam. He continues by stating that Mr. Kernaghan has been on Guam for almost 35 and his service on the Board will be a benefit to all the people of Guam. Dr. Yudin goes on stating Mr. Kernaghan's background bringing in food and goods to Guam give him the experience he needs to serve on the [Port] Board. Dr. Yudin closes by stating Mr. Kernaghan is the best person to serve on the Board and it will be hard to find someone else more well suited to the [Port] Board.

Mr. Timothy T. Kernaghan, Nominee
Oral Testimony

Mr. Kernaghan opens by stating that he has been involved with bringing freight through the Port for the past 30 years. He further states that what happens at the Port for the good impacts him and what happens for the bad impacts him. Mr. Kernaghan continues by stating that he has been through a full range of experience with the Port and he states that can help him working with the Port Board to improve conditions at the Port. He states that he agrees with the Chair that the most important asset is the Port Employees. He goes on saying that their safety and training are paramount and that the Port needs to be competitively priced. He states that as a Port user, the main challenge he faces is, what has happened to the money that users have seen in tariff increases. He further states that as a user, money should have gone to capital gains and improvements. He closes by stating that his focus will be that the benefits listed in the tariff increases are in fact where the money is spent.

Discussion, Question and Answer

Senator Duenas states that his experience with Mr. Kernaghan tells him that he is going to be an excellent addition to the Port Board. He further states that with Mr. Kernaghan's and his involvement in Sanctuary and DYA that Mr. Kernaghan's character is exemplary he hoped the Committee Members who did not know him would see that as the addition it will be to the Port Board should Mr. Kernaghan's nomination be confirmed.

Chairperson Ada states he is impressed with Mr. Kernaghna's taking the time to get familiar with the current issues at the Port. Chairperson Ada further states that because Mr. Kernaghan is part of the wholesale industry, he knows that Mr. Kernaghan has a vested interest in what happens at the Port. Chairperson Ada states he finds comfort in Mr. Kernaghan's vested interest will ensure that the Port's throughput is as efficient as possible. Chairperson Ada continues by

stating tariff increases and the plan for the multi-year tariff increase are interrelated. Specifically, Chairperson Ada states there are certain prerequisites, especially the Master Plan Update, that need to be in place before the tariff increases are accomplished. Chairperson Ada states that he hopes that as a Board, they do not allow the Master Plan Update to sit with the various approval entities before it gets moving. He further encourages aggressive follow-up from the entities because there are many things the tariff plan, which must follow the master plan, will support. Chairperson Ada states Mr. Kernaghan is joining the Board at a very exciting time on the ground floor of a lot of activity at the Port. Chairperson Ada closes by stating that he supports the confirmation barring any surprises coming out of the woodwork.

Chairperson Ada asks if there are any other questions and, there being done, adjourns the hearing at 2:37pm.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Public Safety, Infrastructure and Maritime Administration hereby reports on the appointment of Mr. Timothy T. Kernaghan to serve as a member to the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port Authority Board of Directors, with the recommendation to confirm.
