COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The nomination of Renie Llaneta to serve as a member of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board was made by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo on June 18, 2013. The appointment packet was received by the Office of Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D., on June 18, 2013. The appointment of Renie Llaneta was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations on June 19, 2013.

The Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations convened a public hearing on July 30, 2013 at 2:00 p.m. in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was the nomination of Renie Llaneta. The hearing was adjourned at 2:23 p.m.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Michael F.Q. San Nicolas: I'd like to invite Mister Renie 'Rey' Llaneta to please join us. If there are no other individuals wishing to testify on Mister Llaneta's behalf... sir, whenever you are ready.

Mr. Renie 'Rey' Llaneta: This is my first time to do this. The Governor has asked me if I wanted to do this and I am stepping up to the plate to help in whatever way I can. I work for Chugach Alaska Corporation. I was doing that full-time but now I'm doing it part-time because I am a businessman now in the Philippines, owning the first Remax there. So, I think I can bring to the table my knowledge and experience with being an island boy and wanting to participate and help the community. By stepping up to the plate and being a member of the ABC Board, I think will be a small part of what I

can do for the people of Guam. I'm very happy to be here and I look forward to participating and helping out.

Chairman San Nicolas: Thank you. Again, the island is very grateful for your willingness to serve. As you have heard, the ABC Board has been facing multiple challenges and your willingness to come into this situation, and help to improve upon it, is very admirable. I greatly appreciate your willingness to serve the people of Guam in this capacity. Do any of my colleagues have any questions for Mister Llaneta? Vice Speaker Cruz.

Vice Speaker Benjamin Cruz: Rey is very humble. He retired from the National Guard. When he started with Chugach, he came into my office and the poor thing regretted having come into my office because I jumped all over him about the fact that I wanted his company to be a corporate citizen. I want to publicly acknowledge that Mister Llaneta managed to convince his company to adopt Hurao. They have been the patron saints and have donated hundreds of thousands of dollars in material and man hours to improve the area at Oka Point and have been silent donors and supporters of Hurao. The importance of Hurao to this community and the immersion school... I just think that it is imperative that all of us understand his involvement in that. I would vote for him twice for this Board. He could have gone to any board and I would have made sure that his confirmation went through. He is very knowledgeable and he would be an excellent person on any board. There are some that really need help; the Gaming Commission would have been one. Maybe we can have something where they can serve on several boards because he is one that I would definitely have voted twice for any number of boards that he would have wanted to sit on. His commitment to the community, as shown by his years in the National Guard and his willingness to convince his corporation to be good corporate citizens and support the preservation of the Chamorro language by adopting the Hurao Academy as their non-profit. I just wanted to make that clear for the record.

Chairman San Nicolas: Thank you, Vice Speaker. That is quite a glowing endorsement from this man to my right because he is very guarded with his endorsements but he was very gracious with his endorsement of you. That speaks volumes. Any other Senators have any questions for Rey?

Senator Christopher Duenas: I have to follow the Vice Speaker's glowing remarks but I wanted, for the benefit of the community, to understand Rey's humility also in not disclosing or talking about the arduous number of meetings he attended with the Chugach team at Land Management to go through the very tedious task of getting transportation models approved with his company. One of the reasons I have equal support for Rey was that I know he is very aware of the procedures and issues on how Land Management and the Board vets applications and that process of having to be approved. Even though he wasn't the board member there, he was the individual helping his company to gain and acquire that variance. He certainly was there for all the meetings and sometimes you were last on the list, and there could be 20 applications. So, you're there sitting and listening to every zoning request and everything else. I know that you got a quick study in what that means to the community. I join the Vice Speaker in saying that you're very well qualified for this Board not only because of your corporate citizenry but the fact that you really understand the keen interest of the community when it comes to preserving land rights. Thank you.

Chairman San Nicolas: Thank you, Senator Duenas. Senator Morrison.

Senator Tommy Morrison: The Vice Speaker is right when he says that you are very humble. I was just going through your packet and it is loaded with information. I just want to say that I appreciate your military service and service to our country and island. Thank you for doing this. We are very encouraged with the ABC Board going forward. I think this will be a great team for this year going forward and hopefully to maintain progress up there. Thank you.

Chairman San Nicolas: Thank you to my colleagues. In conclusion, thank you again very much. Some light at the end of the tunnel is that this Legislature recently passed a bill that would require boards and commissions to have an education package put together by the Director in regards to your responsibilities as board members, to include the laws that should apply to your respective board. That should be made available by, I believe, August 8. We've already sent reminders out to the directors to make sure those are prepared and you guys can look forward to receiving that information to facilitate your transition onto the Board. Again, it is very encouraging to see a man of your caliber willing to take on the level of service that is so needed up at the ABC Board. I believe that John Ray is going to be surrounded by an excellent team that's going to help him to navigate this ABC situation into, as Senator Duenas put it, a fair balance between protecting the community and promoting commerce. Thank you, Mister Llaneta, for your service.

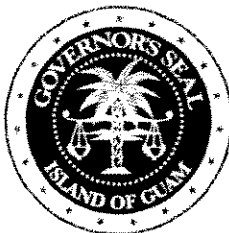
Mr. Llaneta: Thank you very much.



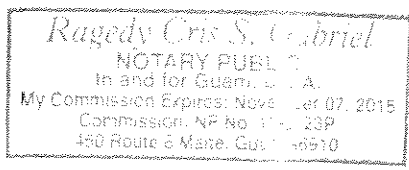


