The Committee on Appropriations, Public Debt, Legal Affairs, Retirement, Public Parks, Recreation, Historic Preservation, and Land convened a public hearing on March 12, 2013 at 9:00 AM in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of Mr. Victor F. Cruz to serve as a Member of the Guam Land Use Commission, and whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by Governor Edward J. Calvo on January 25, 2013, for five (5) years, expiring in the year 2018;
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on February 8, 2013;
- Appointment packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on February 11, 2013.

Notices were disseminated via hand-delivery/email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on March 5, 2013 (5-Day Notice), and again on March 8, 2013 (48-Hour Notice).

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 9:00 AM.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: We will go ahead and call on the next nominee, Mr. Mr. Victor Cruz, for the Guam Land Use Commission.

I have Ms. Tricee Limtiaco who has signed up to testify and she provided written testimony in support of the nominee. I am not sure she signed up for oral testimony. I also have Mr. Eloy Hara and Mr. Art Ilagan who signed up to testify for Mr Cruz.

I see that Mr. Hara is signed up first and we will go ahead and begin receiving his testimony and then Mr. Ilagan and then the nominee will close the testimony and then we will take questions from the panel.

Mr. Eloy Hara

Mr. Hara: Good Morning Mr. Speaker, Vice Speaker Cruz, Senator Limtiaco, Senator Morrison, and Senator Frank Aguon. My name is Eloy Hara and I am a member of the CCU but I am speaking on my own recognizance, so I want to thank you for giving me the opportunity. It's easy to come here and testify on Mr. Victor Cruz knowing his background for almost forty years from his own construction company and field agent to manager and also twenty years in the construction background. Mr. Speaker I highly recommend that Mr. Victor Cruz serve in the land commission. Considering his forty years of experiences in that line of work, it's really a pleasure to recommend he's well knowledgeable of most of the rules, regulations, policies procedures. I know after forty years experiences and I know Mr. Cruz is personable and he is keenly aware of the issues of what is expected of him in serving the community in that capacity.

So let me go back to at least twenty years that is very related. Mr. Cruz has twenty years experience from one form or another, from field hand to superintendent even as an area manager, and his experience with the development of Guam Power Corporation, the Guam Pacific Power Corporation as a construction superintendent, and the Guam Pacific Petroleum Corporation as Operations Manager, and the Shell Guam incorporation from '87-'92, as an area manager and such. He is the prime consultant for Guam Shell in government rules, regulations, licenses, permits and other paper work. He also help the company by negotiating with landowners to acquire a lease for the construction of a gas station and negotiated contract and he also ensures that the company complies with plans, specifications and other requirements.

A lot of you are familiar with Mr. Cruz because he was a staff member of the Senator, the then Senator for Eddie Calvo and now the Chief of Staff and Senior Policy Advisor. So I believe he is well knowledgeable in the area of performing his job. And he is also special staff assistant to the Governor, and in such he is very well versed with community affairs and social relationships and so this really gives Mr. Victor Cruz the knowledge and expertise that he can actually get the job running because of his extreme qualification and background.

And therefore I highly recommend that Victor Cruz to be a member of the Land Use Commission. Thank you Mr. Speaker.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: Thank you and Si Yu'os Ma'åse' Mr. Hara. Before we proceed I see that Mr. Larry Rivera signed up to testify, please sit at the table. In addition to the hearing being aired on the legislative channel we are live streaming on the Internet this morning with this public hearing. And if you're listening out there and have access to the internet tune in to this hearing by going to www.guamlegislature.com/live_feed.htm

We are finally joining the 21st century in terms of the internet in live streaming our public hearings, adding to the transparency of the legislature and using this medium, to get the information out. Thank you to the staff here and the IT staff. We are still beta testing but we know it's up and you can access it. Thank you and Si Yu'os Ma'åse'. Mr Ilagan you go ahead then we will get to Mr. Rivera.

