Mr. Zenon E. Belanger – Good morning. I'm going to read my testimony. Mr. Belanger reads his testimony, which is attached for review.

Chairperson – Si Yu'os Ma'ase Mr. Zenon Belanger. I would just like to say for the record, I appreciate the appointment from the Governor's Office and I want to thank you for stepping up to the plate to help our people of Guam. It takes away a lot of personal time and with the Hagåtña Restoration and Redevelopment Authority, you would basically be working for free and with a lot of labor of love. 

I look forward to working with the Board of Commissioners of the Authority, the Governor's Office, the Legislature, the Judiciary, Mayor John Cruz and the people of Guam to see that Hagatna becomes the village it once was as the center of activity on our beatutiful island of Guam. Biba Guam!
