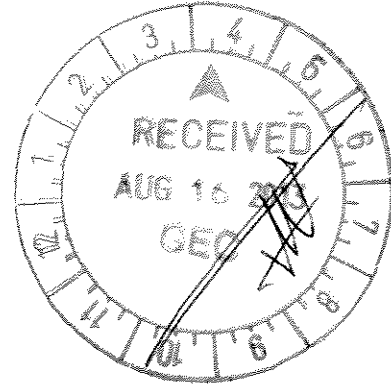



I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Rules, Federal, Foreign and Micronesian Affairs, Human & Natural Resources; and Election Reform convened a public hearing on Tuesday, July 9, 2013 at 9:00 A.M. in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of **Manuel Q. Cruz** to serve as the **Director of the Guam Department of Labor** (Length of Term: To Serve at the Pleasure of the Governor) whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by Governor Eddie Baza Calvo on June 3, 2013;
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on June 5, 2013;
- Packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on June 10, 2013.

Public Notice Requirements

Notices were disseminated via e-mail and facsimile to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on June 28, 2013 (5-Day Notice), and again on July 3, 2013 (48- Hour Notice), thereby meeting the noticing requirements of the Open Government Law. Notices were also transmitted to various stakeholders and government agencies.

Senator Rory J. Respicio called the public hearing for the appointment of **Manuel Q. Cruz** to serve as the Director of the **Guam Department of Labor** to order at 9:00 A.M. and invited the panel to testify.

Mr. Mike Ady, provided oral testimony in support of the appointment. He came to Guam thirty (30) years ago and was lucky to of married into the family of Mr. Manny Cruz. Mr. Ady did not have a father on Guam and his Uncle Manny treated him as son by teaching him how to farm, be active with the church and how to work with people and helping them improve their lives. Mr. Ady feels that his Uncle Manny has many positive traits of a good leader, especially with his past experience at the Department of Agriculture. He feels as though Mr. Cruz will take the department to another level and be an excellent asset to the Department of Labor.

Mr. Leo Casil, provided oral testimony in support of the appointment. For the years he has worked with Mr. Cruz in past administrations, his experience has led him to be an excellent grant writer and analyst. He stated that he is a man of integrity. His mission is on behalf of who he works for and is very loyal. He knows that Mr. Cruz means well and would be the right person to lead the Department of Labor.

Mr. Manny Cruz provided oral testimony in support of his appointment. He believes he is well qualified for the position as Director of the Department of Labor. He has the background, education and experience in both local and federal government. He has been educated both on Guam and in the mainland attaining his graduate studies. He has spent many years working in San Francisco and Washington, D.C. in two large federal departments (the U.S. Department of Interior and the U.S. Department of Energy). While he was on Guam, he has worked for the U.S. Navy and the Ship Naval Repair Facility. Mr. Cruz has so much knowledge and experience in labor issues. Mr. Cruz had read out the Guam DOL’s Mission Statement and he said that committing to carrying out this mission statement is one of his top priorities as Director. Looking at the organizational structure of the department, he can see that the department still provides employment assistance, labor market information, and job training through various programs. He urges the Committee to support his nomination for the Director of Labor.

Senator Respicio then opened the floor to senators for follow-up questions.

Senator Tom Ada had noted he has known Mr. Manny Cruz for many years. He was glad to see that in his career, he has had a number of years at the senior management level and have almost two decades basically at the rank and file advocating for the workers. He said that he hopes that has given Mr. Cruz a balance. Senator Ada asked Mr. Cruz to elaborate on how he thinks those experiences at the senior management level and advocacy role over a decade, how he is able to mesh that and come out with a good balance perspective from the DOL.

Mr. Manny Cruz responded by stating that he was a senior bureaucrat during his time with the federal government and learned to work with senior administrators and how to do things which he was able to bring down to the workers.

Senator V. Anthony Ada stated that Mr. Cruz is a close family relative. He noted that Mr. Cruz was previously the director for AHRD in the 1980’s and now being appointed as the Director of the Department of Labor, the two (2) agencies seem to be one but two (2) separate agencies. Senator Ada asked is Mr. Cruz thought it was positive of having AHRD under the same office as DOL with separate functions.

Mr. Cruz said that each agency has a mission and mandate. He noted DOL as the main stay in the Government of Guam. He noted that AHRD came to be when they wanted independence so they can get local funds because they were operating completely with federal funds. He sees AHRD’s function to be for the employment and training. He

stated they have a Memorandum of Agreement of how they are going to do things and work together as a team so they will not make the mistake of losing a lot of federal grants. He wants to make sure the work and monitoring is done. He said he would work with the Guam Workforce Investment Board and the Governor to continue to work towards a state plan for the department.

Senator Tony Ada noted that he is Mr. Cruz can see it as two (2) separate agencies that will work collaboratively with each other. He also stated that he looks forward to working with Mr. Cruz as the Director of the Department of Labor.

Senator Christopher M. Duenas is a close family friend of Mr. Cruz. He stated he knows wholeheartedly knows he is strong in his faith and he has worked with him through the years under the Camacho administration. He said that he takes on big issues and said this job would suit him the best. Senator Duenas assured Mr. Cruz that he has his full support.

Senator Michael Limtiaco said that with Mr. Cruz's experience, he is well qualified and looks forward to working with him.

Senator Respicio stated that resources are limited at the Department of Labor and the Government of Guam and the last thing they need to be administered with a heavy hand. He asks Mr. Cruz to be firm but fair and continue to be compassionate to the department. He stated that if there is stable leadership at the department, he wants to make sure the employees are okay. He asked Mr. Cruz for his assessment of the morale of employees at the department.

Mr. Cruz said that the employees are very well qualified and never given the opportunity to express themselves. In the few weeks he was with the department, he was able to talk to them and get their sentiments of the people's attitude on leadership in the department. He wants to restore the confidence of the employees and move forward.

Senator Respicio thanked the panel for testifying and the senators present at the hearing.

No further testimony being offered, Senator Respicio then declared that **appointment for Mr. Manuel Q. Cruz to serve as the Director of the Guam Department of Labor** was duly heard.

III. WRITTEN TESTIMONY

Mr. Vicente "Ben" Gumataotao, Mayor of Piti, In Support of the Appointment, Provided Written Testimony. He stated that he has known Mr. Manny Cruz for many years and has served with him in the Guam Regional Transit Authority for the past four (4) years. He has found him to be knowledgeable and experience in so many disciplines. With so many years as a civilian employee of the Federal Government in Guam and in Washington, D.C., Mayor Gumataotao stated that Mr. Cruz brings with him a wealth of knowledge and experience in federal grants management and labor relations.