Mr. Artemio Ilagan

Mr. Art Ilagan: Thank you Mr. Speaker and Senator, My name is Mr. Ilagan and I am the Insurance and Banking Commissioner. I agree with Mr. Hara's testimony and I don't want to repeat what he said about Mr. Cruz. But I know that his son and my son were students at Father Duenas, and during the school years, Mr. Cruz, Victor and I became close. I knew him when he was in the gas industry and when he left the gas industry all the prices went up. During my time at FD and afterwards I got to know Victor we did a lot for our children, we did a lot for the parent association, we went to a lot of support activities, Victor Cruz was always there giving up himself for the boys of Father Duenas. I knew him personally and I recommend him for this position.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: Thank you Si Yu'os Ma'åse'.

Mr. Larry Rivera

Mr. Rivera: Thank you Mr. Chairman and Senators, good morning, my name is Larry Rivera and I am the Vice Chairman for the Guam Land Use Commission and I am here today to support Mr. Cruz appointment. We are glad, as a commission, that we have members coming in. We have five (members) and we have been meeting and making the quorum. I know Victor socially and his family, I know his father well and I know him through his business venture and I think he will do a good job in service of the people. Thank you and Si Yu'os Ma'åse'.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: Thank you and Si Yu'os Ma'åse' Mr. Rivera.

Mr. Victor F. Cruz

Mr. Victor Cruz: Good morning and Håfa Adai Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan, Chairman for the Committee on Appropriations, Public Debt, Legal Affairs, Retirement, Public Parks, Recreation, Historic Preservation, and Land. My name is Victor F. Cruz. My wife is Edna Cruz and she is here in the audience. I have three kids; Victor Jr., Michael and a daughter name Kimberly. I want to take this opportunity to thank you for allowing me to appear before this committee seeking confirmation and your support to serve as a member in the Guam Land Use commission. Born in Inarajan, I attended Inarajan elementary until the fourth grade and that's when my father decided to move the family to Ipan, Talofofu and I have been there since then. I Attended St Francis Catholic School from the fourth grade until ninth grade and after that I attended George Washington High School from grade ten to eleven, and from there I went to Guam Vocational Trade High School also name a Trade School where I graduated in 1967. From elementary I have always been working with my father in the construction industry. It is a hard life but it's a great learning experience. I spent my summers and breaks during that and I hated my summers because of that reason, others were out having fun. Having, after a year out of high school, I enlisted in the US Army in 1967. I did a one three year term and got out in 1971 with an honorable discharge. After that I tried going to University, but instead I went to the Hugh Institute of Technology for one semester, just trying it out you know. Back then I thought I would go into Electronic Engineering but found out its really not my line of work. After that I came back in 1972 and I continued working for my father, the late Francisco P. Cruz who owned Cruz Construction Company. We held the construction as long as we could until we decided to close it in 1984.

Then I met up a guy by the name is Noel Payne, who owned a construction company and a developer called Dynasty Development, Guam Pacific Corporations working as a field superintendent doing mostly military contracts and doing a few projects outside. While working with Mr. Payne a group of companies and group individuals from Australia working with Shell, came to Guam basically looking around and met up with Mr. Payne. Through them and a negotiation, they established a distributorship and incorporated a company, Guam Pacific Petroleum Inc.. As a distributor, I started to walk the walk knocking on doors of business and everybody, introducing Shell products to Guam. Everybody kept looking at my back asking "who are the big guys at the back?" I guess being short and all that. That lead to advising Shell Company of Pacific Islands the only way they could really get going on Guam and succeed and everything is to basically establish a Shell identity on Guam, which then establish Shell Guam Inc. after buying Guam Pacific Park Corporation.

From then on I worked for Shell, and I started out as one of the first local employees, as an area manager going out and knocking on doors selling products. Then Shell decided to go into the retail industry to help them out with their movement into Guam looking for land and making sure that every land pick and every business they decide to do they are in compliance with Guam rules and regulations. After working with them for about five (5) to seven (7) years, I decided to step aside and do consulting business. I signed a contract with them to be their consultant. In 1989, while being in the private sector, I saw that Mr. Eddie Baza Calvo decided to run for the Guam legislature. I met up with him and worked with him during his campaign. After being successful on the 25th Guam legislature, he asked me to

come and join him and I worked with him in the 25th, 27th, 29th and 30th Guam Legislature. In the beginning as Chief of Staff then ended up with being the senior policy advisor, advising him on every level on the Guam Legislature and his needs to work with the people of Guam.

