COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Health and Human Services, Health Insurance Reform, Economic Development and Senior Citizens convened a public hearing on **Monday, March 11, 2013 at 9am** in *I Liheslatura*'s Public Hearing Room.

Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of The Executive Appointment of Mr. William E. Stanley II, as a Member of the Guam Board of Allied Health Examiners and whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo on January 25, 2013.
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on February 8, 2013;
- Appointment packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on February, 2013.

Notices were disseminated via electronic-mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on Monday, March 4, 2013 (5-Day Notice), and again on Thursday, March 7, 2013 (48-Hour Notice).

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 9:06AM.

Chairman Rodriguez invited those who signed up to testify:

Chairman Rodriguez: We will not move forward to the confirmation hearing of Mr. William Stanley II, service member to the Guam board of medical examiners.

Chuck Tanner: I came in today to support Ed. I have a long history with him. He is a very stand up guy and I have consulted with him with business ideas. He is a level headed guy. I think you would have a good choice in him. He's a pretty good guy. I want to support him. If you have any questions, I would be happy to answer them.



William Stanley: Thank you Senators and thank you for having me today. Chuck knew me a couple years before I came to Guam. I have only been here for 11 years and it has been wonderful. I have been under contract with pacific care. That was a very good initiation to Guam. I was here for Chata'an and Pongsona in my first year. I learned a lot about the resiliency of the people of Guam during that time. I learned a lot about caring for medical services. That two year contract has now turned in to 11 years and going. My wife and I really love it here and plan on staying indefinite. I served in the allied health board for the past 2 years. I was appointed by Governor Camacho. It was my first experience in the government entity. I learned a lot about how the committee works and try to work things within the committee. I look forward to doing more. The decisions in the profession is underutilized and could be better utilized. We can see this expanded in other medical specialties and provide more medical services to the people of Guam, and I look forward to doing that.

Chairman Rodriguez: Thank you very much Ed. I want to congratulate you. I have some questions but I will ask the panel first.

Senator pangelinan: Ed, thank you very much. He has been taking care of my dad and continues to see him. We are very happy with Ed's approach to the profession. I do want to say that the position's assistant is why it is in the allied health and not in the medical health board. What would you recommendation be in terms of, we look at the allied health board and how it is currently composed and so many disciplines there. What would you recommend to the committee to something we can look at to ensure that we get everybody licensed to be licensed or maybe a reorganization or revivification of skills and professions there to the other board that are more appropriate.

William Stanley: my personal recommendation would be to collocate the positions within the medical board as it ids in several states. The majority of states the position assistant profession who directly practice medicine, for example, the dietary, nurse practitioners, since they work closely or sup[revised by physicians, it makes good sense to place them under the medical board, rather than a board where different people from many walks of life all commonly in health positions, but different. The allied health board has a lot of spaghetti to hold in on fork.

Senator pangelinan: I agree, when you say medical assistant, it is different and we confuse it because of the word "assistant"." We'll certainly take a look at that and what will make more sense. Another thing, I saw in your record that you have three bronze stars.

William Stanley: it's one bronze star and multiple other achievements.

Senator pangelinan: I look forward to working with you in and if you have any questions regarding issues on medical care.

Chairman Rodriguez: We actually have a legislation already that will move Pas in the allied health. We will work with speaker ben with this as well. There are concerns that have been brought as well and we hope that we can bypass that and we can get you professionals in the medical board.



William Stanley: if I may touch on that, you will find very mixed feelings among physicians and other in the medical profession as well as in the community at large. Just as how senator pangelinan stated, the term "assistant", there are some in the medical profession kind of "anti physician assistants, and not anything that will encroach in job, but better education of the community at large and the professional as a whole can overcome these.

Senator Aguon: I'm going to have to echo speaker pangelinan in hopefully armed appropriately in going to the allied health committee because there are some situations that you obviously have been probably briefed on. Just as a federal veteran, there are certain things that we have abide by and it speaks highly b your character. Having retired and having these accomplishments, I salute you for your service in our island and our country. I thank you for extending yourself in this capacity and I look forward to your service. The Board should be represented at all times in the interest of our community and I thank you again.

Senator Yamashita: Thank you very much. You know the spaghetti that you talked about, that is really a concern. I really believe that there a re really good hearts and souls that makes the board do well. What can you do in to make them in becoming more cohesive and perhaps better in communicating and organizing their efforts because I see them wanting to do well, however, there are these walls that prevent them. I sometimes feel really badly for them because they have these efforts. What kind of strategies do you have in making the allied board more efficient and more effective.

William Stanley: I would remind you that I am returning for a second turn. I've dealt with some of the problems with allied health board. When I resigned for certain reasons, such as having my colleague to move on to the board, a colleague served 3 years and resigned and did the same to have another colleague to come in the board. I believed that this capacity should be shared and not be owed. I do believe that one of the biggest problems I saw in the Allied Health Board, is that some people really feel some ownership there because of serving for a period of time. One thing I proposed in my resignation letter is that an appointee to the board should not serve beyond the term of the Governor that appointed that. I am still encouraging that and I still encourage that you have the same voice and utilize that voice to communicate. You have people form several different medical professions who don't completely understand the other professions. Ms. Julianne has ideas in organizational skills. I served with Greg Cruz and was very quiet but waters still run deep and there's a lot of good knowledge that can bring forth and communicate what their profession does. Those are just two names but there are a lot of good people in that board and if they communicate well they can do a very good job.

Senator Yamashita: I agree with you that the communication efforts needs to be improved because that is what gets the people or members stuck in moving forward. I appreciate your willingness to serve.

Chairman Rodriguez: Some of the issues were brought up and you also brought up the need to take a look the disciplines under the allied health board we started to engaged with those conversations because we've seen the unresolved issues that keep coming up. Perhaps, it is time to take a look at what is under



the board and maybe take them over to another board. Are you sitting already in the board now in terms of observing?

William Stanley: I am not.

Senator Rodriguez: but you are familiar with the issues that have been brought today

William Stanley: yes

Rodriguez: we will open the record for those who would like to provide testimonies and we congratulate you once again
