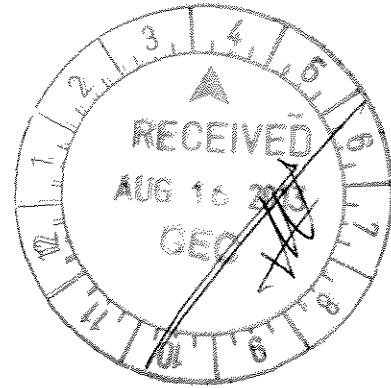





Senator Cruz agreed that teachers are amongst the most valuable members of society and that the interaction Ms. Aguon has working as a teacher will benefit her at PBS.

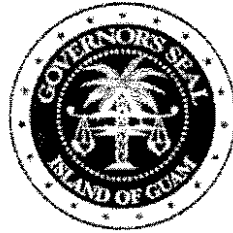
Senator San Nicolas stated that it is fantastic that a person of Ms. Aguon's background is a teacher and is willing to be a member of the KGTF board.
