I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Health and Human Services, Health Insurance Reform, Economic Development and Senior Citizens convened a public hearing on **Thursday, March 13, 2014 at 9am** in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room.

Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of **Mr. Valentino G. Perez as a General Member of the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority Board of Trustees**, and whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo on February 7, 2014.
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on February, 7, 2014;
- Appointment packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on February 11, 2014.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 9:03am.

Chairman Rodriguez: Next on the agenda is the executive appointment of Mr. Valentino G. Perez as a general member of the GMHA Board of Trustees and the term of appointment here are indicated by the Governor is 6 years. We do have the appointee present here and I'd like to invite him up. Good Morning Mr. Perez, thank you very much for being here and congratulations on your appointment. We do have your packet and so if you would like to make an opening statement or brief remarks we'll welcome that at this point.

Valentino Perez: Absolutely, thank you for having me in front of you. It's, to me, quite an honor to be appointed to the Board. My purpose for looking for appointment or accepting it was that I wanted to just help the hospital. I know some of the board members, I know the operations that

have been going through, especially in the public eye, and I was told that we were short some board members and we are having a hard time filling those slots and with that because not a full slate of board members sometimes we go through some periods when we don't have board meetings for the hospital. I'm looking to help fill that slot, so that at least we make one and then hopefully help out with some operations and finance on my side to make some sound decisions.

Chairman Rodriguez: Okay, thank you very much, Senator Aguon, do you have any questions?

Senator Aguon: Thank you very much Mr. Chairman and Mr. Perez, I would also like to echo the settlements of the good chair on terms of accepting this particular appointment and stepping forward and I think that perhaps the Guam Memorial Hospital maybe one of the most challenging government entities to work for and to serve the people of Guam in over the course of the next 3-5 years and I say that, understanding full well that not only does GMH continue to undergo some financial challenges on a daily basis because I also highlight that the opening of the Guam Medical facility at the brand new hospital is certainly going to have an impact on the operations of GMH. The question is what type of impact and how can we continue to ensure that that public hospital facility operates for the benefit of the community and the people of Guam who otherwise the neighbor brand new facility so I think that's an issue that is going to be discussed extensively in the courses of next year, year in half. I certainly hope that you monitor not only the finances because you bring a financial background of perspective to GMH and that is going to be extremely helpful in terms of monitoring where the resources are originating from, what the collectables are, how the receivables are and how GMH is pursuing those much needed funds, but also monitoring the activities and the impact on the operations as a result of the brand new partner that is going to be opening up at if not the end of this year, but early next year. I thank you again for stepping forward and extending yourself to the community of Guam and I certainly look forward on your service on that particular board. Thank you.

Valentino Perez: Thank you.

Chairman Rodriguez: Thank you Senator, Senator McCreadie?

Senator McCreadie: Thank you Mr. Chairman and I would like to thank my other colleague Senator Aguon as well and I share the same sentiments as him. I look at you and I was talking to you earlier, before the hearing and this is your first time. I don't think that is a bad thing I think fusion of new energy and new ideas is a great thing. I thank you for accepting this nomination for 6 years and you're absolutely right. There's a void, there's a gap they need to fill and not just the hospital, there is a lot of board members we need to fill. The hospital is probably the toughest one; it is not the easiest job or board member to make those tough decisions and I look at your background and your packet and you're very qualified to do this job and it's an honor for you, but it's an honor for us to get people who are qualified who have a vision and a financial

background that can lead this hospital in the right direction. I don't have any questions, but maybe just one, have you seen the financial sheets of the hospital?

Valentino Perez: I have, sorry about that, even over last year I looked at the financial statements, I was interested in the hospital when I was working. My biggest problem with this position and not just me but for any board member or for Guam as a government is knowing the challenges when the new hospital comes. One of the biggest problems with the hospital is that we get patients in there that can't pay right? We know that, that's just a given, but as a financial advisor even as a personal financial advisor, I use to tell my clients hey, if you want more than what you got, you got to do one or two things you either make more money or spend less. There is no way around it, it is basic budgeting and looking at the financials I know they got a problem, but we're also a community hospital in which we can't turn away a single patient. We got two issues at hand that we're trying to make them independent and self sufficient, but we would like for them to be so, but it's darn impossible just because we can't turn anybody away. The beauty about any other non community hospital, especially the new hospital coming up they are able to pick and choose their clients and make sure they pay because they're going to go after the insures, so for me it's a no win situation for the hospital, but in trying to help it out and see if we can make it better and make them a little more self sufficient and knowing that the new hospital is going to be coming up there is a big operational issues that if we do lose, some of the clients let's just say, sorry if I am saying clients instead of patients because they are the customers. Let's say you lose half of the customers of GMH, you've got a mass building a lot of square footage, a lot of volume full of air that you need to air condition, the operational numbers are still going to stay the same because you have the staff, but if you don't have that many patients coming in to provide the revenue where do they go? Where does the hospital go? I want to help. I've spoken to Mr. Olrighch, Mr Verga and I think I'll help them. I think they genuinely want to do the best that they can and they're trying their best and it's just sometimes it may be hard for them to do so, but being able to see how things are run in the inside as well and report that and help make decisions on that I'm hoping that I can help. I am not saying that I got the answers, I most definitely don't, but bringing in a perspective just another side, a non medical perspective, I hope that I can. From the medical side, I have two brothers that are both doctors and I kind of see the way they think and working over at FHP I know how providers think as well there and what they're suppose to as far as caring for the patients regarding financials, yes I have it's kind of scary.