He decided after the 30th Guam Legislature to run for the Executive level and I helped him with the campaign and then he asked me join the Administration and I am still here working for the Governor of Guam. At this time I am ready to answer any questions from the committee members.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: Thank you and Si Yu'os Ma'ãse'. Senator Cruz – Mr. Vice Speaker.

Vice Speaker Cruz: I am glad that the Vice Chair has a quorum and I am glad there are going to be members on the GLUC to address these issues. Tongue and cheek whether or not this is going to put you in a interesting predicament about the decisions you make if it's in opposition to the Administration, that changes whether or not that is going to rub off.

Mr. Cruz: I am very humble and honored of Governor Eddie Calvo when he sat down with me and asked me if I could join, aside working for him, being a member of the GLUC. I am humbled and I accepted that. Being from Guam and watching Guam grow from dirt and watching development grow, I also learned how it is to be a member of the Guam Land Use Commission because my father, the late Francisco P. Cruz, was one of the members when The Territory Planning Commission was first formed. We spend time talking and he spent time asking me, and as far the issue of rub on the wrong shoulder, I will do my best if confirmed by this legislature to provide my decision that is good for the territory, good for the community, and good for the people of Guam. I know people of Guam, I do understand when people look at me and say you work for the Governor. I have never seen or heard Governor Eddie Calvo tell anybody, "Hey! Do this for me". He just leaves it up to them to make their decision. That's the best I can answer you Speaker.

Vice Speaker Cruz: Excellent answer.

Senator Aguon: Buenas, thank you for offering yourself and extending yourself. I understand the nature of where you work and possible influences that can take place regardless to what our work environment is. The underlying questions is what part of Guam are you from?

Mr. Cruz: I was Born in the village of Inarajan and now live in Ipan, Talofofog Country.

Senator Aguon: Highlight that you are from the south is enough. That was my hard life question. I think anytime an individual accepts a mantle of volunteering in and serving our community in different capacities, regardless of where he or she works speaks volumes about that particular individual. But I think what's just as important is the critical nature of

checks and balances. You are very familiar with that in terms of some of the decisions GLUC make. Ultimately, the decisions they make there is always going to be eyes on the GLUC particularly the things that are going to transpire over the next five to ten years. There is going to be tremendous interest in the community of Guam and interest in rezoning to maximize economic benefit and I think as long as you maintain roots, and I like your answer “the South” because that includes Yona, as long as you maintain your roots and keep the best interest of the people of Guam, I have every confidence that you will do well in that commission. I wish you the best of luck and I hope the decisions and the action you take ultimately benefit our people. Thank you.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: And now, from the real South, Senator Tommy Morrison.

Senator Morrison: Good morning Mr. Cruz and to the panel. I appreciate the testimony. I worked with Mr. Cruz for many years and always your appreciated your integrity, your honesty, your guidance your advice I know you worked with us at the contractors licensing board to assist us and helped us become better efficient and revenues for the COB. I know along the lines of Vice Speaker Cruz, I know you work with the application review committee that provides the technical support for the Guam Land Use Commission to better make your decision and I appreciate you taking this service to the community and you have my full support.

Mr. Cruz: Thank you very much.

Senator Lintiaco: Just a comment. Thank you for stepping up and providing a service to the community and you have my full support and thank you Mr. Hara, Mr. Rivera, Mr. Ilagan for your testimony.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: I do want to put on the record, having been involved not only the business but the political communities you are very much aware that people go through, the jumping to conclusions regarding the politics of the community and so forth.

