## COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

### **I. OVERVIEW**

The appointment of Donna W. Kloppenburg to serve as Performing Arts Member of the Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency was executed by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo on November 8, 2013. The appointment packet was received by the Office of Speaker Judith T. Won Pat on November 8, 2013, and the appointment was subsequently referred to the Committee on General Government Operations and Cultural Affairs on November 11, 2013.

The Committee on General Government Operations and Cultural Affairs was scheduled to convene a Confirmation Hearing on Friday, December 13, 2013, at 5:00PM in the Guam Legislature Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the appointment of Donna W. Kloppenburg to serve as Performing Arts Member of the Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency.

The Confirmation Hearing for the appointment of Donna W. Kloppenburg began at 4:38PM and ended at 4:43PM.

## II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

**Senator Tina R. Muña Barnes** began the Confirmation Hearing for Donna W. Kloppenburg by explaining that the Committee has acquiesced to a request made early that morning to move up the Confirmation Hearing to an earlier time. She noted that written testimony in support of Mrs. Kloppenburg's appointment was received from Ms. Leonora Jordanou, Mr. Ron J. Castro, Dr. Stephen Bednarzyk, and Ms. Lina C. McDonald.

**Senator V. Anthony Ada** thanked Mrs. Kloppenburg for her willingness to serve CAHA again. He noted that her absence was noticed, but that he is pleased that she has happily returned at the behest of the Governor.

**Senator Christopher M. Duenas** thanked Mrs. Kloppenburg for her volunteerism and stated that he wanted to extend his gratitude to her family for settling in Guam and serving the island in different capacities.

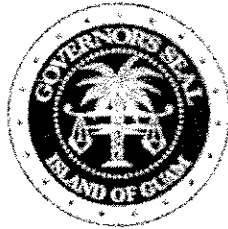
**Senator Aline A. Yamashita, Ph.D.** thanked Mrs. Kloppenburg for her volunteer effort and her positive influence on children.