Senator McCreadie: I just wanted to ask just a follow up question if I may Mr. Chairman. You said you would either raise the revenue generation or cut right obviously that is the core.

Valentino Perez: In budgeting, absolutely.

Senator McCreadie: How would you raise it and what would you cut?

Valentino Perez: That is a hard question.

Senator McCreadie: It's a tough question.

Valentino Perez: Just because I don't truly know the current operations of the hospital, but I was talking about a more personal basis. When I have customers they also say they want a boat, they want a motorcycle, they're sending their kids to college and yet they are working off of 50,000 dollars a year and they have a mortgage to pay in their brand new home. It's hard to fund all those things, so you either want less, spend less to fund more or you just say you want less, or you make more money with that respect making more money for the hospital, you get more patients right? That's the billing side, you can bill all that revenue and collect all the revenue is a different story or anybody can use a credit card you can buy it there you go, sometimes that credit card company collecting the money owed it is sometimes easier said than done. Cutting operations I don't know and I don't want to really guess on that one at the moment, but if you look at what is a priority and what needs to be staffed and what operating machines that may cost a lot of money or use a lot of power just think proactively and try to minimize the usage, but if a patient comes in and they need it, absolutely you got to do it that's just what we do.

Senator McCreadie: Thank you Mr. Chair and Mr. Valentino, you have my full support congratulations and good luck.

Valentino Perez: Thank you very much, I appreciate that.

Chairman Rodriguez: Thank you Senator and thank you again Mr. Perez. Just to follow up a little bit on what Senator McCreadie had asked. I know your background is along finance and that is a big plus for us at the hospital and you said that you looked at the finances of the past year, where do you see the whole zen there? I mean, you said it already, it is the collectibles, we know some of the people we treat there may never be able to pay, but do you see any bright spots where if we clean up and fix up what we need to where there is potential have you looked at that?

Valentino Perez: It's hard to deal with folding into the details of the financial statement if you don't have in the corporate side for publicly traded companies they have something called an MDMA discussion analysis along with your annual statement and finally without having something as detailed as that, but yet without being able to also go into the software, the computer software shows what's going on and knowing the operations, it's hard to find holes, but what I have noticed is we only continue to take in patients, so there's going to be some expenditures. we have expenses every time somebody comes in be it not just the personnel involves, but they got to cut you're taking out brand new sheets to put on an exam table, you're pulling out gauze bandages those items cost money and when you can't get the billed revenue collected to cover those funds it just makes it extremely difficult. The hole isn't necessarily whole in the financials in the way the hospital is run because if you look at the premise they

service Guam they service the outline islands their purpose is to make sure they provide treatment medical treatment to everyone that comes in, that is a priority. 2nd priority is let's hope they can fund, with the priority being providing healthcare everything else comes second and when you take people in that if you're a for profit hospital, you know they wouldn't pay then you turned them away the biggest hole I find is not what the operation hospital more on the intent of the hospital, and I'm all for continuing to provide medical care to anyone who needs it, so that is the focus of the hospital is being able to collect those funds. I am not a politician, I am not a rule maker and so however we get that funding, we rely on you and that burden, that task falls on you folks because we still need to keep that hospital open, but if we have to go for funds from the feds if we have to take it away from another program that's the harder decisions. That's the stuff that would not make me not sleep at night, I'll leave it up to you that is the biggest that is the hole.

Chairman Rodriguez: And I thank you for that. We understand as a government hospital we need to provide the subsidies, and we have. This fiscal year's budget alone, we've given more to the hospital right, but the hospital as well as an autonomous entity must do its part. There are two things there is make more money or you cut operations. The balls are in the hospital's court as well. What I am trying to stress in trying to get up from the hospital is what can we do, what are the potentials still that we could do because there is great potential there is so much good people there doctors and nurses and I don't think we've gone to the maximum to take advantage of the talent we have and the talent we have on island and is that something you're open to and expanding services or what we have there now and boosting their capabilities?

Valentino Perez: Well you mention a couple of things for me as far as expanding service it's probably something that we don't do. There is many clinics on the island in which they won't provide is emergency room service, so we got a lot of specialties on island and having GMH bill for that or at least open that up might be Pandora's box just because we once again we may not be able to collect on that revenue. As far as the operational side, you simply you might be able to cut back on certain things. Well, for me the priority and the first rule in any formula at what level of care do we want to offer? Our residents for the island of Guam and if we want to go off in the metrics and by a certain US County, state, city, or hospital and match those well, we got to make sure that we can actually make it happen and it is affordable, but in knowing the constraints the financial constraints in which we do operate because we have a very different dynamic set of customers than any other state in the US just isn't possible, so if we want to look at what we actually can do then an option and I'm not advocating it but you lower your standard of care, Is that something we want to do? I don't think so standard of care where it needs to be and as a resident, I want them to be but basically you're between a rock and a hard place, you keep that standard of care or you let it slide. I am not for letting it slide, but you have to look at the picture overall, the big picture and find out what is actually possible and that is something I want to help do like I said I am in health care now, I was not educated in healthcare. I am more on the finance side, but it is the operation side that I really want to help them do their job because these folks

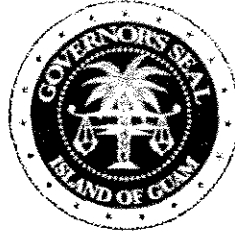
know what they're doing, they've been doing it for a long time. I would not second guess anything that they're doing medically as far as the intent of working, that is a different story, but I am not somebody's supervisor, we'll let management take care of that what they can or cannot do trying to help out the hospital and the government so that we can come to some sort of middle ground in which it can happen.

The public hearing was adjourned at 9:45am.