As you say, you have been with him, you helped him achieve his greatest success to date in terms of being a successful gubernatorial candidate, one of the few men on Guam who are able to do that which is a real accomplishment. The issue of conflicts of interest, we have some very stringent conflicts of interest laws which govern familial relationships, but not too much the political relationship but I want to echo what is said, the governor and family are one of the biggest developers and landholders on Guam that regularly come before the Guam Land Use Commission with regard to rezoning properties. How do you intend to handle, should one of the governor’s family properties should they come forth requesting for a rezoning that may be opposed by the community? People are requesting for conditions that may be placed that may be not acceptable to the family development how would you handle that kind of situation? Would you continue to sit and make a decision on that,

knowing that you work at the pleasure of the Governor? What would you do to handle a situation like that?

Mr. Cruz: Thank you for such an important question, Mr. Chairman. One thing I learned growing up and even from my father is that if I was allowed to sit in that commission I would do my due diligence. I would ask all the questions necessary and make sure that after the review, when they submit and it goes to the Application Review Committee, work with the Application Review Committee. Listen to people's input, both from the government side and those near the rezone request. I would ask all my questions and everything. I would sit with the Board whenever the time come for the vote I will make it publicly known who I work for and what do I do and if the decision that I see needs an attention then I would put my input in. Come time to vote and I would allow everybody to vote and would vote my conscience. As my late father says, "Whatever you do, whatever decision you make son, make sure you go to sleep at night good. Wake up in the morning smiling and thank God for the new day." That is the best answer Speaker.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: So you're saying you would vote for those matters.

Mr. Cruz: If it comes, I would recuse myself if there is a great conflict of interest.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: Wouldn't every single case be a conflict.

Mr. Cruz: I don't know that every single case is going to be of conflict of interest. I do know the Calvo's will have other ventures they go in, joint venture, corporation I believe that the senators are on the floor they make that decisions, and if is a real conflict of interest I would then say I have a conflict of interest.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: A week ago, we had a hearing here with the Port Authority, one of the board members worked for the Calvo's Enterprises. She testified during that hearing that when there is any decision to be made that is directly involves a Calvo Enterprise business and a port project, they recuse themselves almost automatically. It's not like they discuss it and then decide. You don't think that you would use that kind of standard.

Mr. Cruz: I would recuse myself like I said Senator, but I would also look at the project itself and if it is great beneficial to the community and the entire island of Guam, then I would stand in support for such things. But I would not stand for somebody pushing me at the side saying that at the request of the governor vote for this. I have never my entire lifetime working for Governor Calvo ever done that. It's always "what do you think here Vic". And if there is an issue we talk about it. I will vote on my conscious if it's good for the entire island and the community then I will vote. If it's not beneficial be it one of my close friend or relatives I would not vote for that.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: You wouldn't at the very beginning not participate on the discussions? An application comes in and it's a Calvo Enterprise project you wouldn't just not participate in the discussion because you work for this person, you would wait until the very end?

Mr. Cruz: I would join the other committee members together with Application Review Committee and look at what the project is. I believe everybody should be given the opportunity to give input whether or not how close you are to the individual or company. I believe you also help other members come up with understanding, but in the very beginning I will let them know I will participate in the discussion, give my input and everything, when it comes time to vote I will make that decision right then and there.

Chairman Vicente C. Pangelinan: Some people think the mere fact of participating in the discussion breaches the conflict of interest threshold. I am sure you will do that and look at that, whatever way go that it's going to be your conscience as you say, and how you going to feel in the morning. That is a personal standard, but there are public standards that we need to be aware of and certainly you will be briefed on that. Thank you for your frank discussion and comments and thank you for agreeing to serve the community.

Mr. Cruz: Chairman, Thank you for giving me the opportunity to communicate with one another. Senator Mike Limtiaco, Senator BJ Cruz, Senator Tommy Morrison, Senator Frank Aguon, I seek your support. Mr. Chair, Un Dankulu na Si Yu'os Ma'ãse'.

The public hearing was adjourned.

III. FINDINGS & RECOMMENDATIONS
