Committee Report Digest

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on General Government Operations and Cultural Affairs convened a public hearing on Monday, April 15nd, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslatura*. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration was Committee Report on the reappointment of Mr. Goring Duenas to serve as a member of the Guam Parole Board.

Public Notice Requirements

All legal requirements for public notices were met, with requests for publication sent to all media and all Senators on April 8, 2013, and April 10, 2013 via email. Copies of the hearing notices are appended to the report.

The public hearing was called to order at 10:05 a.m.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Vice Speaker Benjamin J.F Cruz announced the appointment of Mr. Goring Duenas to serve as a member of the Guam Parole Board, but noted that he was not present.

Michelle Taitano, Guam Parole Board, stated that Mr. Duenas is at the Guam Memorial Hospital having undergone emergency surgery. Ms. Taitano stated that for this reason he is unable to attend, but that they would still like to provide testimony in support of the appointment of Mr. Duenas to serve as a member of the Guam Parole Board.



Senator Cruz and the members of the panel agreed to hear the testimony and have the committee report for Mr. Duenas completed for session. Senator Cruz noted that the Guam Parole Board currently does not have enough members for quorum.

Michelle Taitano, Guam Parole Board, stated that Mr. Duenas is courageous. Ms. Taitano stated that Mr. Duenas is willing to work on the parole board, that he is a good listener, reader of body language, and that he has the background as a counselor, which will help him make decisions.

Joana Margaret Blas, Mayor of Asan, stated that she has known Mr. Duenas since they were in school 45 years ago. Mayor Blas stated that Mr. Duenas is a compassionate and patient man that will make a strong addition to the parole board. Mayor Blas respectfully asked for the expeditious confirmation of Mr. Duenas so that the Guam Parole Board may have a quorum.

Conception Duenas, Guam Parole Board, stated that she has known Mr. Duenas since he was a child. Ms. Duenas stated that he was an excellent teacher and counselor at Tamuning Elementary School. Ms. Duenas stated that Mr. Duenas is an even tempered individual with understanding, concern, and common sense that will do an effective job as a member of the Guam Parole Board.

Basil O' Mallen, Chief Prosecutor at the Office of the Attorney General, provided oral support for the appointment of Mr. Duenas to serve as a member of the Guam Parole Board. Chief Prosecutor O' Mallen stated that he does not know Mr. Duenas, but based on the strong oral testimony from key members of the panel that have served the community positively he is inclined to voice his support for the appointment of Mr. Duenas.

Senator San Nicolas stated that his experience is that Mr. Duenas is a kind man that follows through with his commitments. San Nicolas stated Mr. Duenas is a fair man that is keenly aware of the rules and regulations.

Louise Rivera, Mayor of Tamuning - Tumon, provided oral testimony in support of Mr. Duenas. Mayor Rivera stated that Mr. Duenas is a great candidate for the parole board because he is an active member of the Tamuning community that has been a great member of the community.

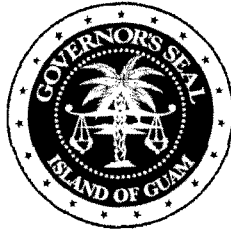
Senator Cruz thanked the members of the panel for their comments then asserted that the record will be open for ten days so that residents may submit their testimonies.
