COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Appropriations, Public Debt, Legal Affairs, Retirement, Public Parks, Recreation, Historic Preservation and Land convened a public hearing on August 6, 2013 at 9:00 AM in *I Liheslatura*'s Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of Ms. Denise Hertslet to serve as a Member of the Criminal Injuries Compensation Commission, and whose appointment history is as follows:

1. Appointed by Acting Governor Ray Tenorio on June 20, 2013 for Four (4) year, expiring in the year 2017.
2. Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on June 20, 2013;
3. Appointment packet forwarded to this committee for public hearing on July 5, 2013;

Public Notice Requirements

Notices were disseminated pursuant to the Open Government Law to all senators and all main print media and broadcasting outlets on Tuesday, July 30, 2013 (5-Day Notice), Friday, August 2, 10, 2013 and again on Sunday, August 4, 2013 (48 Hour Notice).

The public hearing was called-to-order at 9:00 AM.

Chairman Pangelinan: Good morning ladies and gentlemen and welcome to this morning's public hearing. Today is August 6, 2013, Tuesday. The hearing agenda was published pursuant to the requirements with the Open Government Law in addition to the publications in the printed media. Notices were also sent via email to all news agencies and media publications on Guam.

We have several items on the agenda this morning and we would like to begin with the appointment of Ms. Denise Hertslet to be a member of the Criminal Injuries Compensation Commission.

Ms. Hertslet, please come forward.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Ms. Denise Hertslet. Good morning Acting Speaker Cruz, Mr. Chairman and Senator Limtiaco. I am honored to be appointed by Governor Calvo to serve as a member of the Criminal Injuries Compensation Commission and I thank you for your time today to consider me for this nomination. At this point, I just want to be able to solidify my commitment to serve on this board with the best of my abilities for the next four years.

The other thing I would like to add to this statement is an update with the organization that we call "RWR" – Random Women's Rally. The ladies that are currently working on this organization have been working closely with the FJC – Family Justice Center – and at this point have helped to map out the resources for first responders and secondary resources with the goal of creating the first Family Justice Center, a non-profit 501(c)3 organization with a collaboration with all of the needed resources and agencies. They have also identified a possible location in central Tamuning, which is behind the ITC Building and it is GEDA property. They are currently working with some folks at GEDA, realtors and the rest of the agencies, such as the Guam Police Department to be able to formalize the organization and have access to the needed funds and then move into the new location.

Chairman Pangelinan. Is this Family Justice Center going to be involved with the Criminal Injuries Compensation Commission or is that separate?

Ms. Denise Hertslet. It would be separate but they would be the resource that would be available to the victims turned survivors to use the needed funds to access resources, such as work experience programs, self employment programs, therapy and any other needed resources. The advocates that would be placed in FJC will try to create a one advocate, one victim scenario so that in that situation the victim would only work with one person throughout the whole process until they are able to receive the needed funds and resources to move forward.

Chairman Pangelinan. Do you envision the funds in the Criminal Injuries Compensation Fund that are awarded to victims to then be directed to the Family Justice Center?

Ms. Denise Hertslet. No, I think that in order for the FJC to provide better assistance to them, the victims would need the funds from the Compensation Commission in order to begin getting their resources paid for, such as their therapy services. The funds will not be directed to the FJC.

Chairman Pangelinan. The Commission is composed of five members. Currently there is only one other member appointed: Dr. Lisa Borja. Did the Administration give you any indication of when other nominees may come forward in order to make sure the Board is up and functioning?

Ms. Denise Hertslet. Not at this point. I know that when I turned in my packet, there was three other people that were suppose to turn in their information but they have not, yet.

Chairman Pangelinan. Thank you very much. Si Yu'os Ma'ase.

Senator Limtiaco. I just want to say thank you for your public service and you have my full support.

Chairman Pangelinan. There was also in the passage of a recently passed law that re-defined the Criminal Injuries Compensation Commission in that the Attorney General can access the funds in the absence of a Board to ensure that the victims get the services that they need. Has he by chance – even without a full complement of a functioning board – brought you in with Dr. Borja to work with him rather than leaving all decisions with him at this time?

Ms. Denise Hertslet. No, I have not heard any new information. I have not been contacted by anyone.

