### COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

#### I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Rules, Federal, Foreign and Micronesia Affairs, Human & Natural Resources; and Election Reform convened a public hearing on Wednesday, May 14, 2014 at 10:00 A.M. in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of **Mr. William T. Detry to serve as a Member of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency Board** [Length of Term: Three (3) Years] whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by Governor Eddie Baza Calvo on April 29, 2014;
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on April 29, 2014;
- Packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on May 1, 2014.

#### Public Notice Requirements

Notices were disseminated via e-mail and facsimile to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on May 7, 2014 (5-Day Notice), and again on May 9, 2014 (48- Hour Notice), thereby meeting the noticing requirements of the Open Government Law. Notices were also transmitted to various stakeholders.

#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

1. **Mr. William T. Detry, Appointee as Member of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency, Provided Oral and Written Testimony, In Support of the Appointment.**
2. **Mr. Eric Palacios, Administrator of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency, Provided Oral Testimony In Support of the Appointment.**

Senator Rory J. Respicio called the public hearing for the reappointment of **Mr. William T. Detry to serve as a Member of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency Board (GEPA)** to order at 10:00 A.M. and invited the panel to testify.

Mr. Eric Palacios:

Thank you for the opportunity to speak in support of Mr. Detry's nomination to the GEPA Board of Directors. I have limited background information on Mr. Detry's background but it's enough to comfortably speak on his qualifications and what I believe to be his commitment and the value he will bring to this Board. Mr. Detry is a member of the regulated community and to my knowledge, there are no pending Notice of Violation's (NOV) against his company and that speaks to his know-how on how to operate in the confines of environmental laws and regulations. I meet with him yesterday and discussed should he be confirmed, he will have to maintain that clear and distinct line of being a board member and a member of the regulated community. He gave me his assurance that he will bring nothing but his best interest to the board. With that, in short, I do support his nomination.

Mr. William T. Detry:

*Mr. Detry read his written statement. Please see attached for written testimony*

Senator Respicio:

Thank you for your willingness to serve. From our perspective here at the Legislature, we certainly recognize that it is difficult to by individuals who would want to volunteer. In some cases, they have the fiduciary responsibility to for the personal decisions they make. Certainly, I commend Governor Calvo for his ability to reach out and find very capable and qualified individuals to the EPA Board. And if you look at the history of this Committee, we don't sit on appointments so there is no difficulty maintaining quorum, particularly for the GEPA Board. I want to thank you for accepting the appointment.

Mr. Detry:

You are welcome. It is an honor and a privilege.

Senator Respicio:

With EPA, you will be guided with very capable staff and the Board Chairman. It is a very difficult agency to be part of with the long hearings and the decisions to make.

Senator Aline A. Yamashita:

Thank you for your willingness to serve. EPA has very exciting initiatives right now. They just had a Zero Waste Conference and as we talking about recycling and reduction and all these wonderful ideas that have to happen if we want to save our environment. We look forward to you and your leadership in moving us ahead. Congratulations!

Senator Respicio thanked the panel for testifying and the senators present at the hearing.

No further testimony being offered, Senator Respicio then declared that **appointment for Mr. William T. Detry to serve as a Member of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency Board** was duly heard.