Chairman Pangelinan. There being no further questions of the nominee, we want to thank you for your willingness to serve in this capacity. It is something that I think I is sorely needed in our community. Without the legislative intervention we had money in the bank sitting there, available for victim services with no way to disperse it. Only upon Senator Cruz' questioning that we find out we cannot access that money because no appointments to the board have been made. The Legislature came in, passed the statute that allowed the Attorney General on an interim basis to access that money and give the services to the victims, especially when we have the resources to pay for those services.

We hope to get the full complement of the Board quickly from the Administration. We will remind them that there are still three vacancies left. We will also the Attorney General to bring you in so you can see the implementation of the administrative side so when you get a full complement, we will somebody on the board who is familiar with the systems to ensure we continue allowing these victims to access these resources available to them. We will make that request to the Attorney General.

Ms. Denise Hertslet. Thank you and to add to that, it's very critical because as we get into the holiday season we will see an increase in violent crimes and affiliated crimes, such as these. We are going to see the growing number of victims and we still have no action. So, this is very critical.

Attorney General Rapadas. Thank you for allowing me to speak today on this nomination and I speak in support of it. Although I just met her briefly I felt like I have known her for a while. I have listened to her radio show and comes across as a thoughtful, caring person. That's what this position requires to be a member of Criminal Injuries Compensation Commission. Since the beginning of my term and even while I was an Assistant Attorney General I have advocated for a quorum for this very important commission. In the past we were able to use it, very briefly and even back then when I was an Assistant, we still only had three members, which is a bare quorum. Of course you know there are five members that should be on there.

Restitution exists in criminal cases as a way to give victims out of pocket costs, whenever they are a victim of a crime. It is suppose to make victims whole but they aren't really; not even really emotionally, but that is a discussion saved for later. Most times, even if restitution is ordered our victims do not even get a penny. Many of our defendants are financially challenged and that's probably a reason they are in jail because they committed crimes to get money. In the course of getting this money, they end up injuring someone.

But there are also other costs associated with those cases; they are not contemplated by the laws. Restitution takes care of out of pocket costs, medical and other funds directly related to particular cases, but it does not take in account things like lost wages, airfare to caregivers and those similar in-direct costs. We need a quorum to get our victims compensated. I am thankful to have worked with the Legislature to amend the law to do just that. I have worked with the Administration to appoint members. Every chance I get, I send emails and letters to the Governor's several legal counsels and even speaking to the Governor and the Lt. Governor themselves and we continue to speak with them to get a quorum. As far as I know, we only have two members sitting at this point. So, we are still pushing the Governor to make another appointment.

Under the amended law, I get to make these compensation decisions should there be no quorum. But, it is important to a board because having one means that the people make the ultimate decision. That's the way it should happen; let the people decide, not just the Attorney General. Today, I continue to work with the Legislature on this very important issue by registering my support for the appointment of Ms. Hertslet. We spoke briefly today and we pledged to work right away to get our victims compensated. I support the nomination and I hope that the Legislature will give her favorable vote.

Chairman Pangelinan. Thank you and Si Yu'os Ma'ase Mr. Attorney General. One of the things I suggested to Ms. Hertslet was to ask that you to bring the two nominees in – when you are looking at any applications before the Criminal Injuries Compensation Commission for disbursement of any claims to assist victims in services that may be

available to them that may require some compensation and you feel that they may deserve it, can you bring the appointed members in at this time so they can get a feel for how the commission would function, some of the administrative processes that they deem necessary in order to ensure that the victims get access to these funds so when the other members come in, the transition from the interim regulation, which allows you to make those decisions to the board itself that there will be up and running and somebody has been there that may be able to guide the new members. So, if I may suggest that, Mr. Attorney General.

Attorney General Rapadas. We did discuss that I believe that is a great suggestion. She said she is ready to work today to do that. I am ready to send emails out to her to get started. I will still make recommendations to the Governor and I invite the good Senators to do that, too if you know some good citizens. It has been difficult to get many of the commissions and boards filled – many times it is a thankless job and get criticized for the decisions they make. But I think this is an important position enough that we know of good people, make those recommendations. Ms. Hertslet also said she would be looking herself. We will be working together on that.

Chairman Pangelinan. We appreciate your testimony and rest assured that we will append it to the record.

This concludes the confirmation on Ms. Denise Hertslet.

There being no further business, this hearing is now adjourned.

III. FINDINGS & RECOMMENDATIONS
